

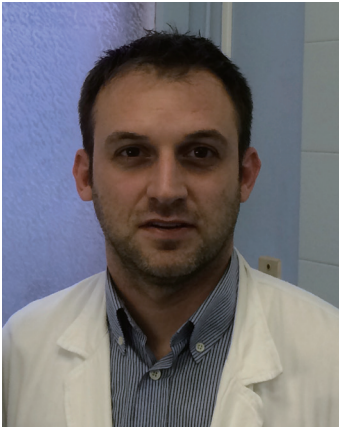
Preface
