


#### 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

#### 4. Number of Published Articles by Year




Number of published articles each year presents a upward tendency with 2021 reaching to 41 pieces in total.


#### 5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021



ABS published 41 articles in 2021, among which there are 59% of Review Articles, 24% of Original Articles, 10% of Case Reports.




### 6. Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021

#### 7. Pageviews from Google Analytics between 2020 and 2021






All together 43,793 visitors. Readers who visited ABS website were from diverse countries, with the majority from the USA, followed by the UK, India, Australia, Canada and China.
