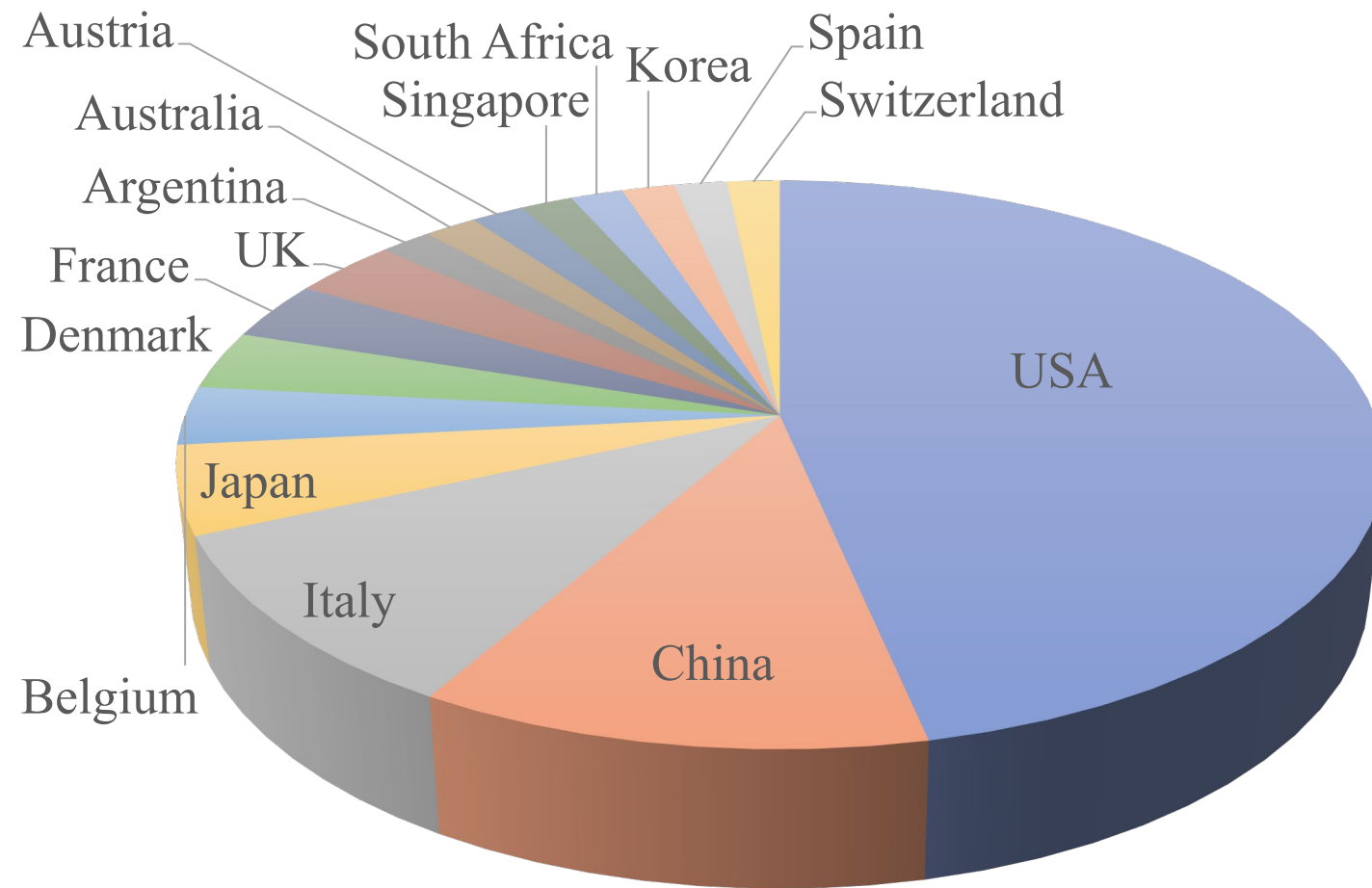

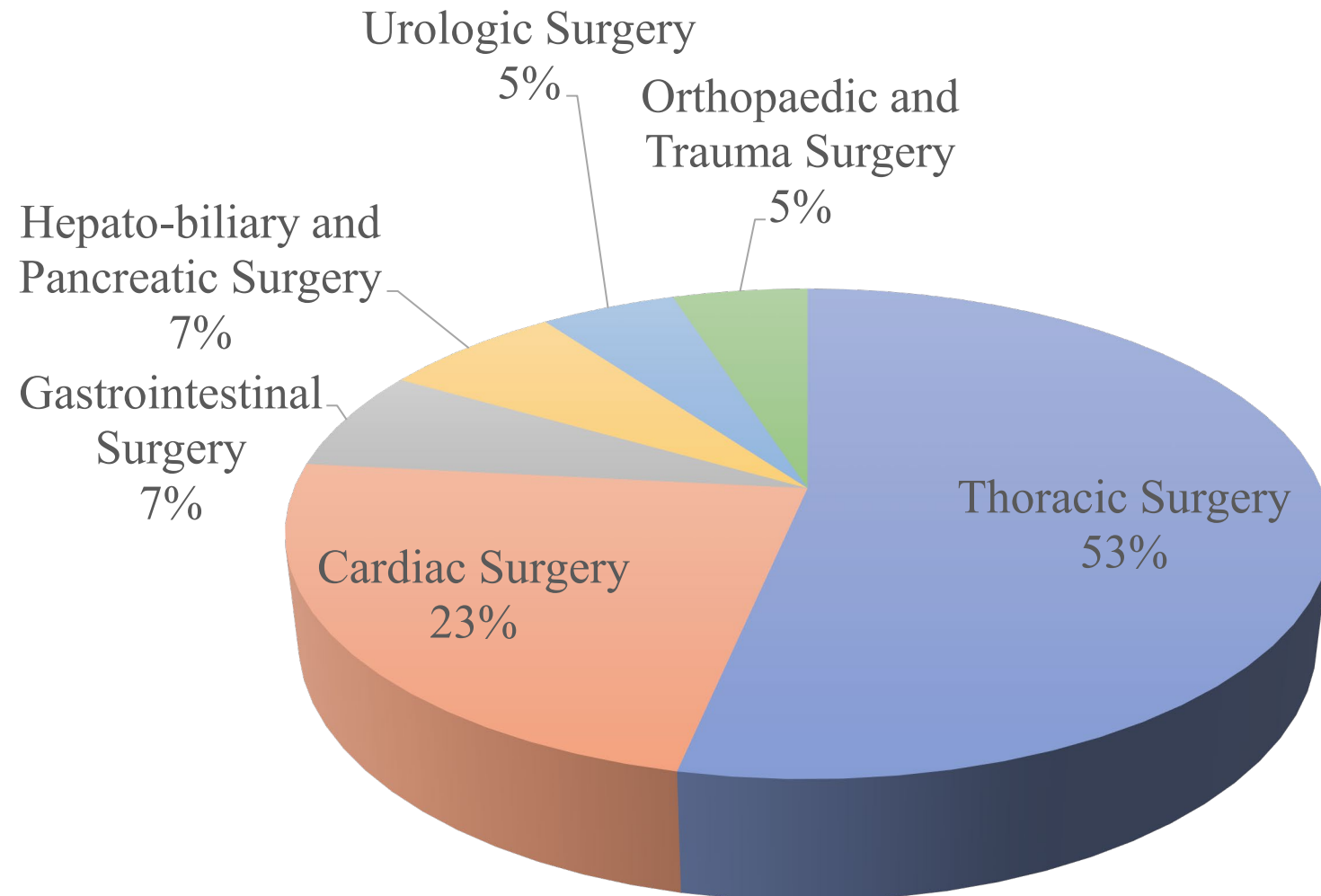

