

2. Message from the Editor-in-Chief



Mediastinum's editorial board comprises 70 members from 17 countries, with the highest percentage from the USA (27%), followed by Japan (20%), Italy (10%), and China (9%).




4. Number of Articles Published in Mediastinum (Results by Year)



Mediastinum has maintained a stable publication of approximately 40 articles per year since 2019 and has published a total of 289 articles since its inception in 2017.




5. Proportions of Article Types in 2023



Of the 40 articles published in 2023, Review Articles represented the largest proportion (45%).




6. International Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2023

7. Website Pageviews (Results by Year)




The pageviews of Mediastinum have continued to present a steady rising trend.




