



3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members



4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2020




In 2020, AOB has published 40 articles, among which there are 13 Review Articles, 13 Editorial Commentary and 6 Editorial.

5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2020




Corresponding authors of 40 articles published in 2020 come from 14 countries, among who there are 30% from USA, followed by China, Australia, Canada and etc.


