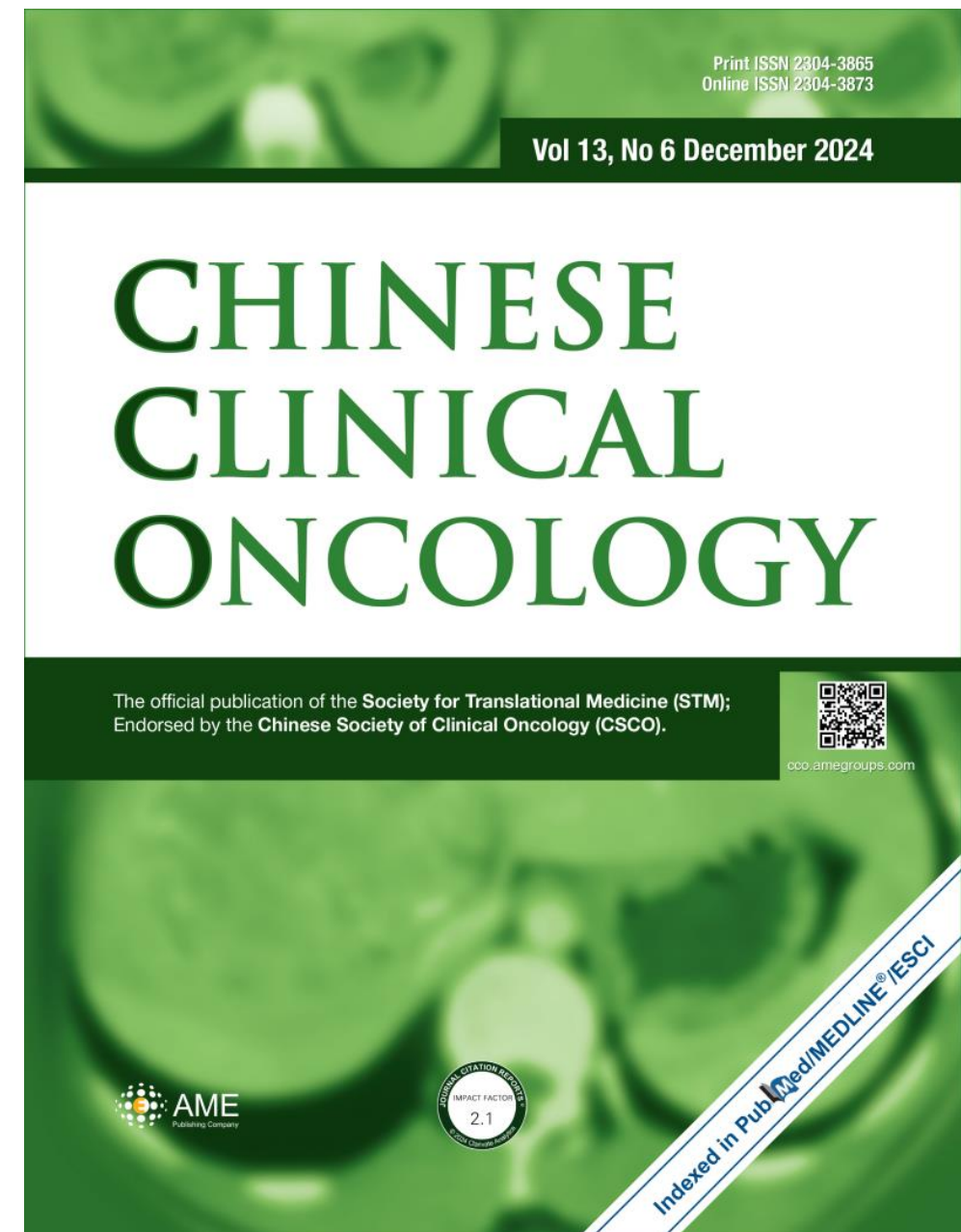

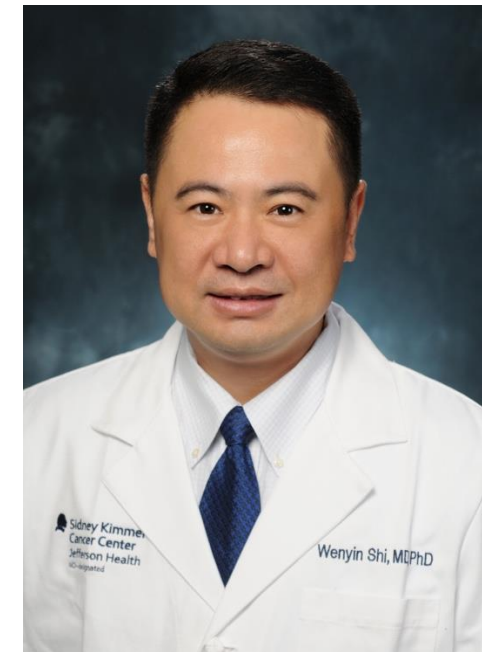

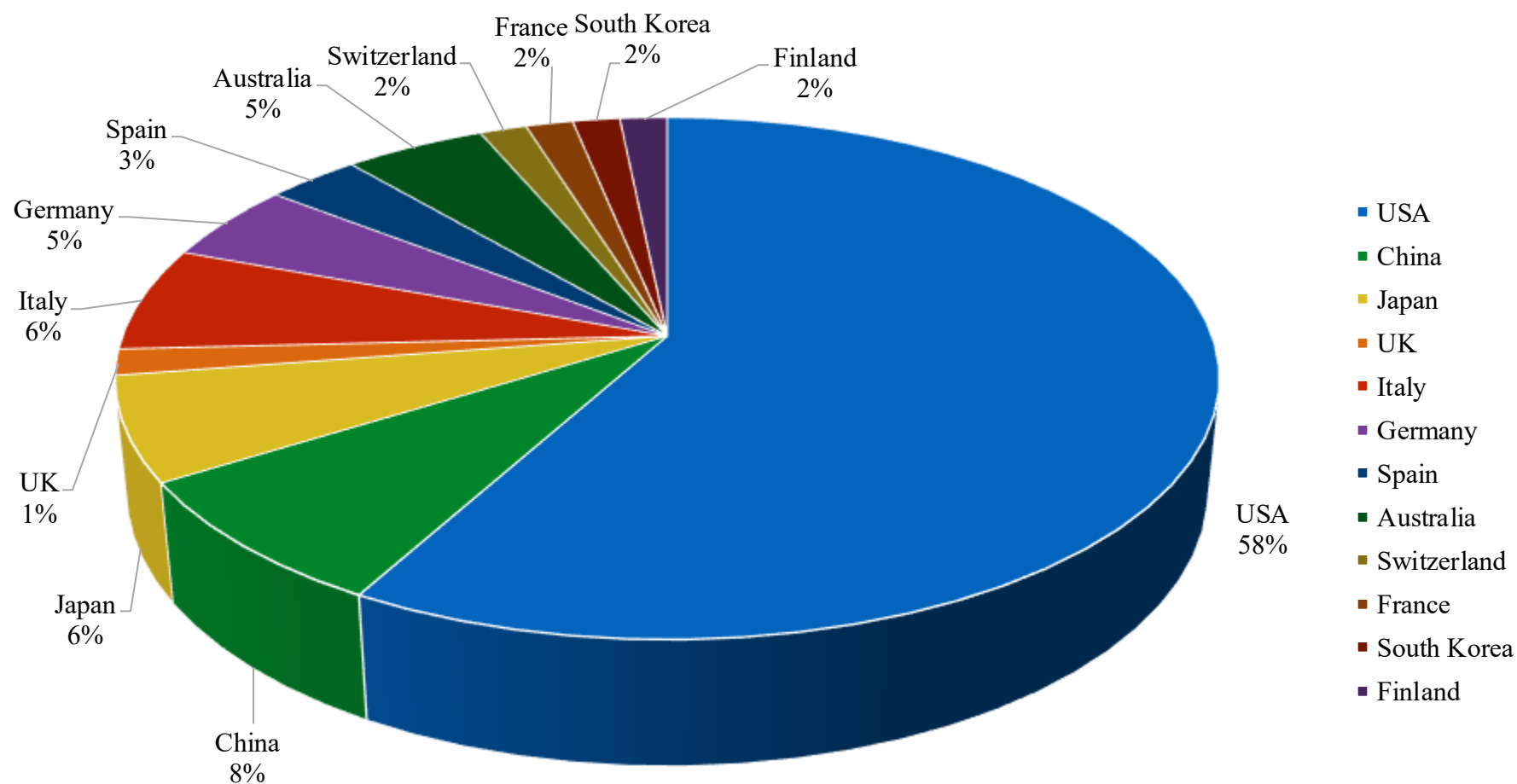

