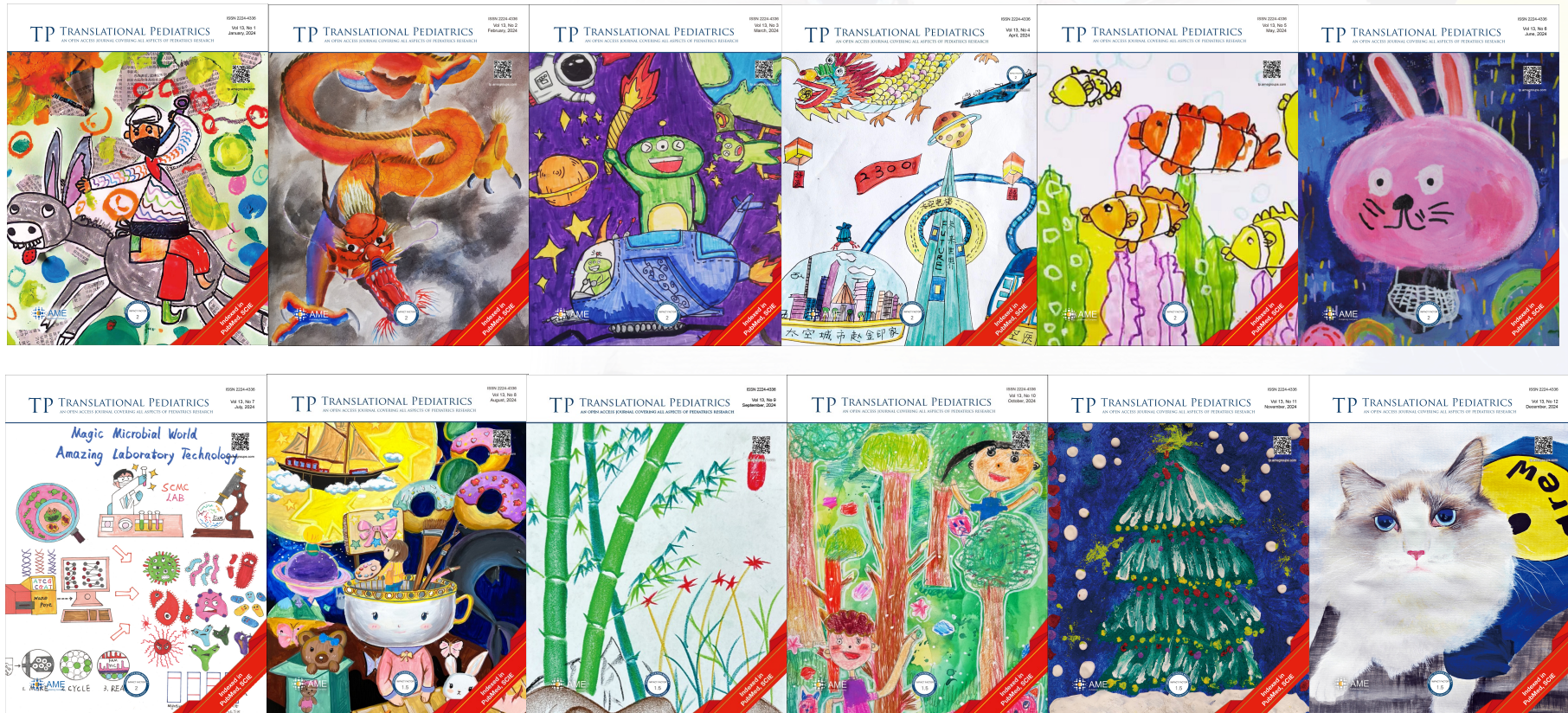

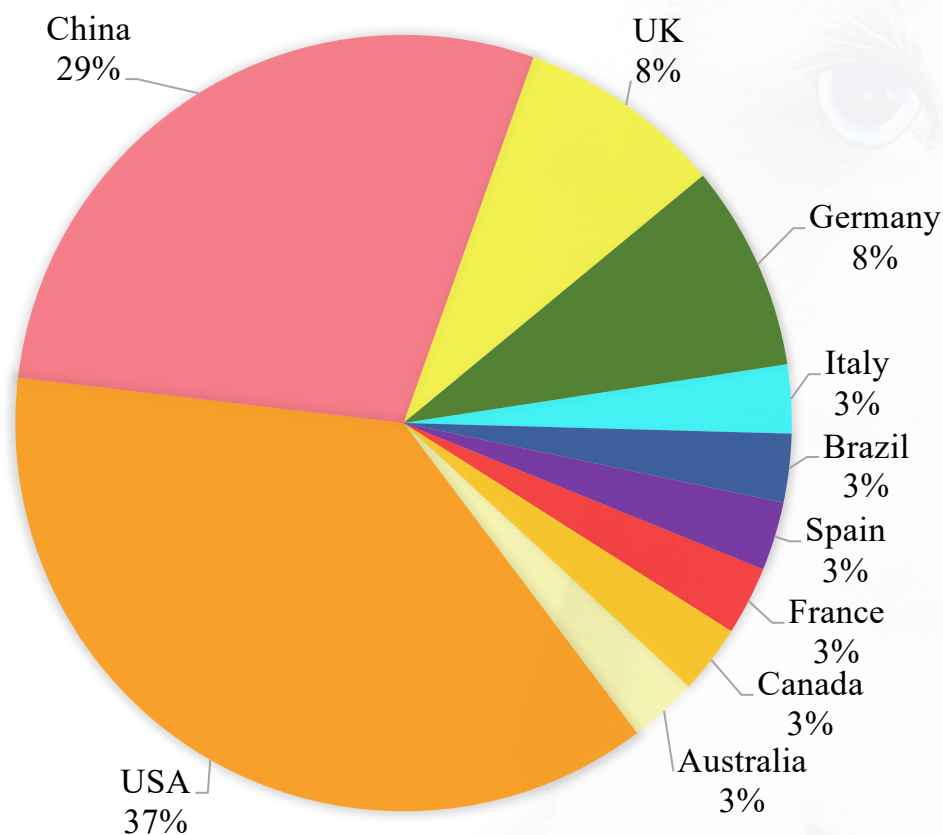

## 5. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

