line 44: stage not statge

comment No1: the lateral suspension does not usually adress the rectocele.

Reply1: this patient's ultrasound of pelvic floor indicated rectal prolapse was not observed in the resting state or after maximum Valsalva. Although many literatures have suggested that LLS cannot

solve posterior pelvic defects, we find that LLS with a cross-mesh placed over the top of the vagina

after hysterectomy can solve mild to moderate posterior pelvic prolapse to some extent.

comment No2: The high mesh costs could be reduced from native tissue techniques with excellent
