


4. Message from the Editorial Team

5. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




All together **61** Members from 15 countries, including

- 55 Editorial Board Members




6. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



In 2019, **62** articles have been published in TP




7. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2019



Among the 62 articles published in 2019, there are 45 review articles and original articles.




8. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2019

10. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2019




Monthly Retrieval of TP in PubMed reached the peak of 46, 595 in Oct. 2019.




