


4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



338 ATM editorial board members come from 35 countries, among who there are38% from the USA, followed by Italy, Canada, Spain, the UK and etc.




5. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2019

6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2019




Corresponding authors of **1,218** articles published from Jan 2019 - Dec 2019 come from **42** countries, with **23%** of them from the USA.

7. Citations in 2019 (results by year)




Number of **total citation** has significantly increased to **11,592** in 2019.


