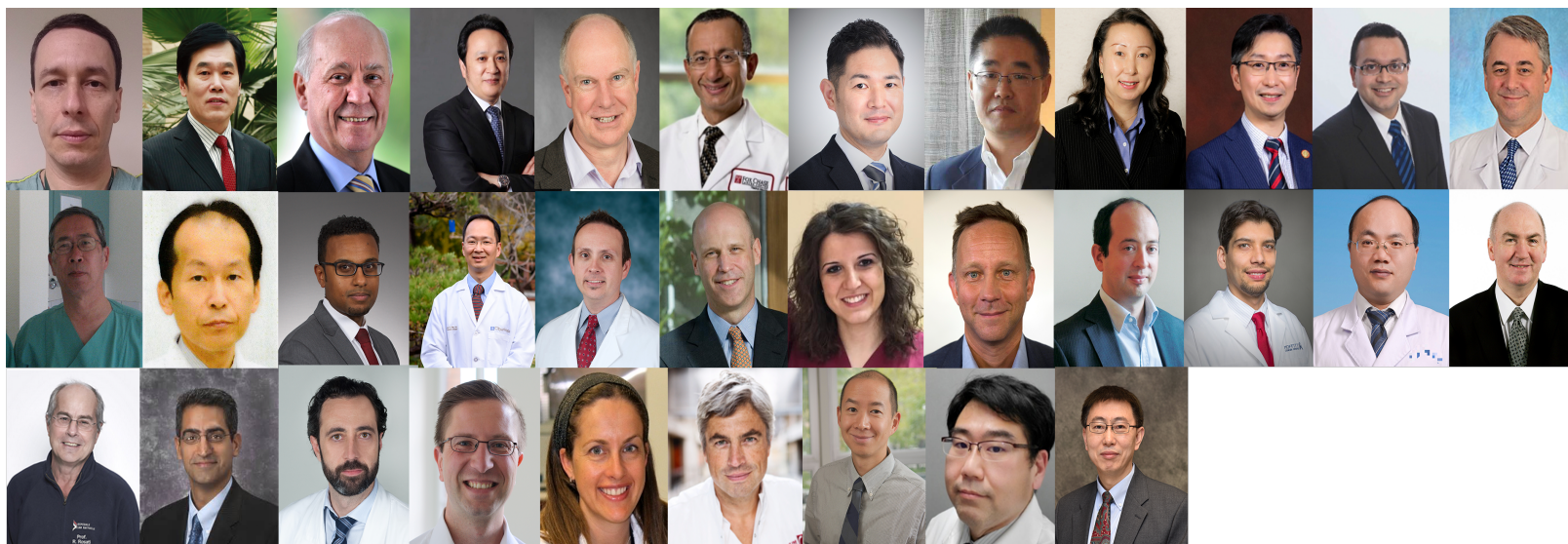

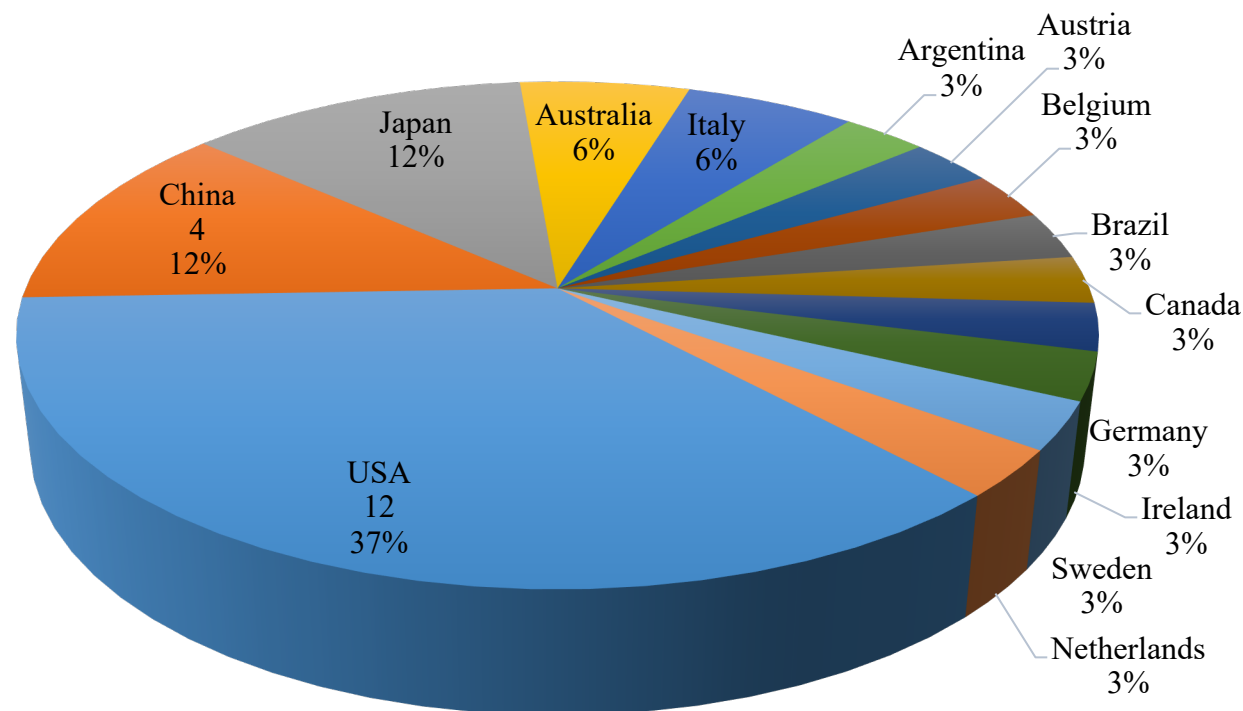

