



>4. Number of Published Articles by Year






- In 2019, the number of published articles in GS rose markedly with the total reaching to 152.

>5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2019







>9. Total Citation of GS by Year






- Citation of GS has increased steadily with a total reaching 1, 953 by December 31th, 2019.


Retrieval: Total




