







4. Number of Published Articles by Year




• Number of published articles each year presents a upward tendency with 2020 reaching to 31 pieces in total.

5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2020




ABS published 31 articles in 2020, among which there are 23% of Original Articles, 35% of Review Articles, 29% of Case Reports.




In 2020, The website users of ABS reached 26,894 in total. Above is a vivid map representing sessions from different countries, with the USA, UK and China ranking the top three among the list.