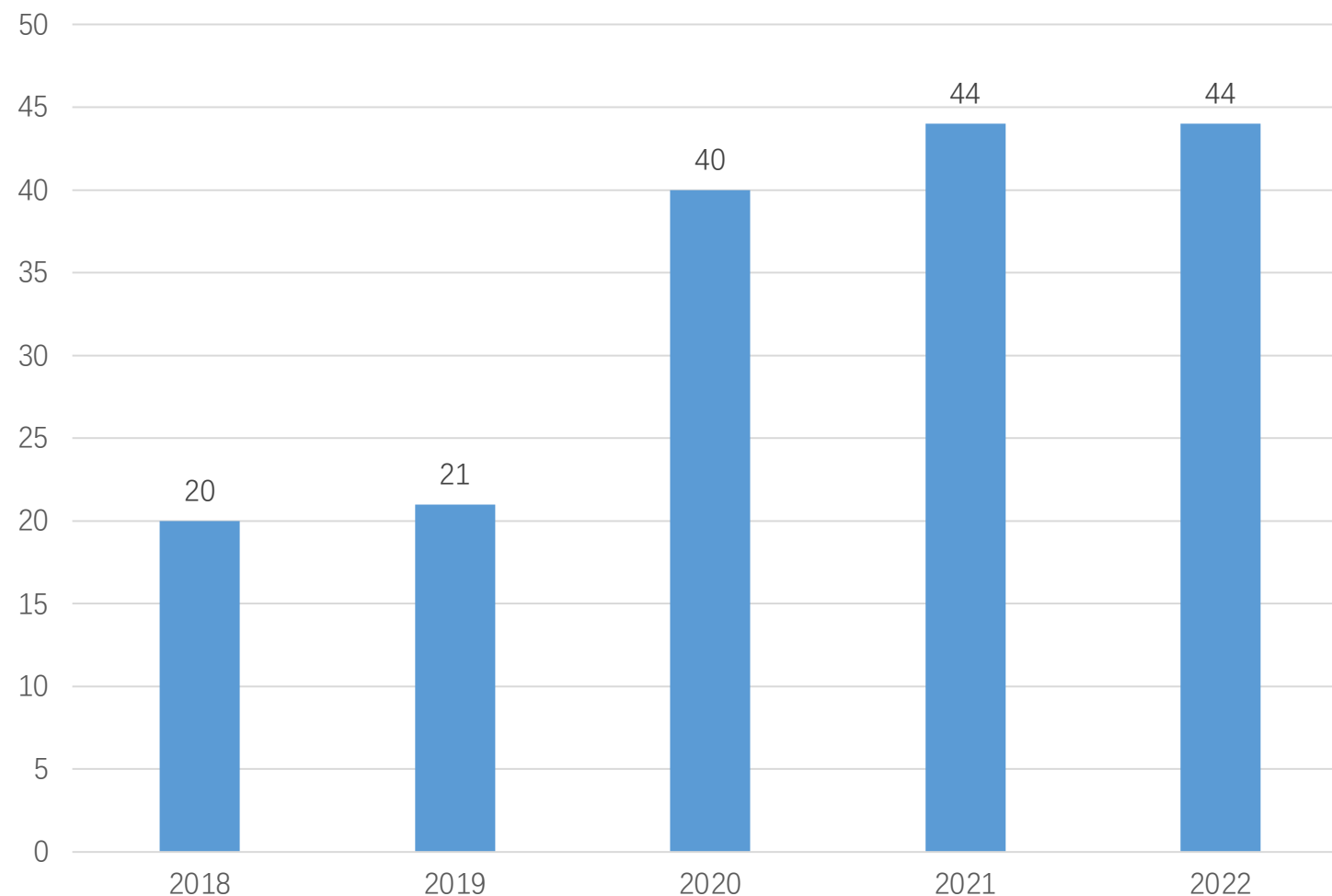
3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members