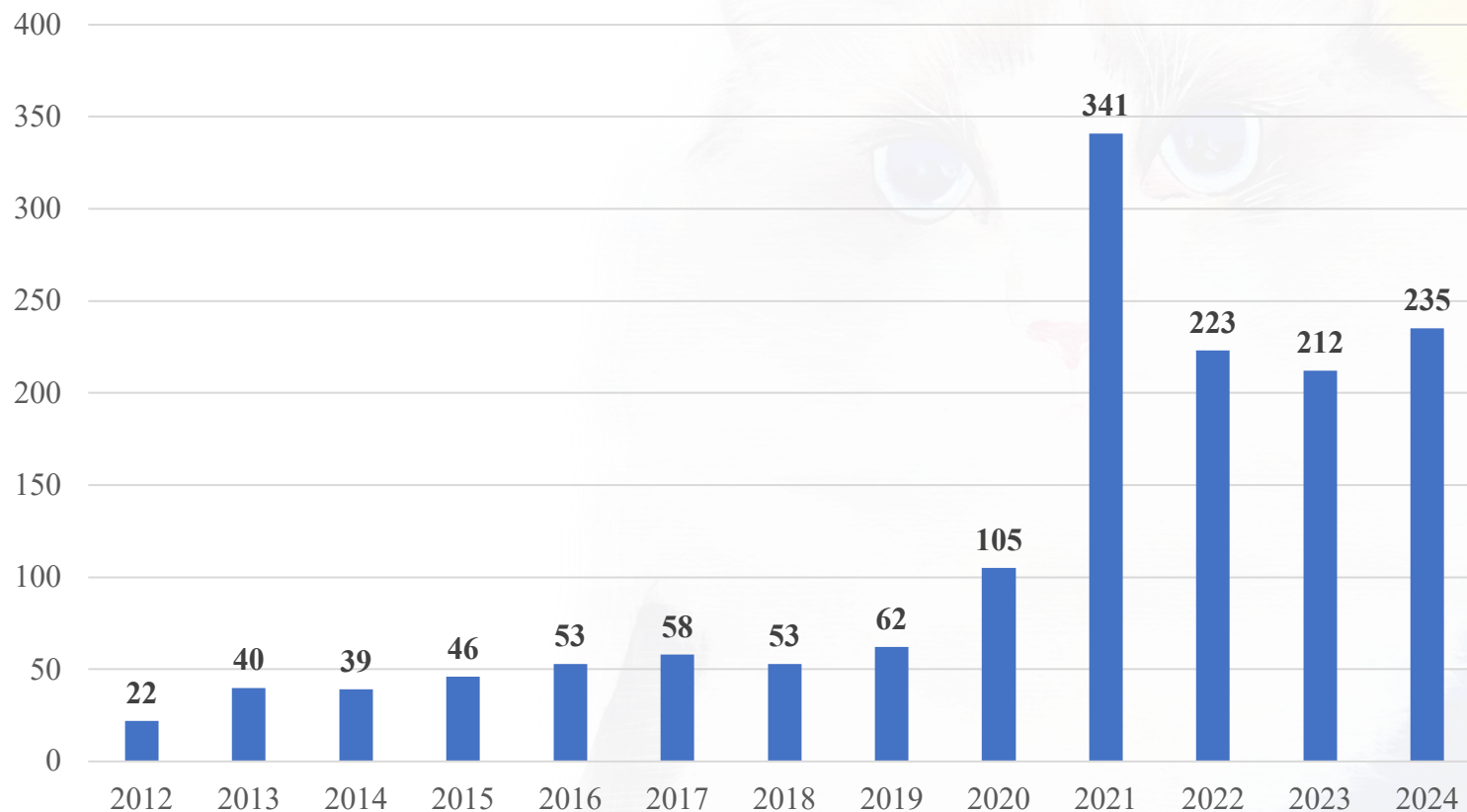

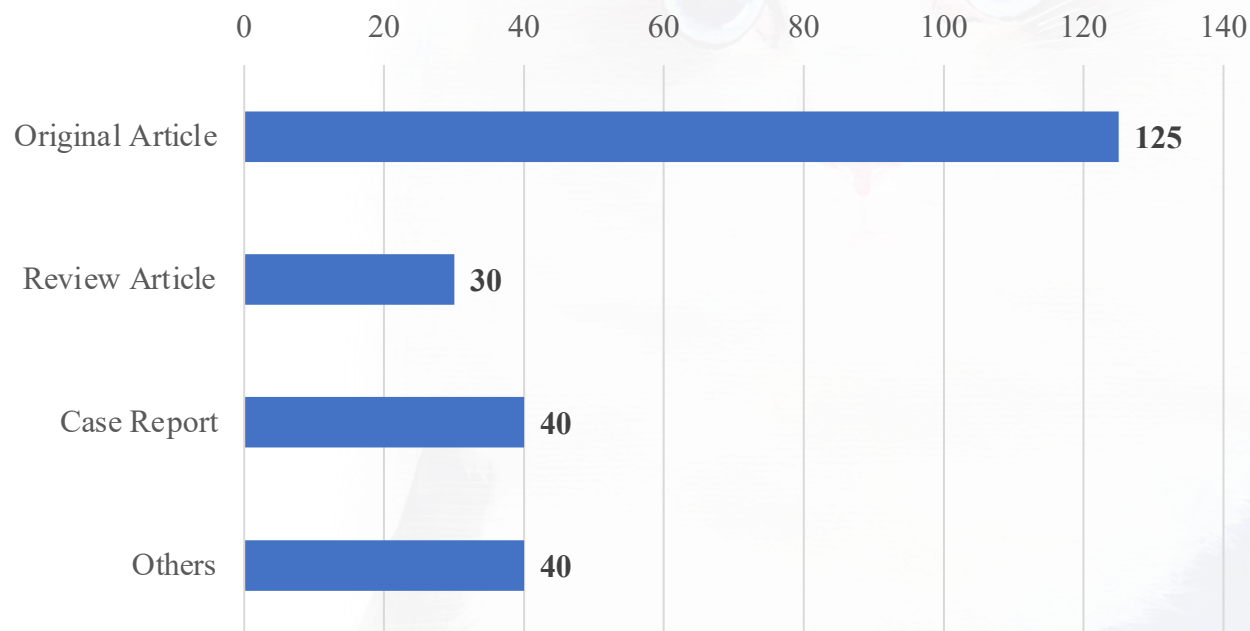
## 6. