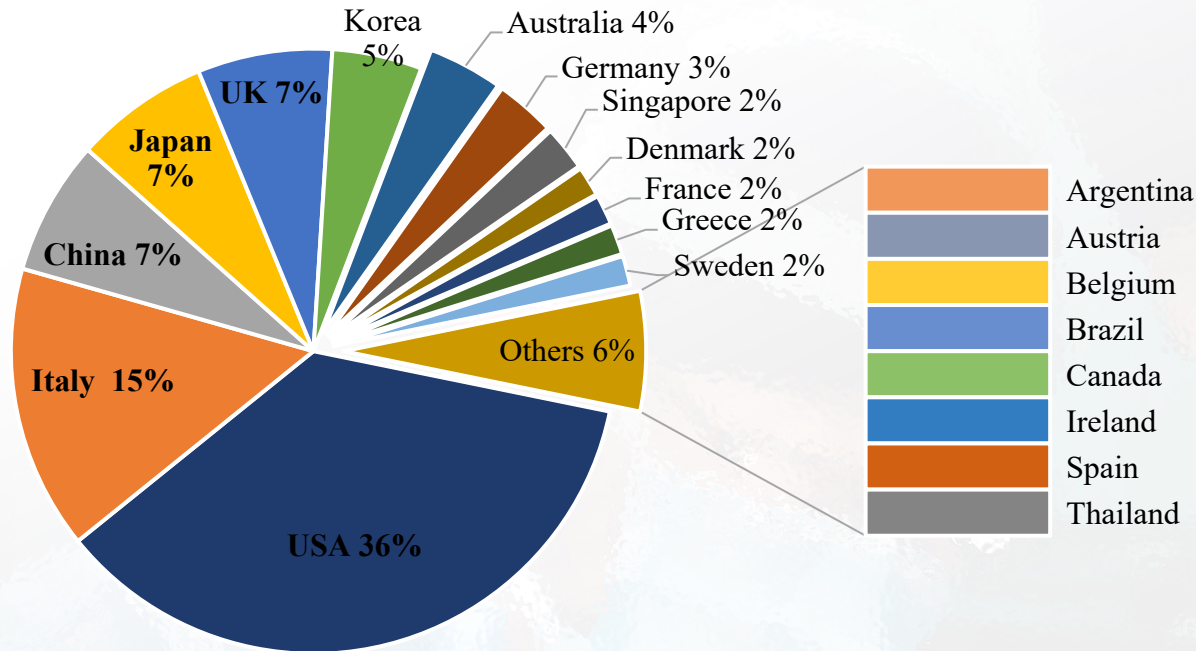

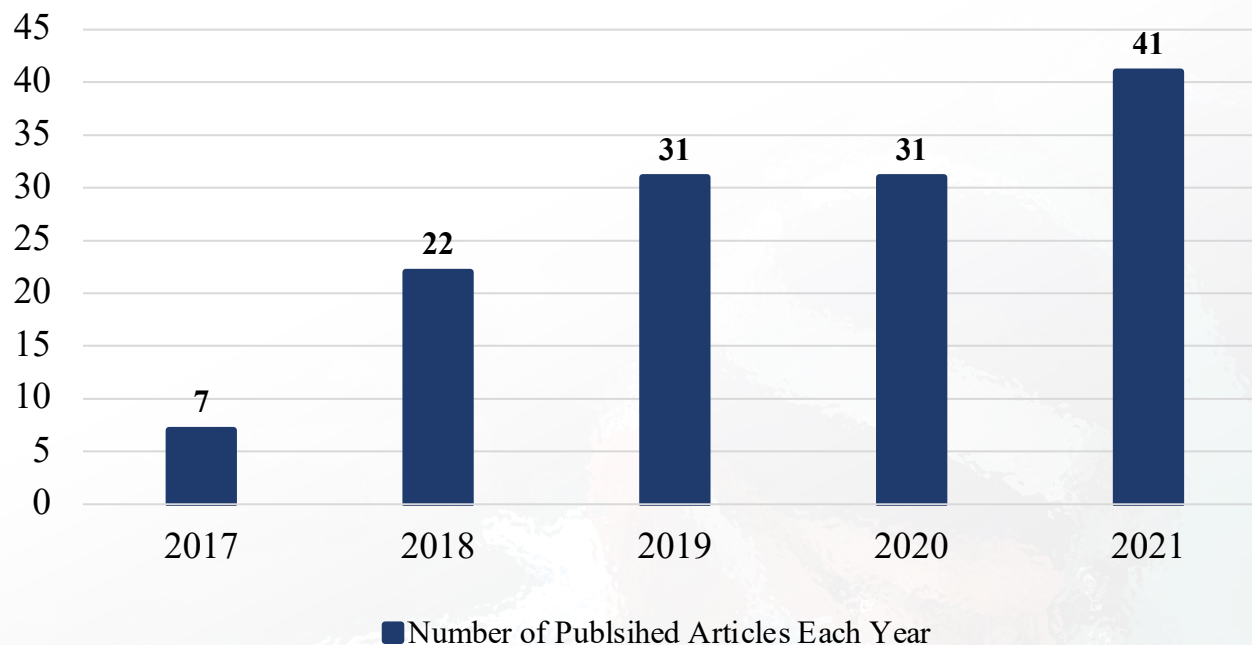

125 current editorial board members come from **21** countries, among who there are **36%** from **the USA**, followed by **Italy, China, Japan and the UK**.