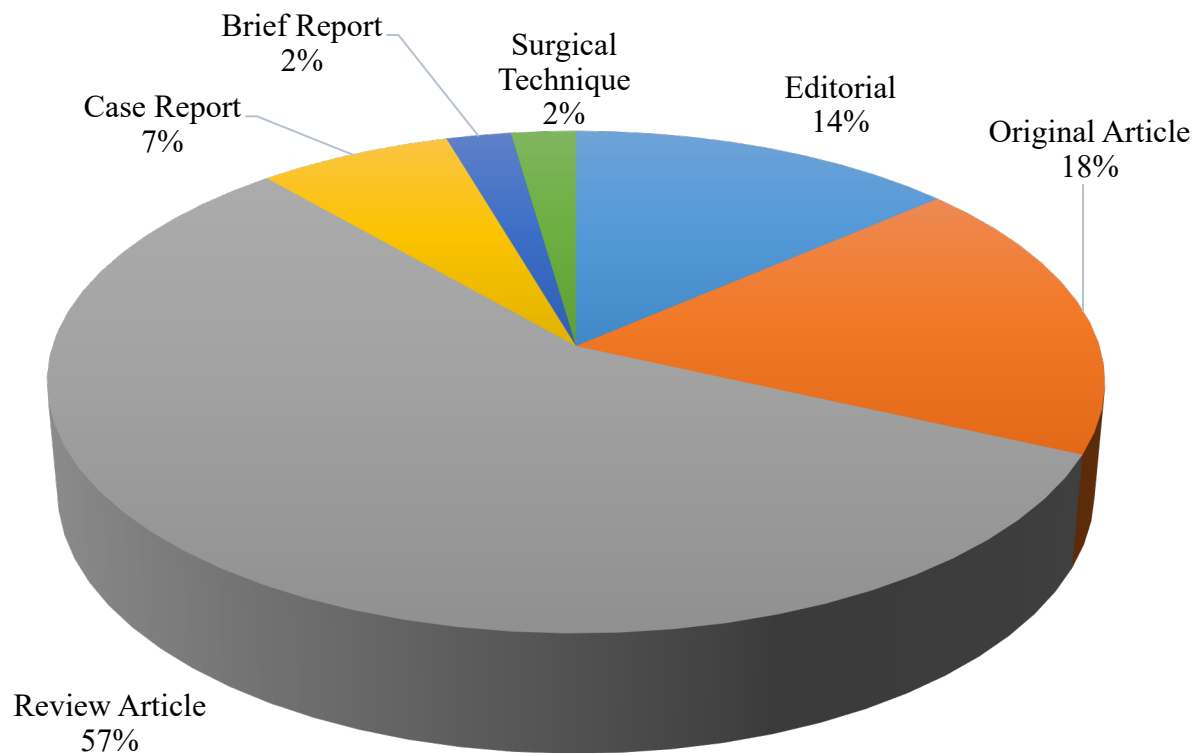
4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