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

## 7. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2024

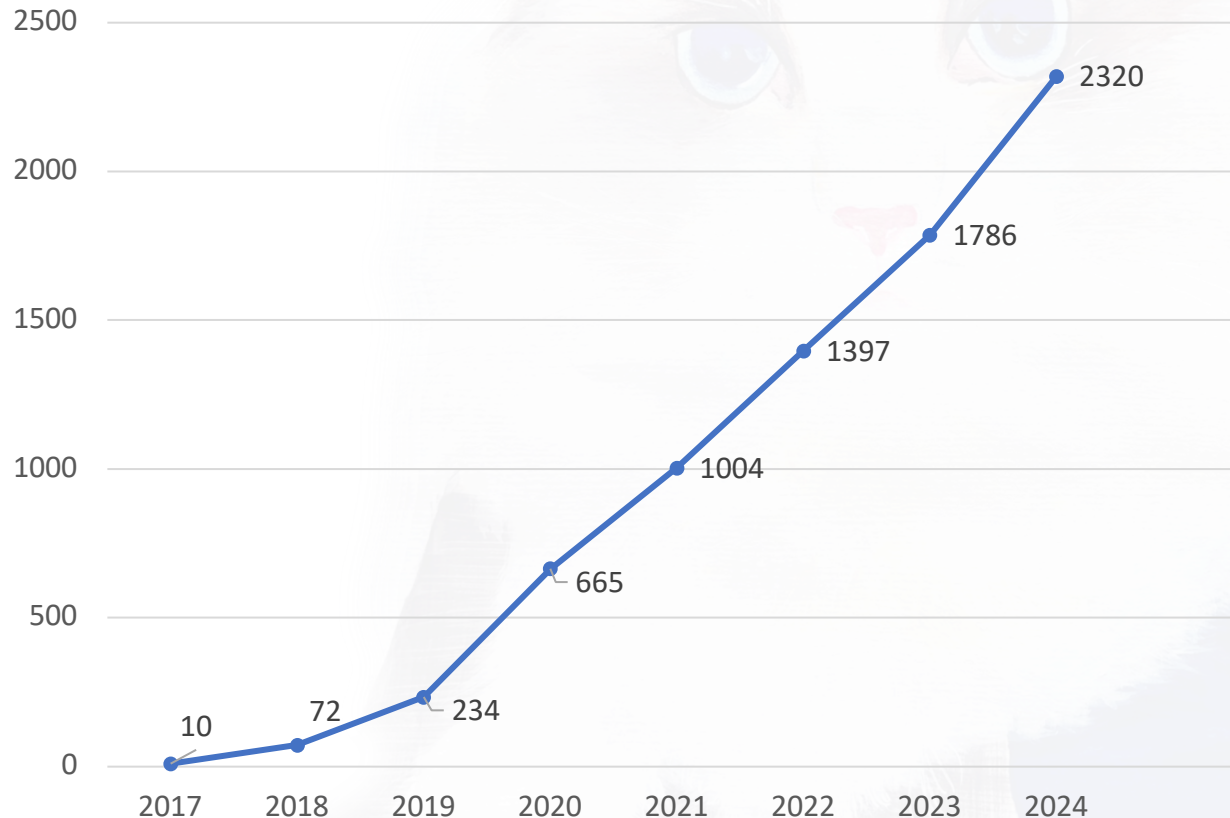
Among the 235 articles published in 2024, there are **155** original articles and review articles.