### 3. Geographical Distribution of Editorial Board Members

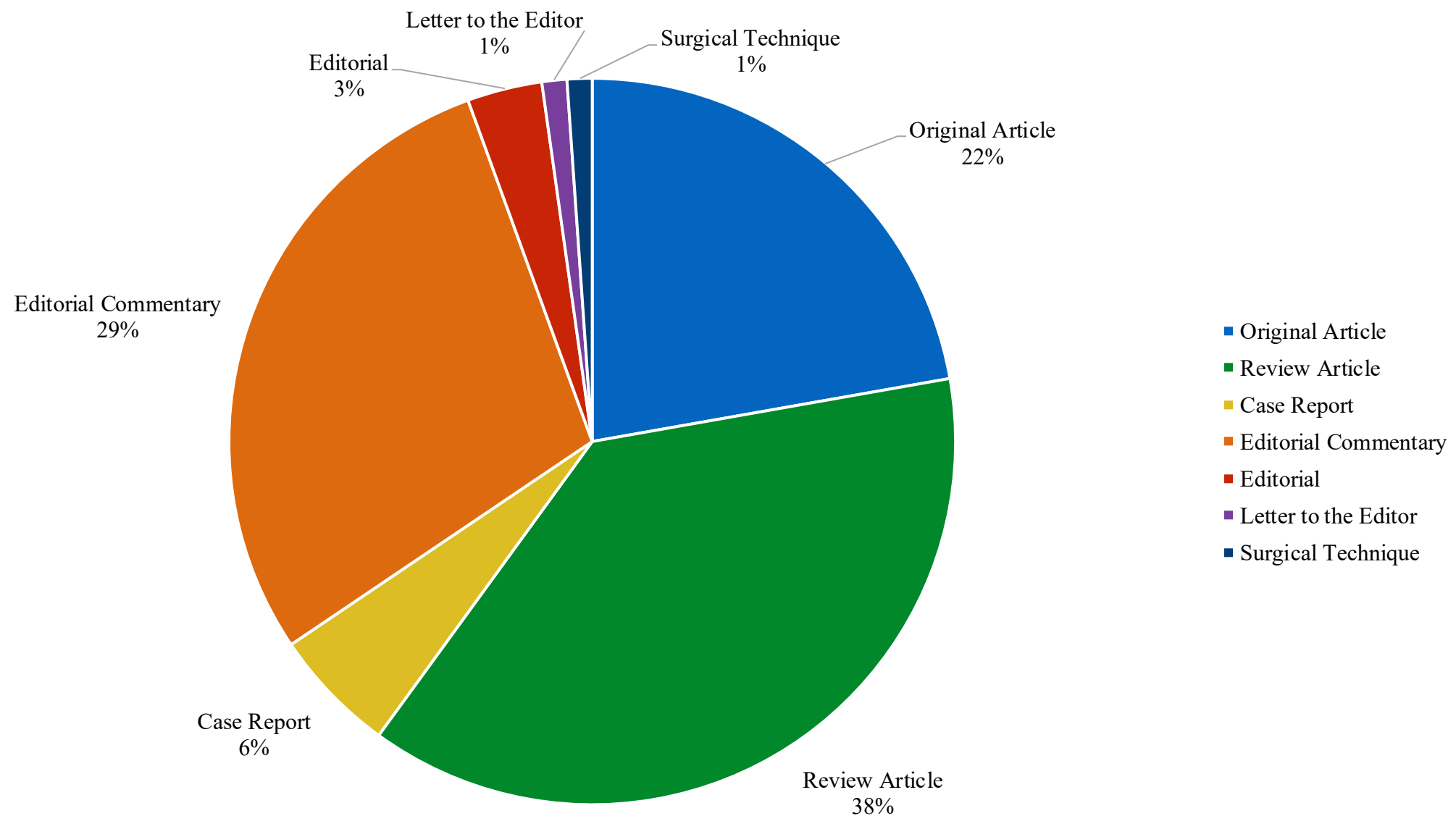
62 CCO editorial board members come from 12 countries/regions, most of whom were from the USA, followed by China, Japan, Italy, and Germany, etc.





