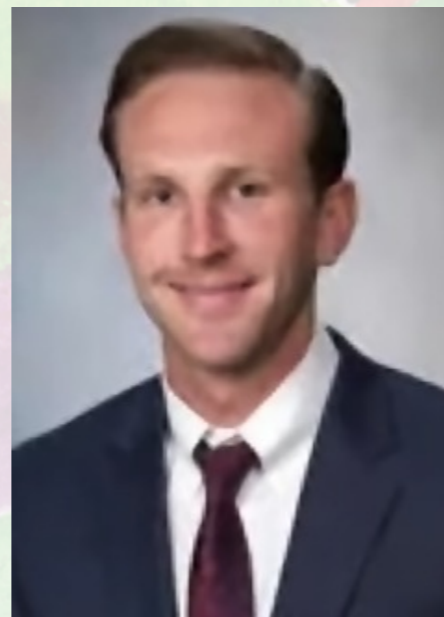
2. Message from the Editors-in-Chief

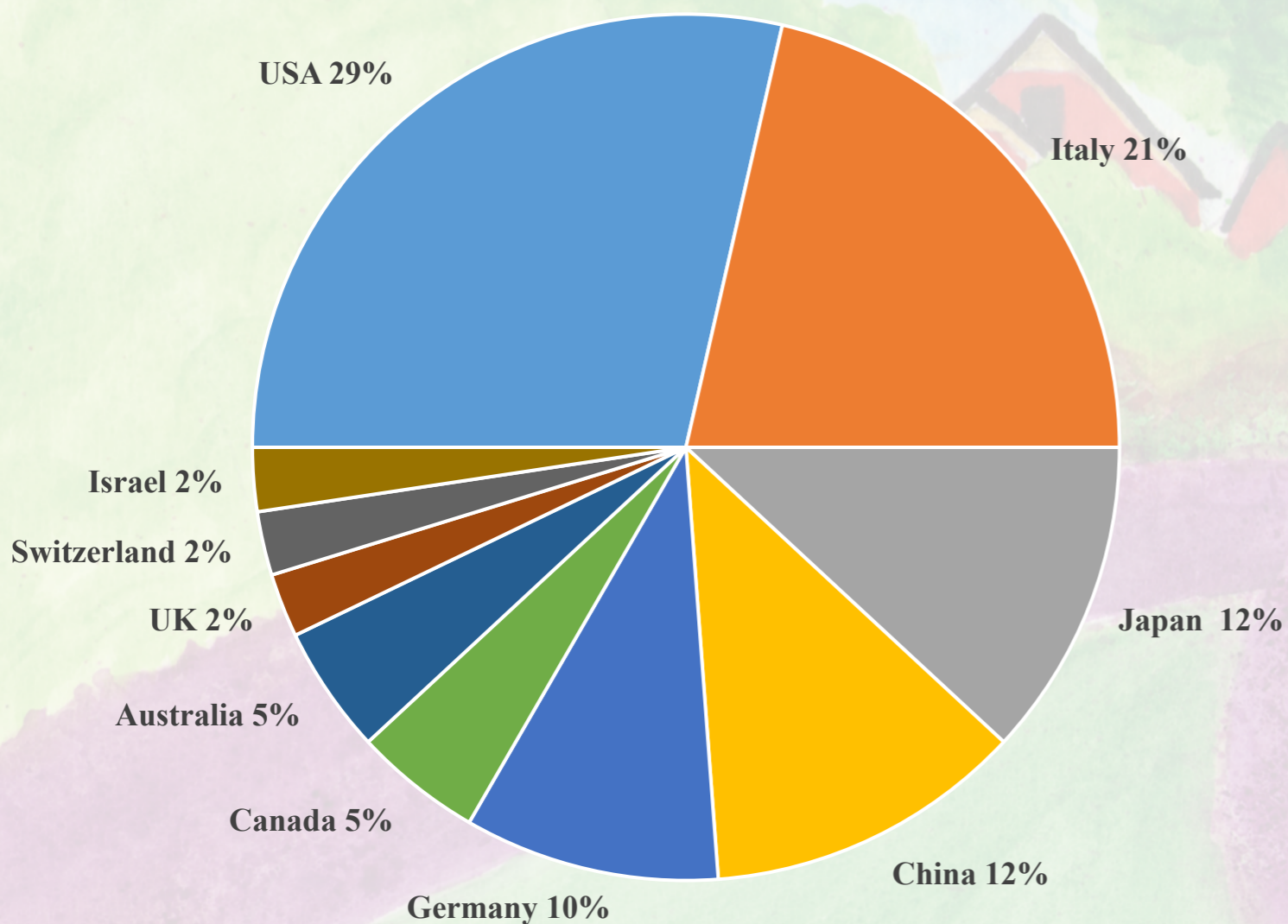

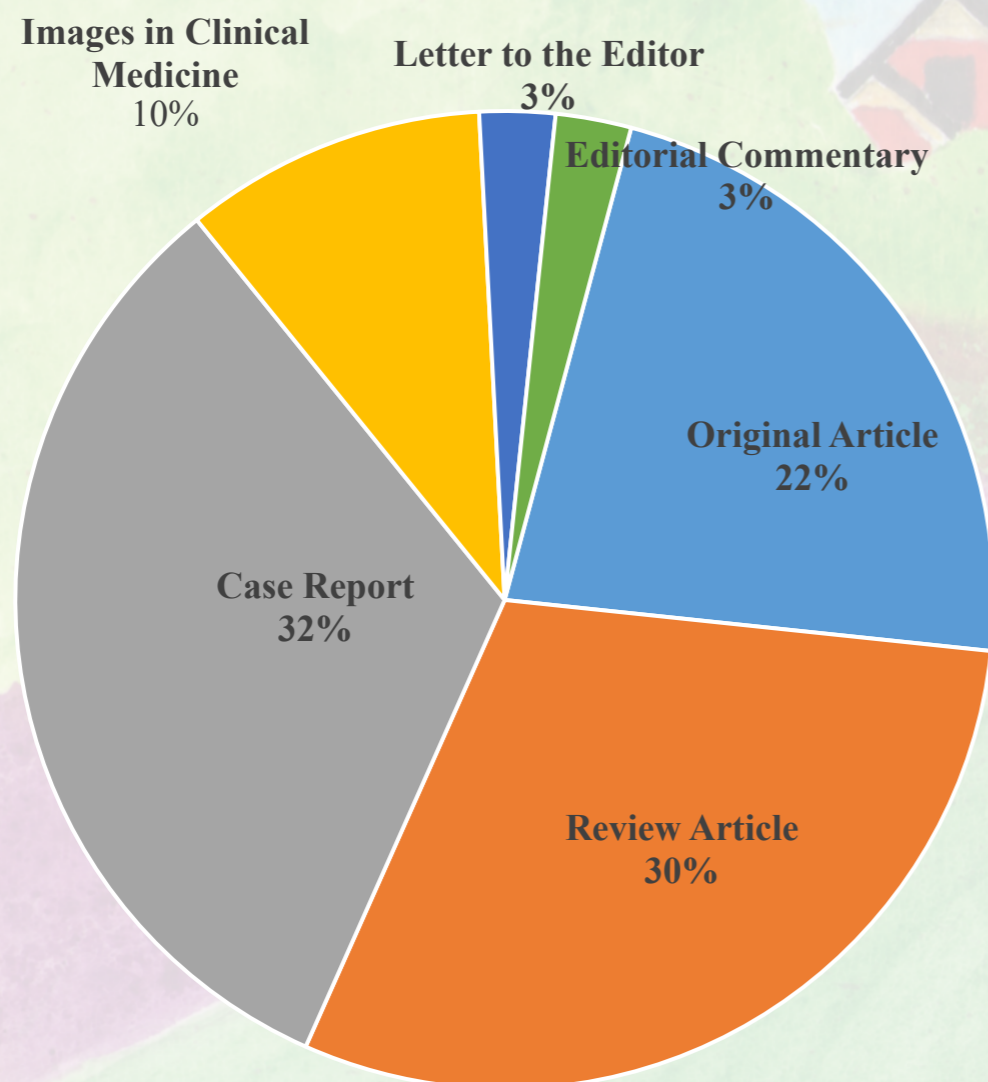
4. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members



All together **42 Members** from all over the world

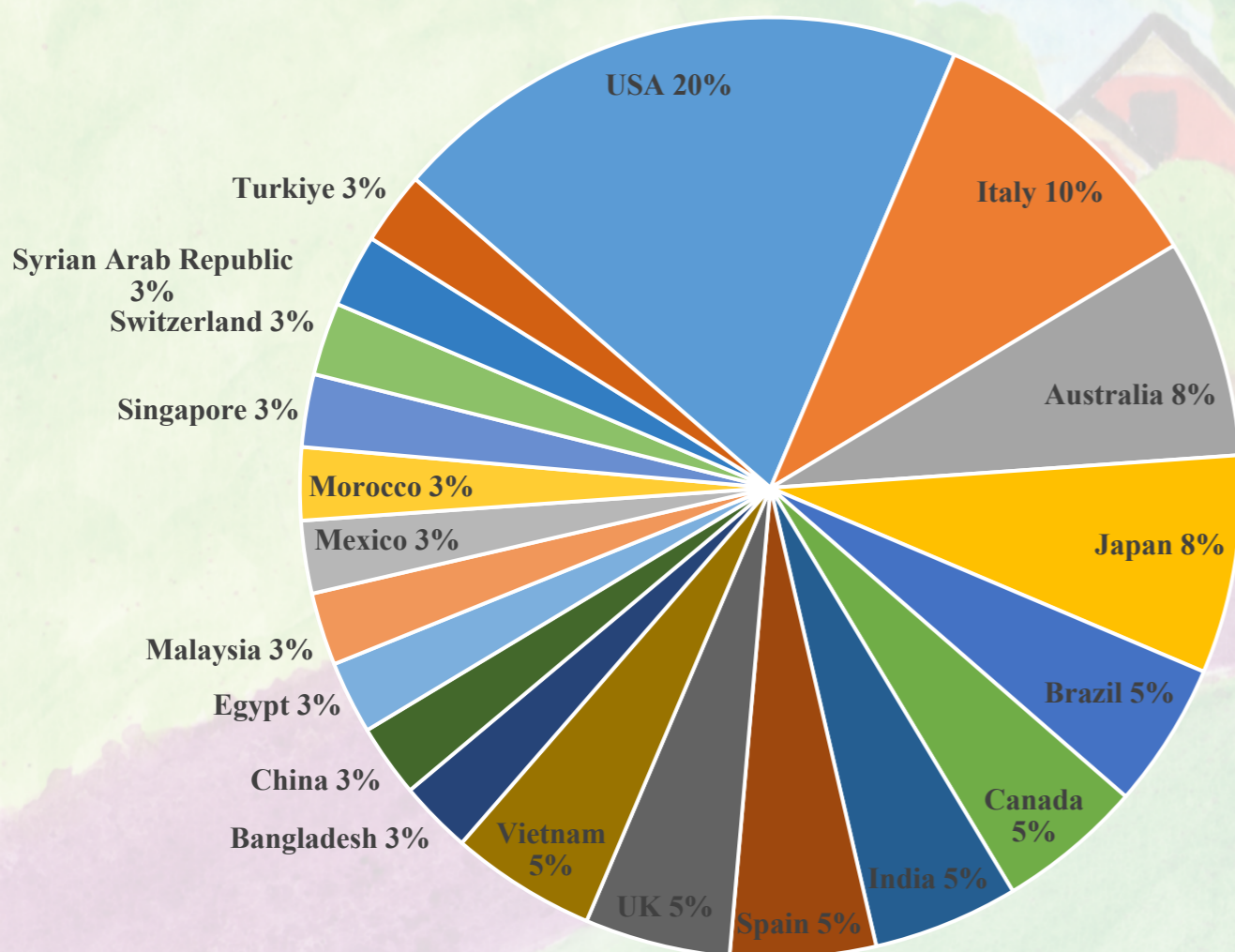

In 2025, AMJ has published **40 articles** in total, among which **32%** are case reports **30%** are review articles, and **22%** are original articles.

