Comment 1: As a thoracic surgeon, this article, which provides information on the status of thoracic surgery in other country, was very informative and interesting. This paper provides information on the current status of thoracic surgery in Denmark, especially lung cancer surgery. However, some revisions are necessary for this paper to be published.

First of all, although the title of this paper is 'Thoracic surgery in Denmark', the actual content is mainly dealing with lung cancer surgery. So the title and content do not match well. It would be nice to change the title to one that includes lung cancer surgery. Also, if the contents are limited to lung cancer surgery, it will be a clearer and better paper.
