



3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members







4. Publication: Number & Diversity(2019)




In the single year of 2019, TGH published altogether 84 articles, with 45% of Review, 43% of Editorial Material, and 11% of Article.

5. Publication: Internationality(2016-2019)





5. Publication: Internationality(2019)




In the year of 2019, 96 authors from 21 different countries contributed to TGH, and 41% of them came from USA.




Between 2016-2019, publication on TGH has been cited over 690 times, with 1.74 average citations per item.


