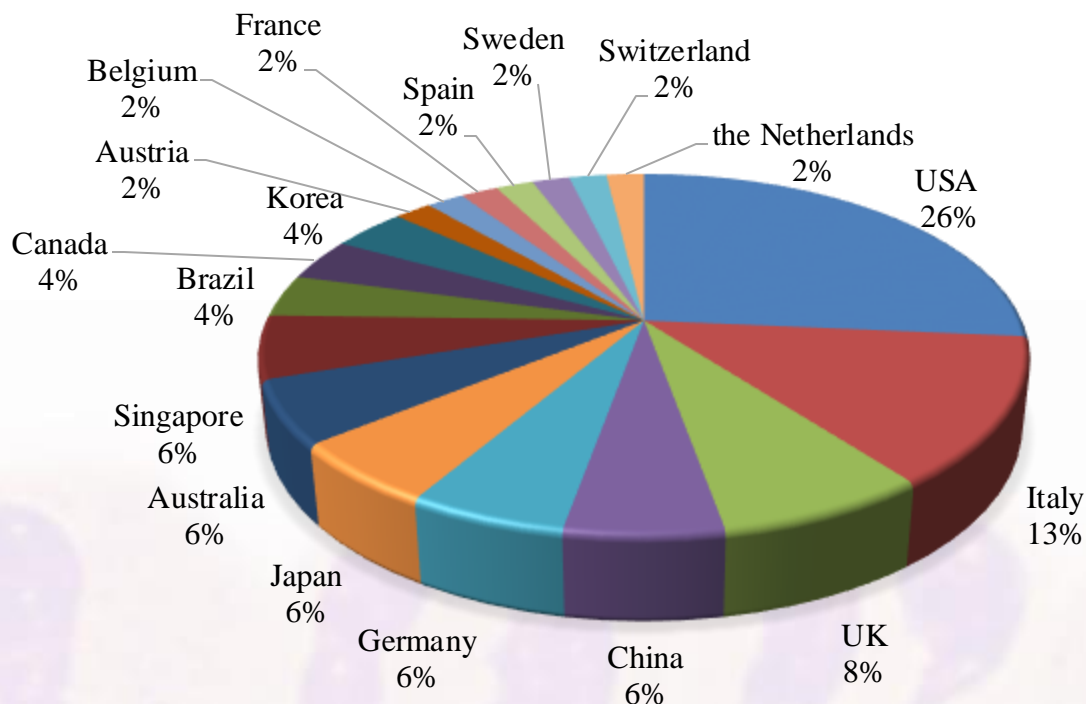

53 JLPM editorial board members come from 18 countries, among whom there are 26% from USA, followed by Italy, UK, China, Germany, etc.