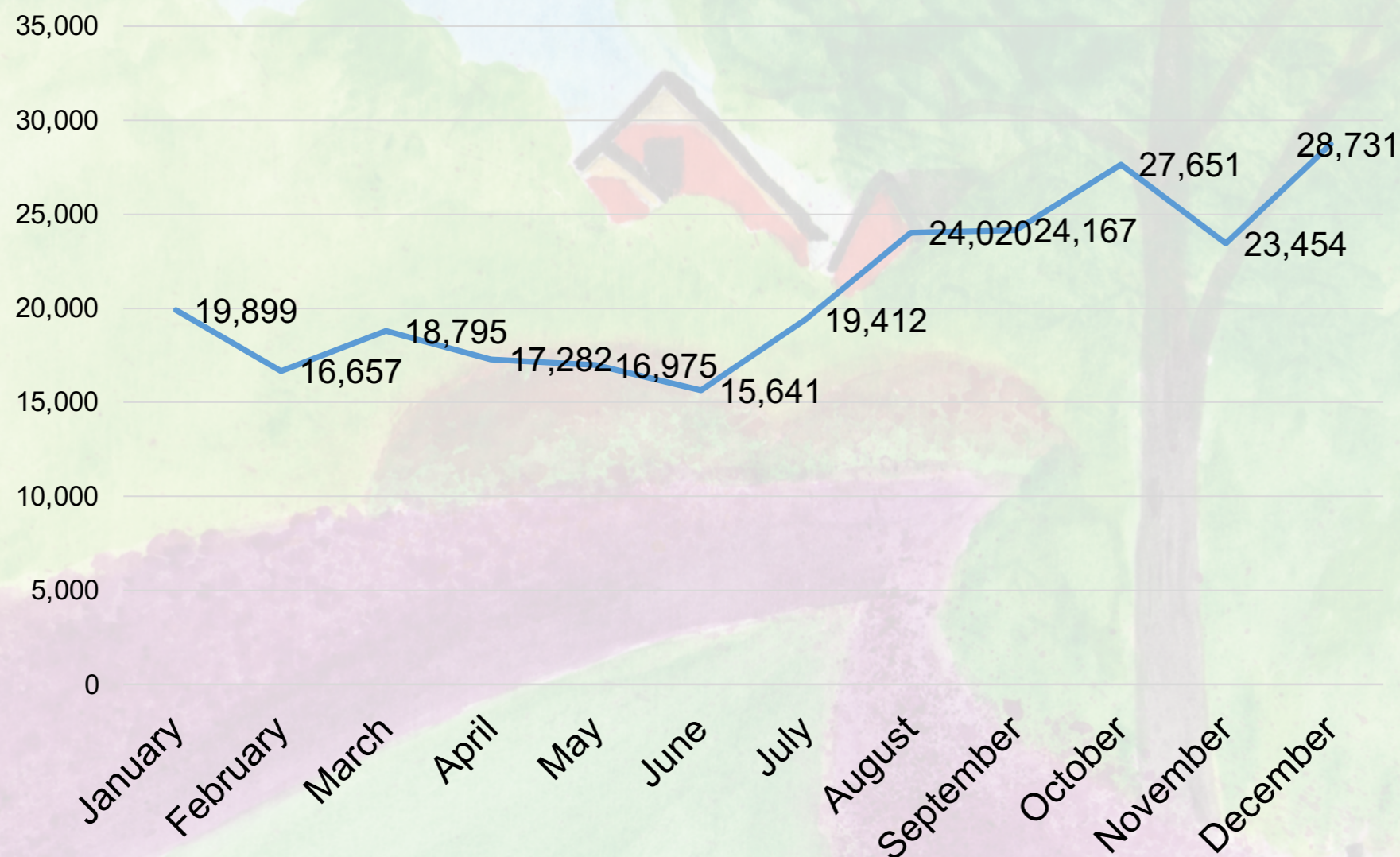
6. Geographic Distribution of Corresponding Authors

Among the **40** corresponding authors in 2025, **20% come from USA, 10% from Italy**, with the rest from 18 countries around the world.