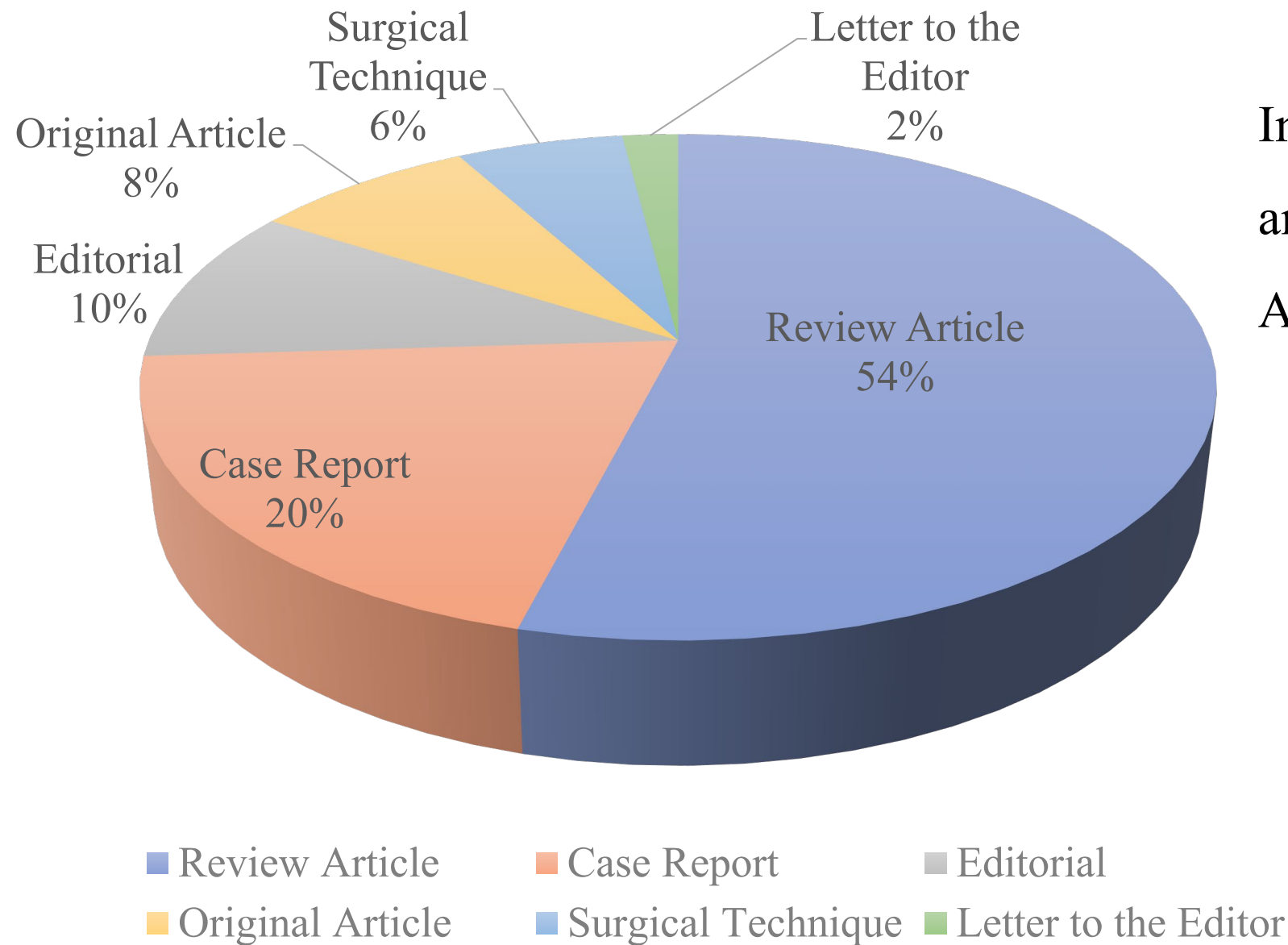