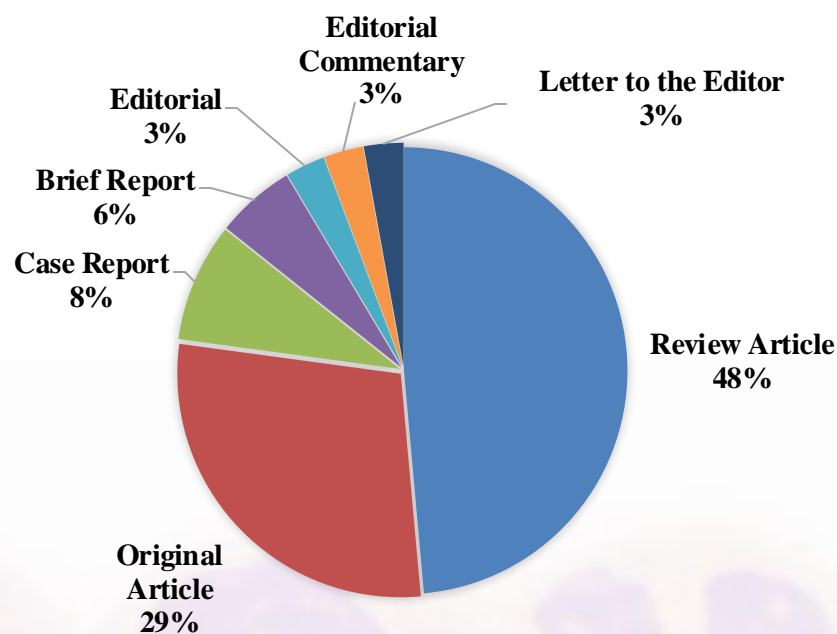

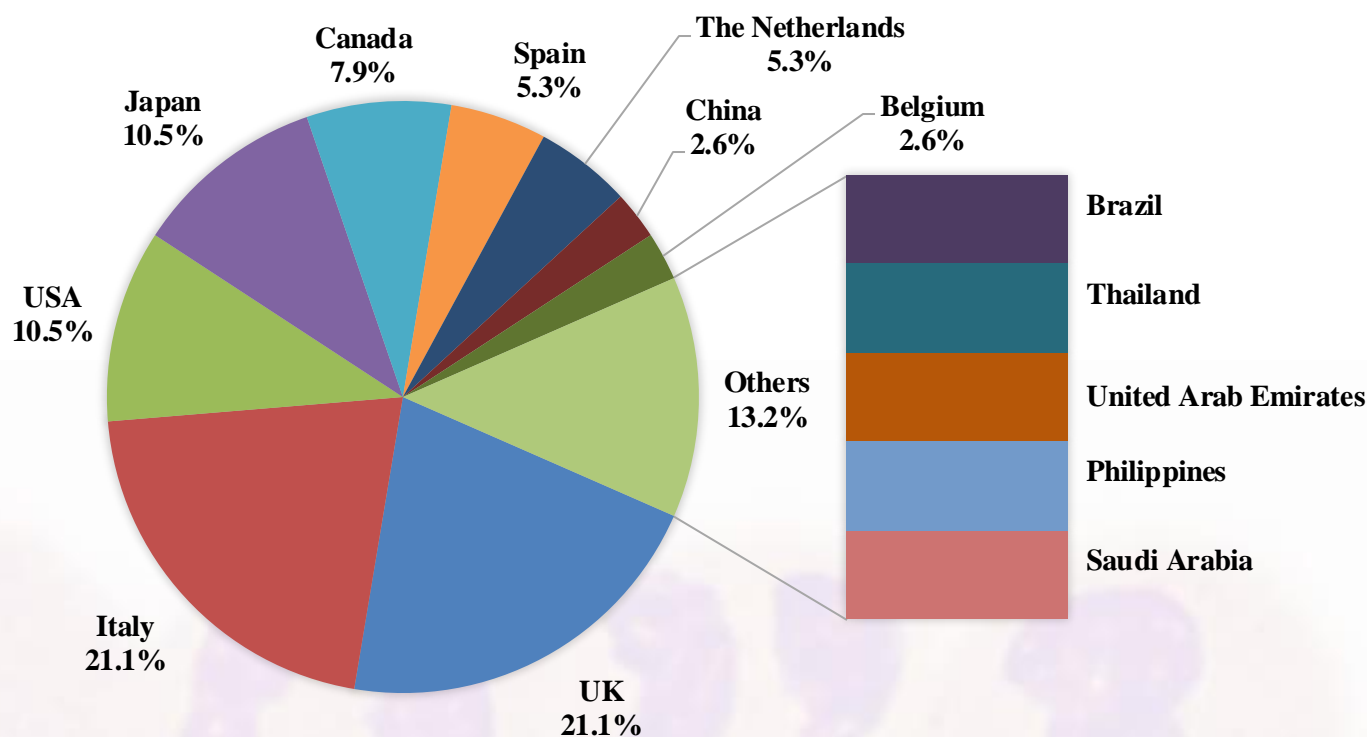


3. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2024



Since Jan. 2024, JLPM has published a total of **35** articles, among which there are **17** Review Articles and **10** Original Articles.

