Thank you for this nice case. The main comments about this study is that there is no audiogram. Is it possible to document an audiogram of the patient even if not one was attained prior to commencement of treatment. If there is sensorineural hearing loss, then the whole merit of this paper is of question since it will no longer be an isolated neuropathy.

We acknowledge this excellent suggestion from the reviewer, but unfortunately, we are unable to perform this clinical assessment on the patient at this late date.

The only other comment is minor, however in the discussion, the nerve supply to the pinna is documented but the reference to the contribution from the facial nerve is missing
