
# 2. Aims and Features

All together **60** members from **16** countries.



# 4. Research Fields of Editorial Board Members




Currently, board members are from a variety of fields, mostly from Cardiothoracic Surgery fields.

# 5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021




In 2021, JOVS published **50 articles**, among which there are **54%** Review Article, and **20%** Case Report.





# 6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021




Corresponding authors of 50 articles published in 2021 came from **14 countries**, mostly from USA and Italy. Updated on Dec. 31, 2021




