1	Would you like to share data collected for your study to others?	Yes

3	What data in particular will be shared?	Outcomes to share are the incidence of post-esophagectomy diaphragmatic hernia and postoperative results following surgical repair.
4	Any other documents will be share? Such as study protocol, statistical analysis plan, informed consent form, clinical study report, analytic code.	Any request concerning extra-documents can be emailed and will be evaluated by authors prior to be accepted.
5	When will data availability begin?	From the publication date.
6	When will data availability end?	The surgical technique and cancer survival have been evolving, and both follow-up and incidence of post-esophagectomy diaphragmatic hernia may change. For this reason, availability may expire in 1-2 years as data may be updated and, thus, different.
7	To whom will you share the data?	Oncologists, Upper GI or emergency surgeons collecting data for meta-analyses or clinical survey.
8	For what type of analysis or purpose?	Meta-analysis or survey summarizing multicenter experience from high-volume esophageal units. Other projects evaluating morbidity after esophagectomy could be appropriate.