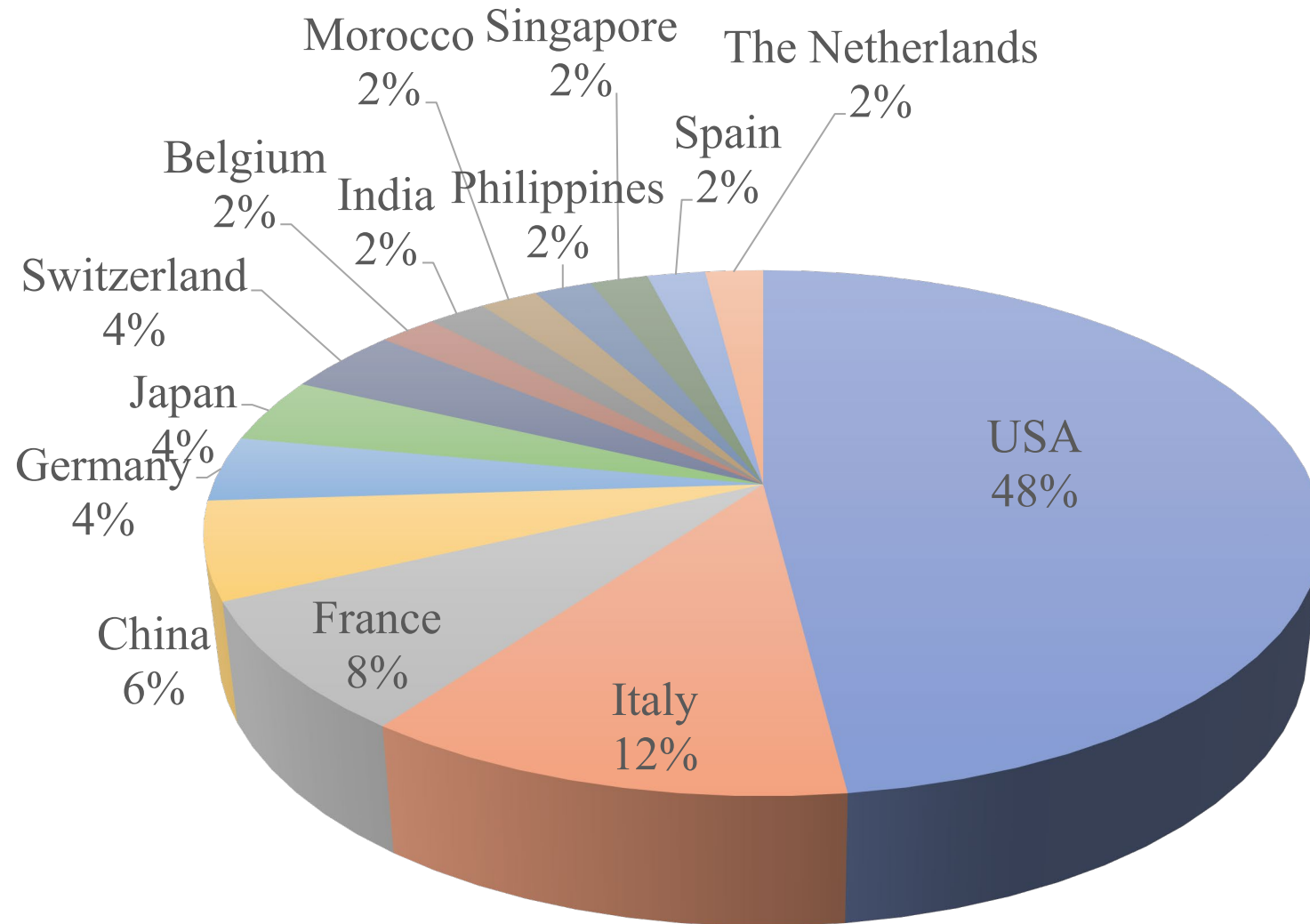

Corresponding authors of 50 articles published in 2021 came from **14 countries**, mostly from USA and Italy.