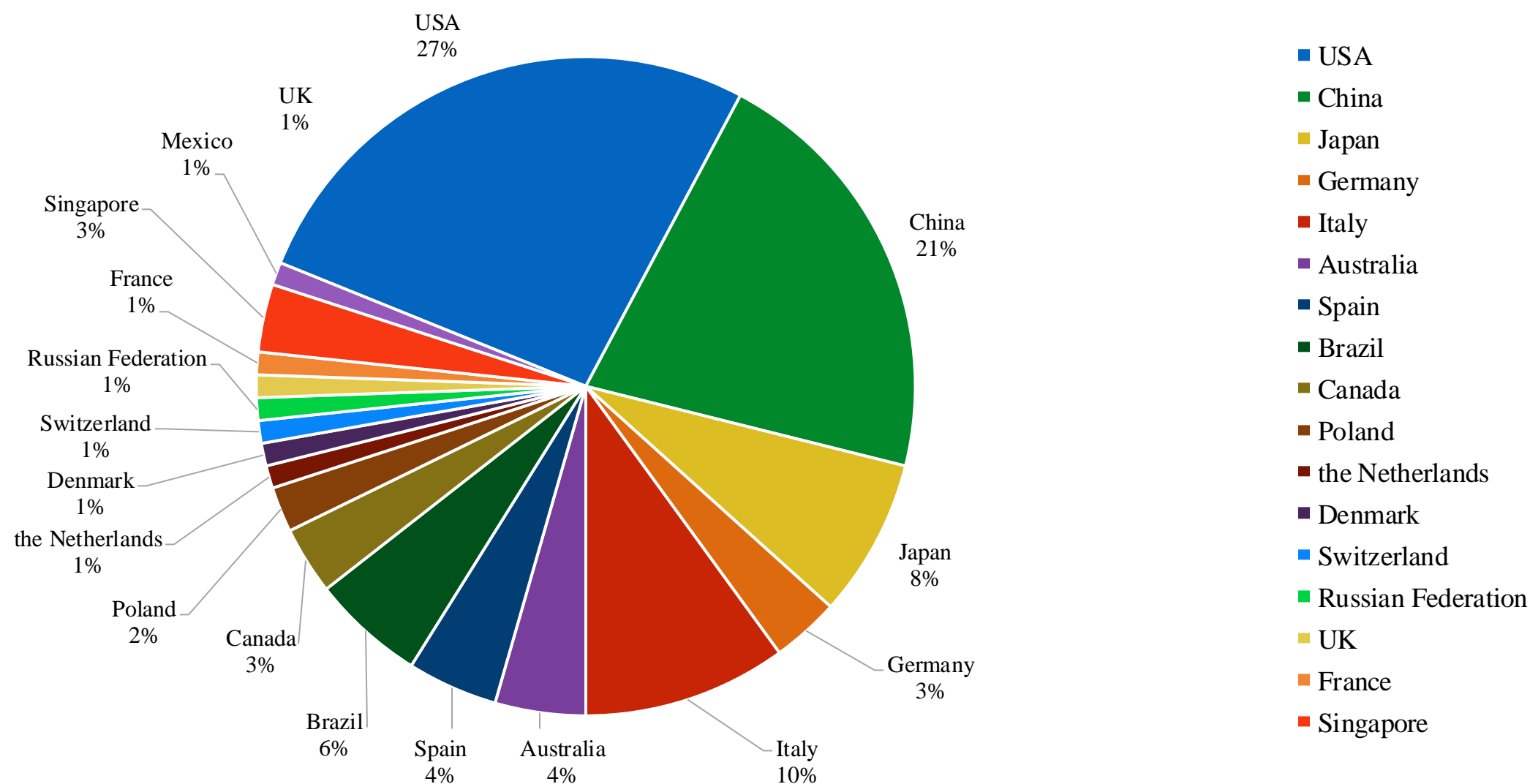
## 4. Types of Articles Published in 2024

In 2024, CCO has published a total of **90 manuscripts**, including **34 Review Articles** and **20 Original Articles** in total.