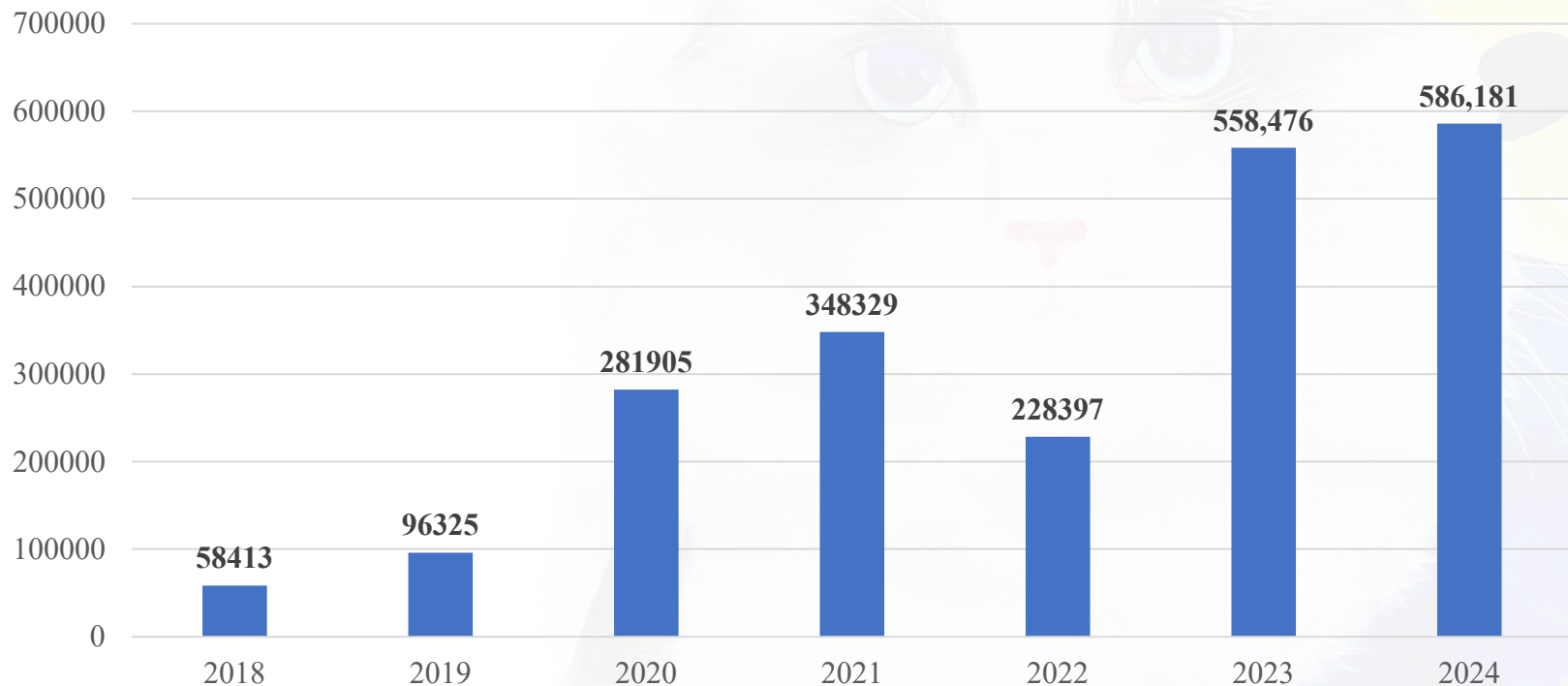
## 8. Citations collected from WOS

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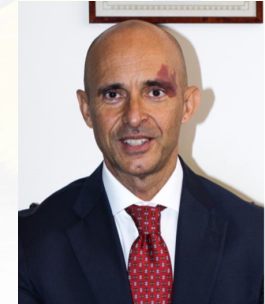
