Author reply: I truly appreciate the comments and have reviewed the additional 2 articles. The articles are very well written and confirm the findings in this review and other studies. The additional studies were not included because they did not specifically evaluate patient reported outcomes with standardized measures or surveys such as the BREAST-Q.