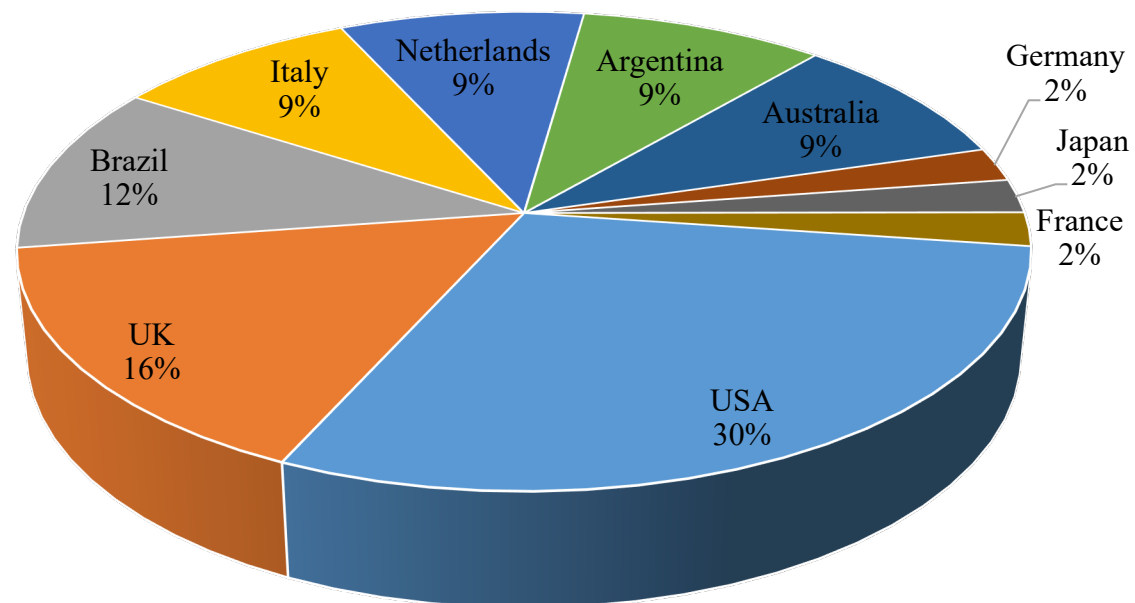

5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2022

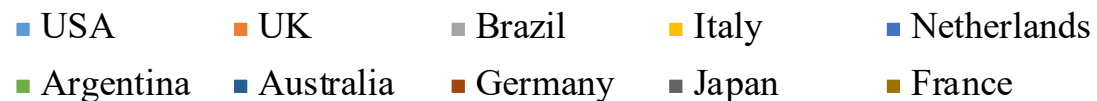

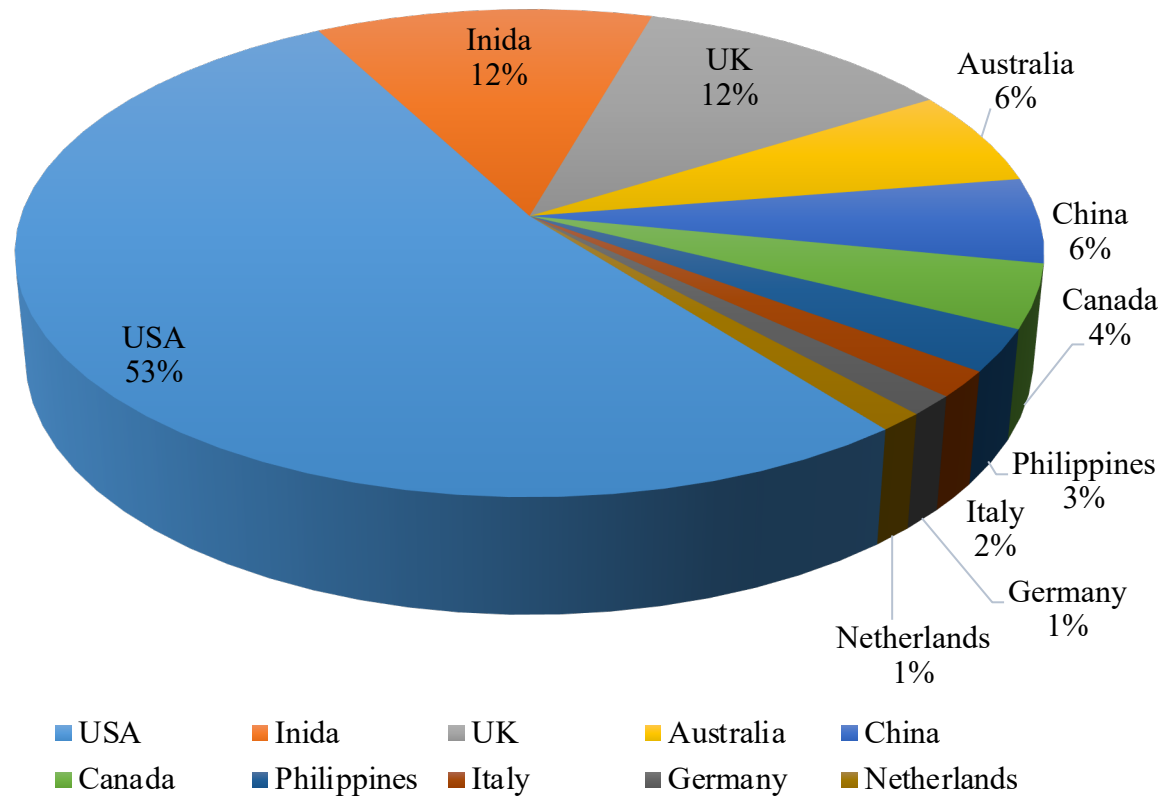
6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022
