OncoLifeS, a data biobank managed by the University Medical Center Groningen (UMCG), also provides clinical and survival data. Access to OncoLifeS data is granted upon request and subject to approval by the ethical and scientific committees of UMCG and OncoLifeS.

5	When will data availability begin?	From publication date
6	When will data availability end?	One year, since survival data is updated on a yearly basis.
7	To whom will you share the data?	Epidemiologist, medical scientist and stakeholders
8	For what type of analysis or purpose?	Intended for the use of survival data of patients with lung cancer for scientific or policy making purposes
