





4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2024




In 2024, VATS published 43 articles, with 19 Review Article, 10 Case Report, 7 Surgical Technique, 4 Original Article and 3 Editorial.





5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2024




Corresponding authors of 43 articles published in 2024 came from 9 countries, with mostly from USA and Japan.