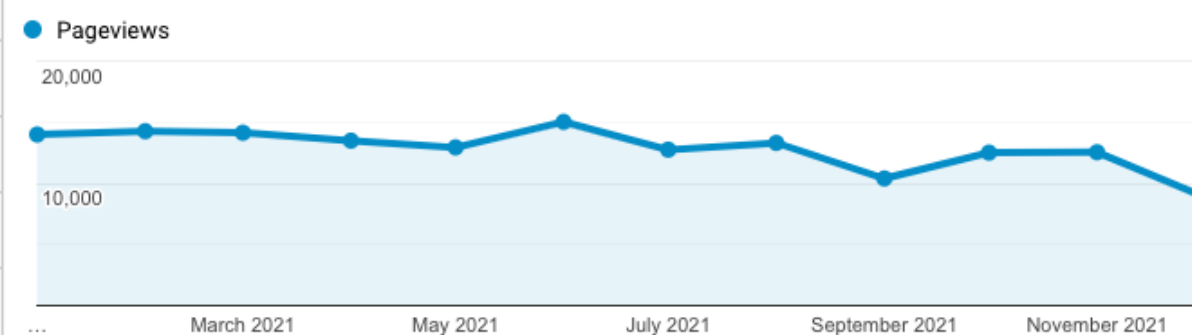
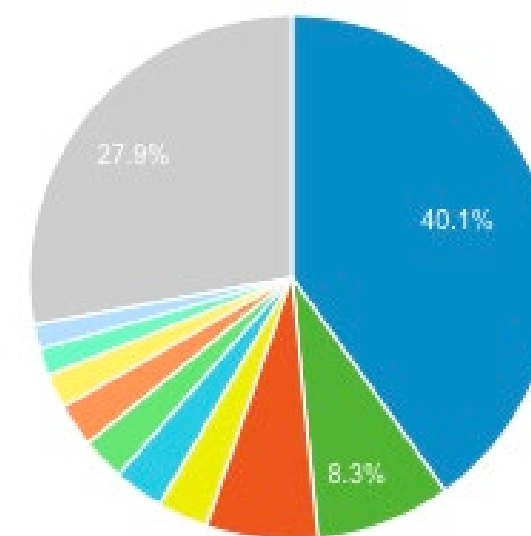

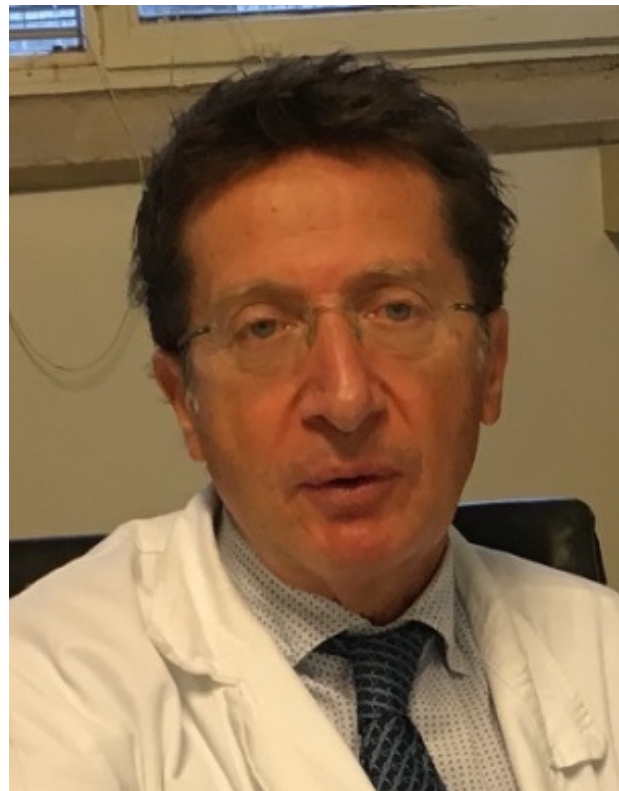
