We hope that the Conference and the special issue will meet your scientific and educational needs.

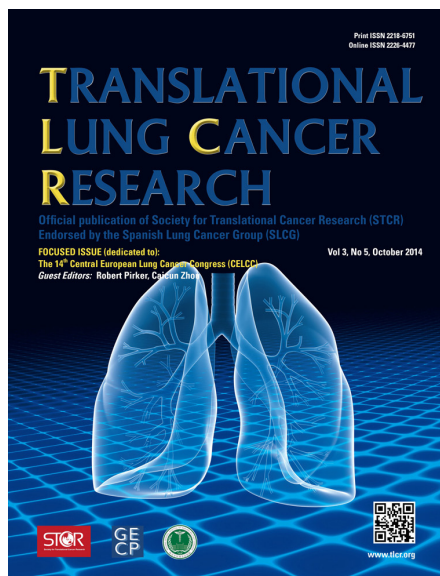


Figure 1 Vol 3, No 5 (October, 2014).

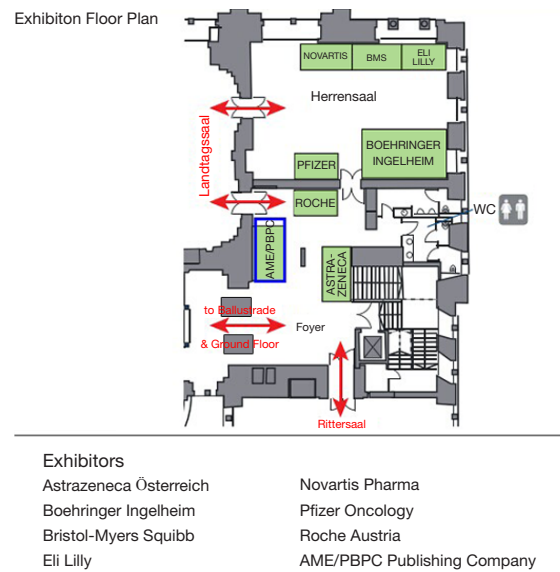


Figure 2 Exhibition Floor Plan: the exhibition booth of AME/PBPC Publishing Company is near the entrance of Landtagssaal.
