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Comment 1: Reviewer A

The report is important and the picture material is suitable for publication. However, the paper is in need of thorough language editing by a professional.

Reply 1: We have turned to use the medical writing service. The paper has been thoroughly linguistically edited by 2 native English-speaking experts.

Changes in the text: The main text and figure legends have been checked by 2 experts from AME Editing Service.

Comment 2: Reviewer B

In this case report, authors showed detailed histopathological findings of esophageal sebaceous glands. I think this manuscript is worthy of publication. However, there are a couple of issues to modify.

Line 60. Author described "1. chronic non-atrophic gastritis with erosions (grade III) ", is "gastritis" really correct in the text?

I don't think the English of Figure legend is appropriate. For example, I think "pathology biopsy" should be "histopathological findings of biopsy specimens," and I am not sure what you mean by "mild epithelial cell morphology."

Reply 2: We have modified our text as above advised.

Changes in the text: chronic **superficial** gastritis with erosions (grade III); A small squamous epithelium, **normal** epithelial cell morphology, and interstitial dispersion in inflammatory cell infiltration were observed, but no other specific pathological changes were observed