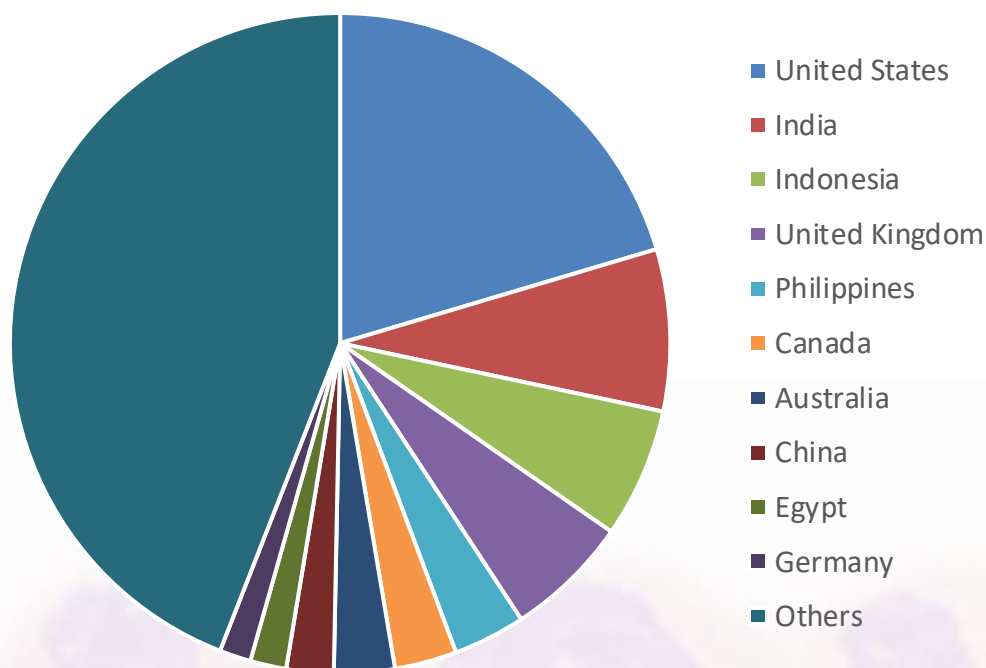
4. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2024

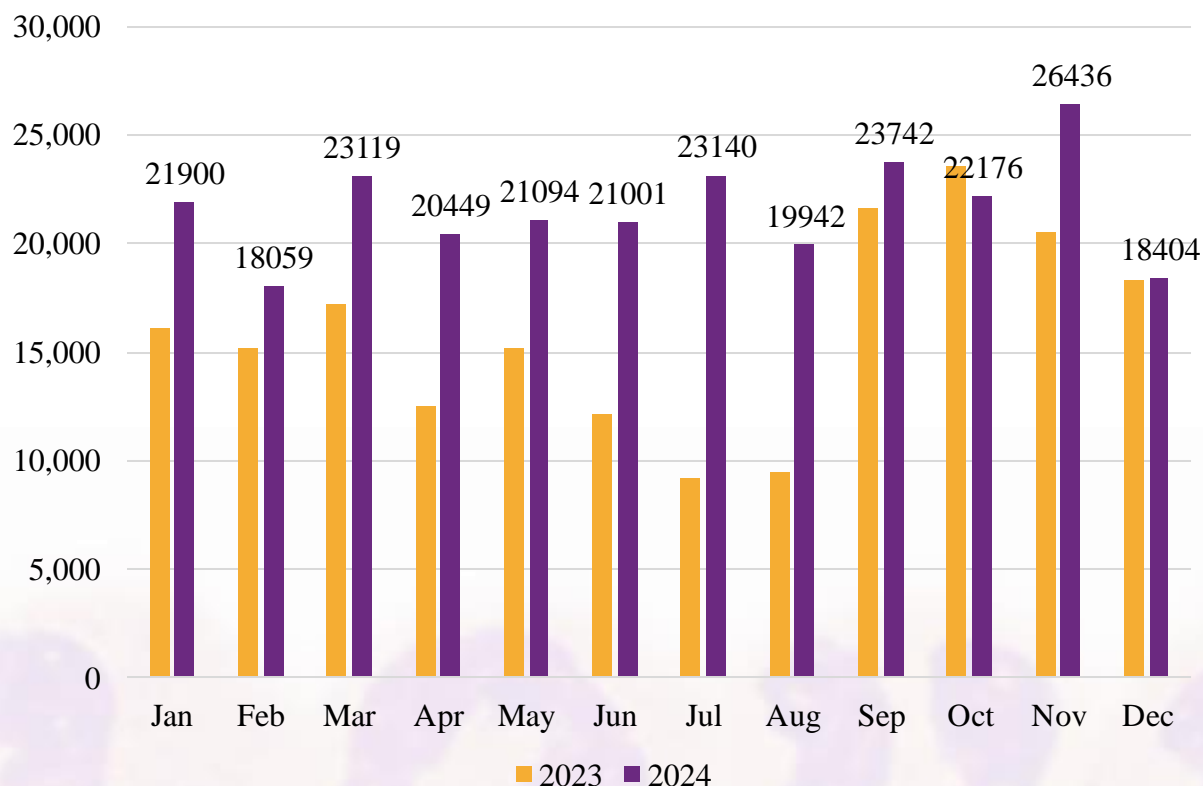