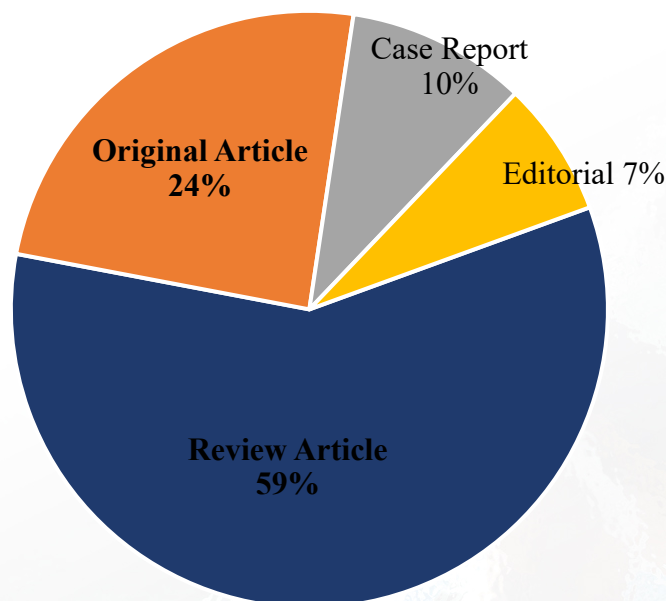
4. Number of Published Articles by Year

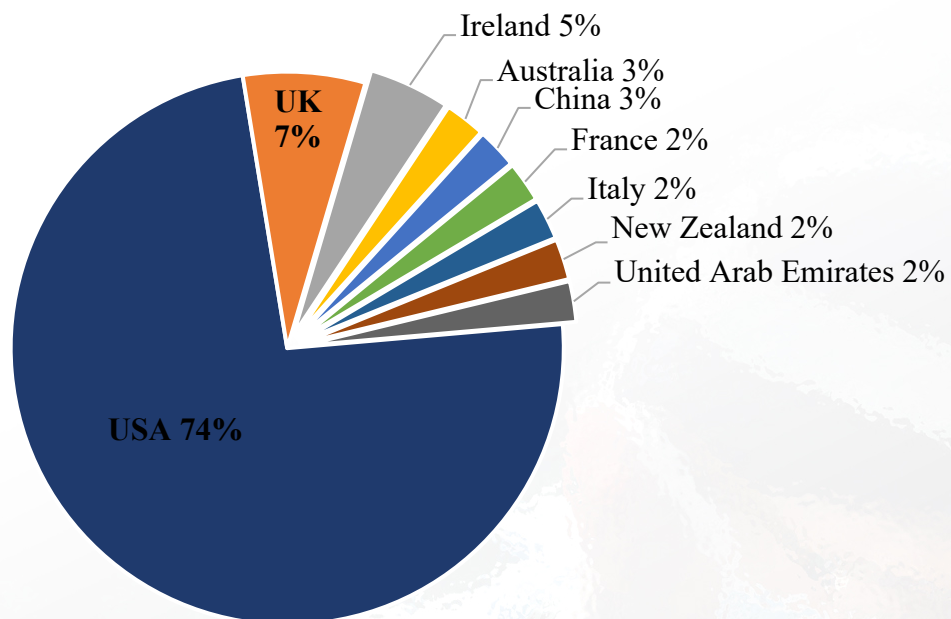
5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021

