

> Distribution of Editorial Board Members




53 JLPM editorial board members come from 18 countries, among whom there are 26% from USA, followed by Italy, UK, China, Germany, etc.





3. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2024




Since Jan. 2024, JLPM has published a total of 35 articles, among which there are 17 Review Articles and 10 Original Articles.





4. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2024




Corresponding authors of 35 articles published in 2024 come from 14 countries, including 21.1% from UK, followed by Italy, USA, Japan, etc.


