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### Review Comments

1. in the video we do not understand how the authors are able to perform a dissection towards the promontory. How do they use the catheter? how to be sure that you are in the good dissection pathway? I suggest the authors should explain in depth the technique of dissection, maybe using a figure (anatomy...) to confirm that this technique is reproducible.

Reply: Thank you for your remind. We describe in more detail the procedures and anatomical markers of the surgical approach in step-by-step description (2) & (3) .

2. we know that there is a risk of severe infection during laparoscopic sacrocolpopexy. Using he vaginal route with a mesh, I suppose the risk is higher despite using antibiotics. Could the authors explain how to diminish the risk of infection? could they give the preliminary results of their cohort?

Reply: The views on infection are described in Line 139-145. Reference 6, another article by the author's hospital team, details the low incidence of infection in a large sample of 2000 vnotes surgeries.