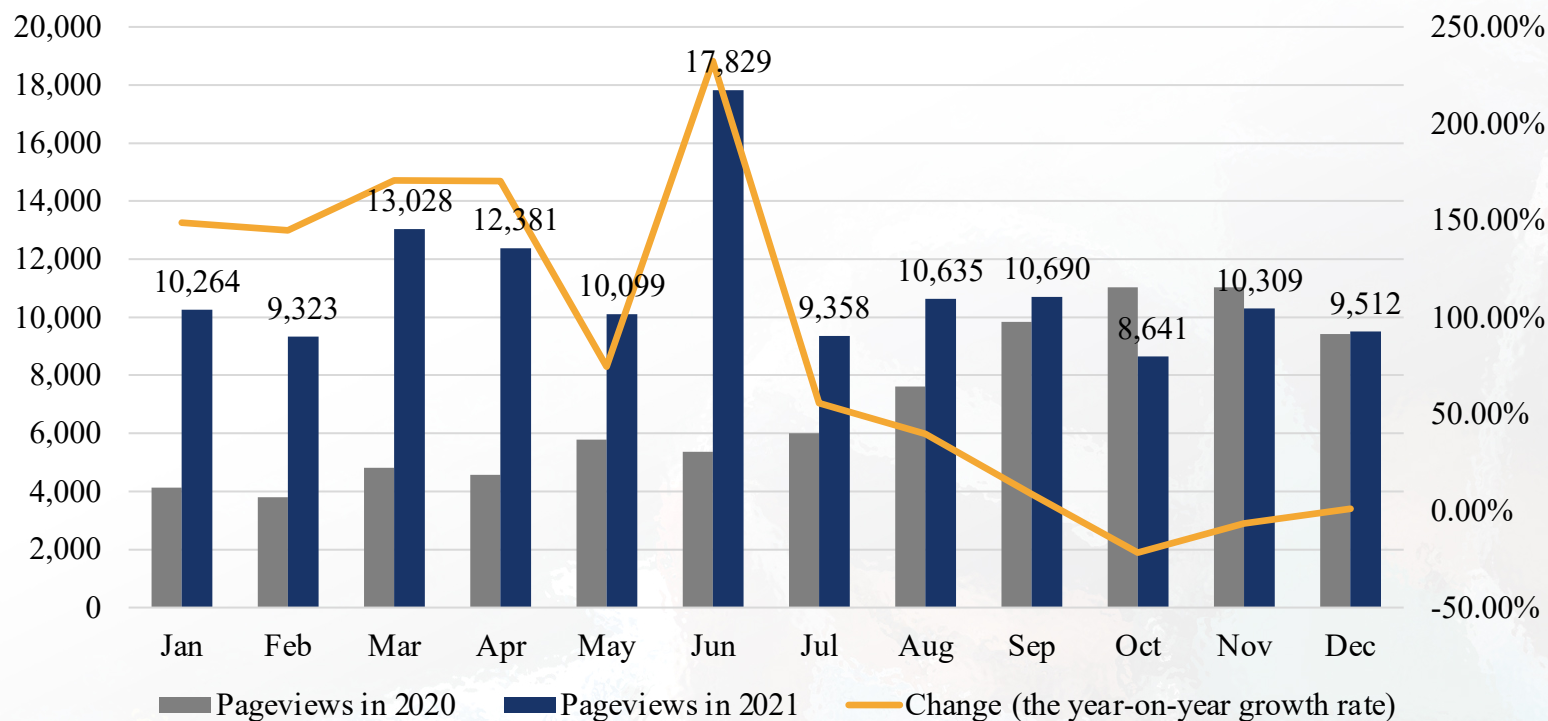
6. Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021