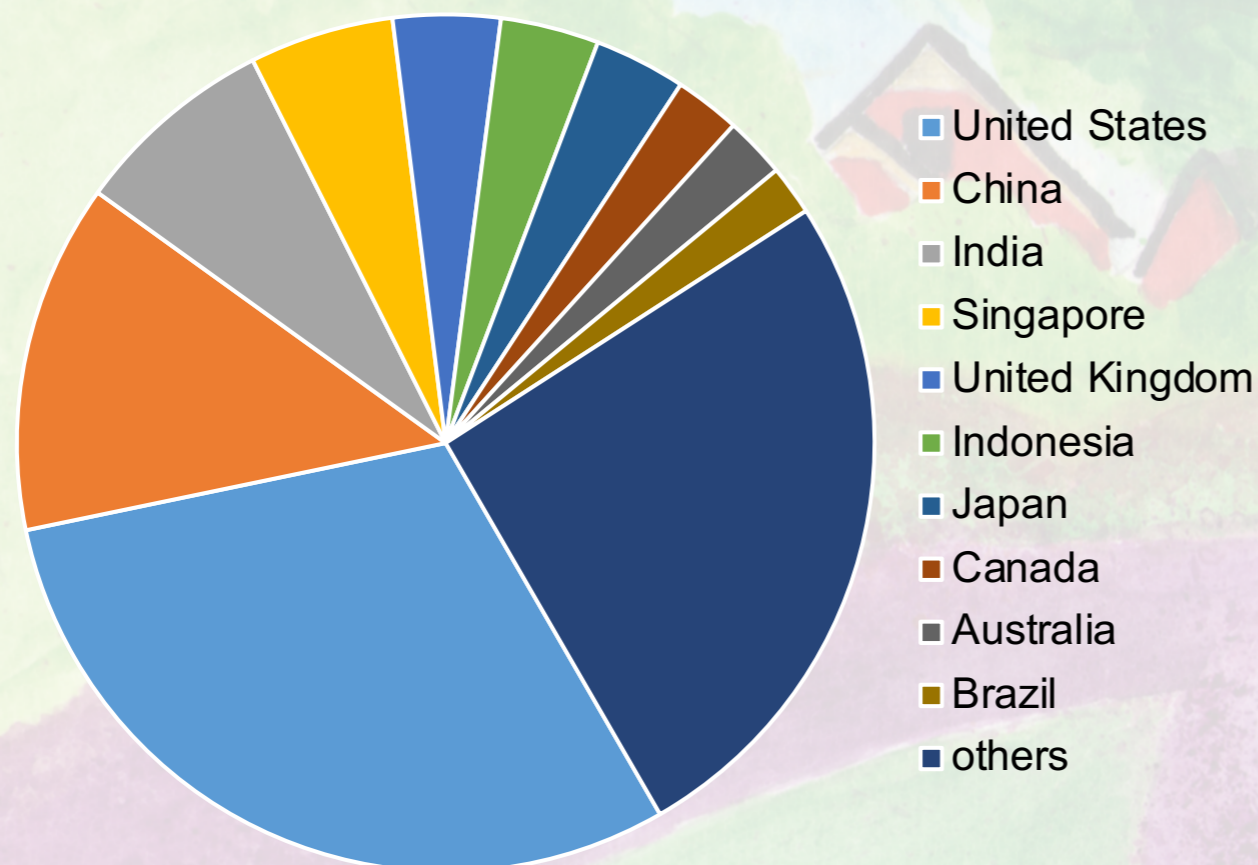
7. Pageviews of the Website in 2025