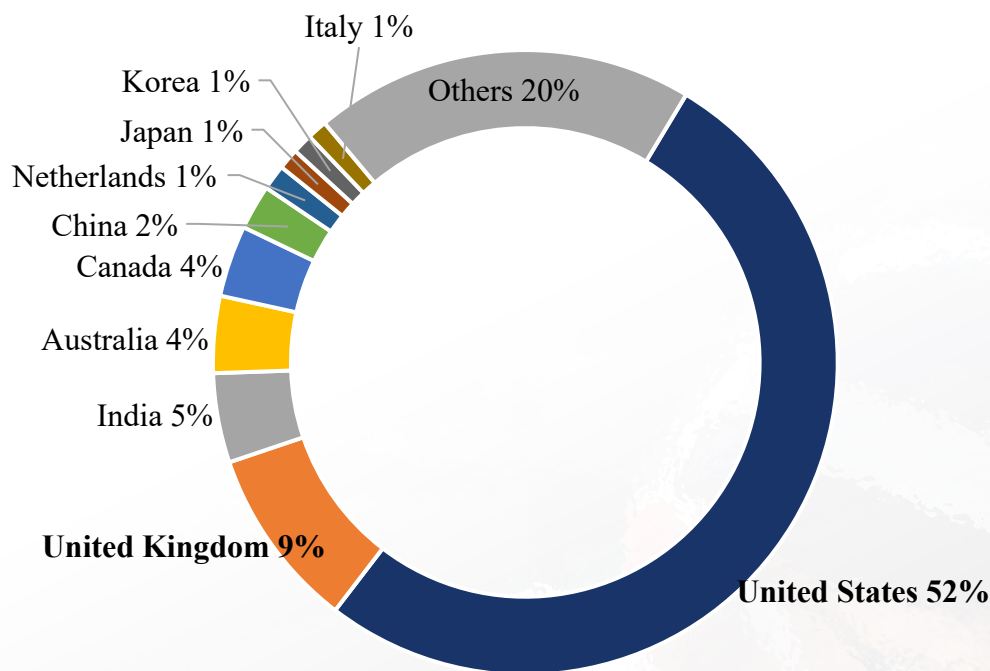
7. Pageviews from Google Analytics between 2020 and 2021

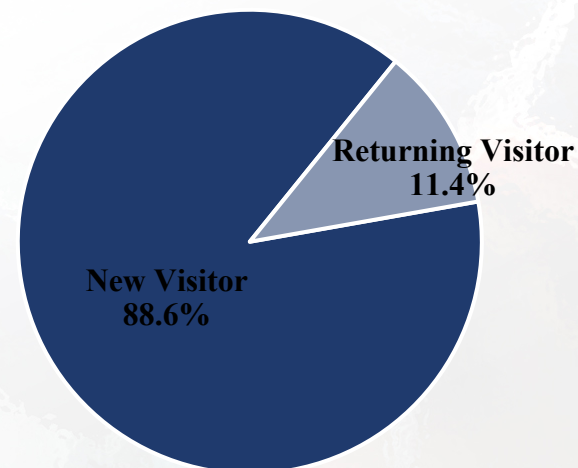
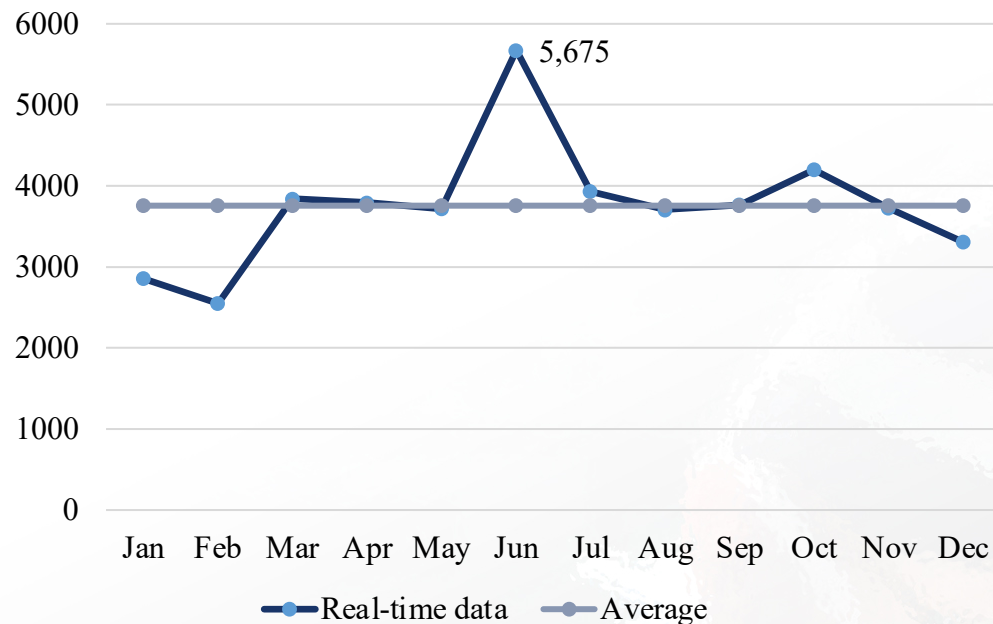