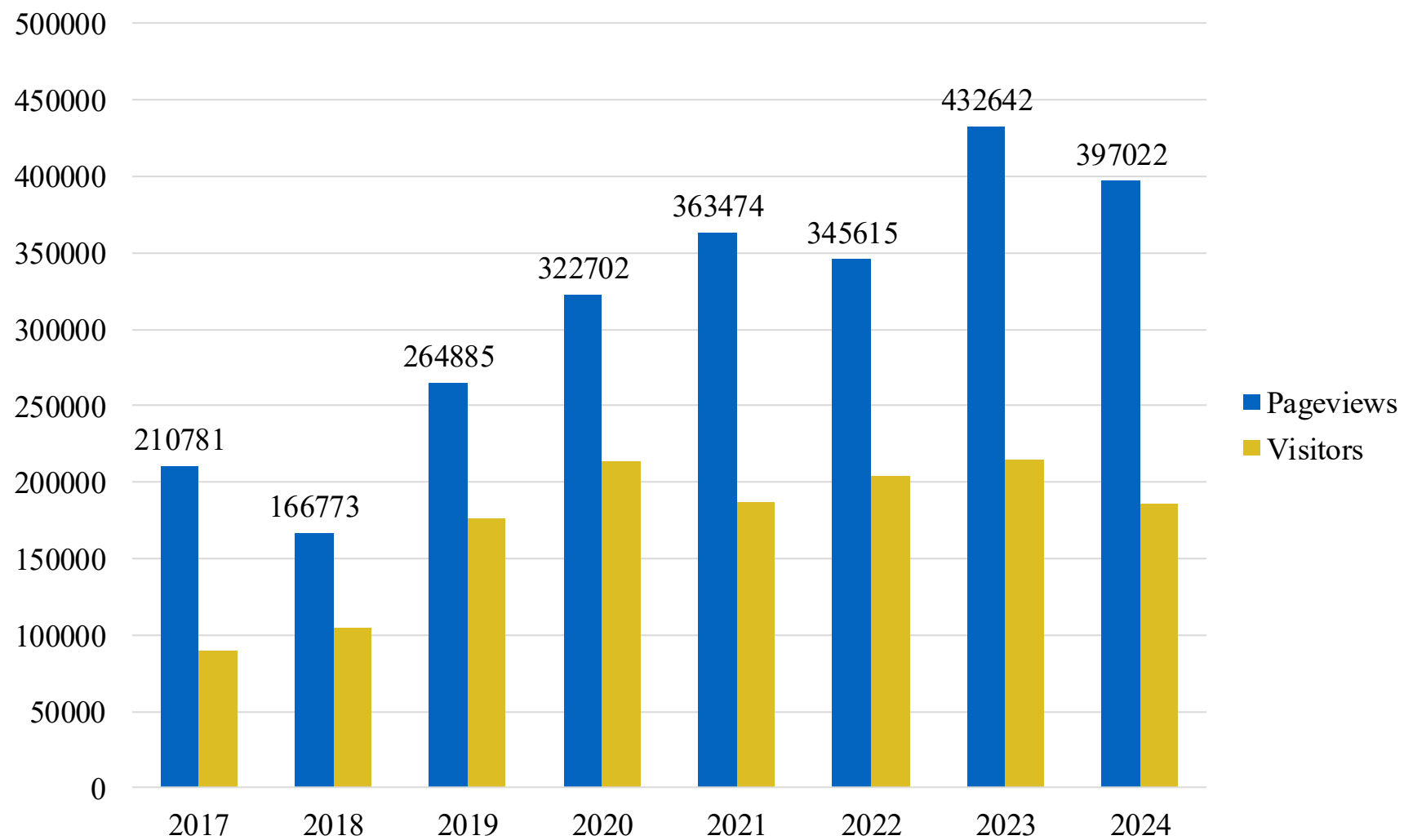


## 5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2024

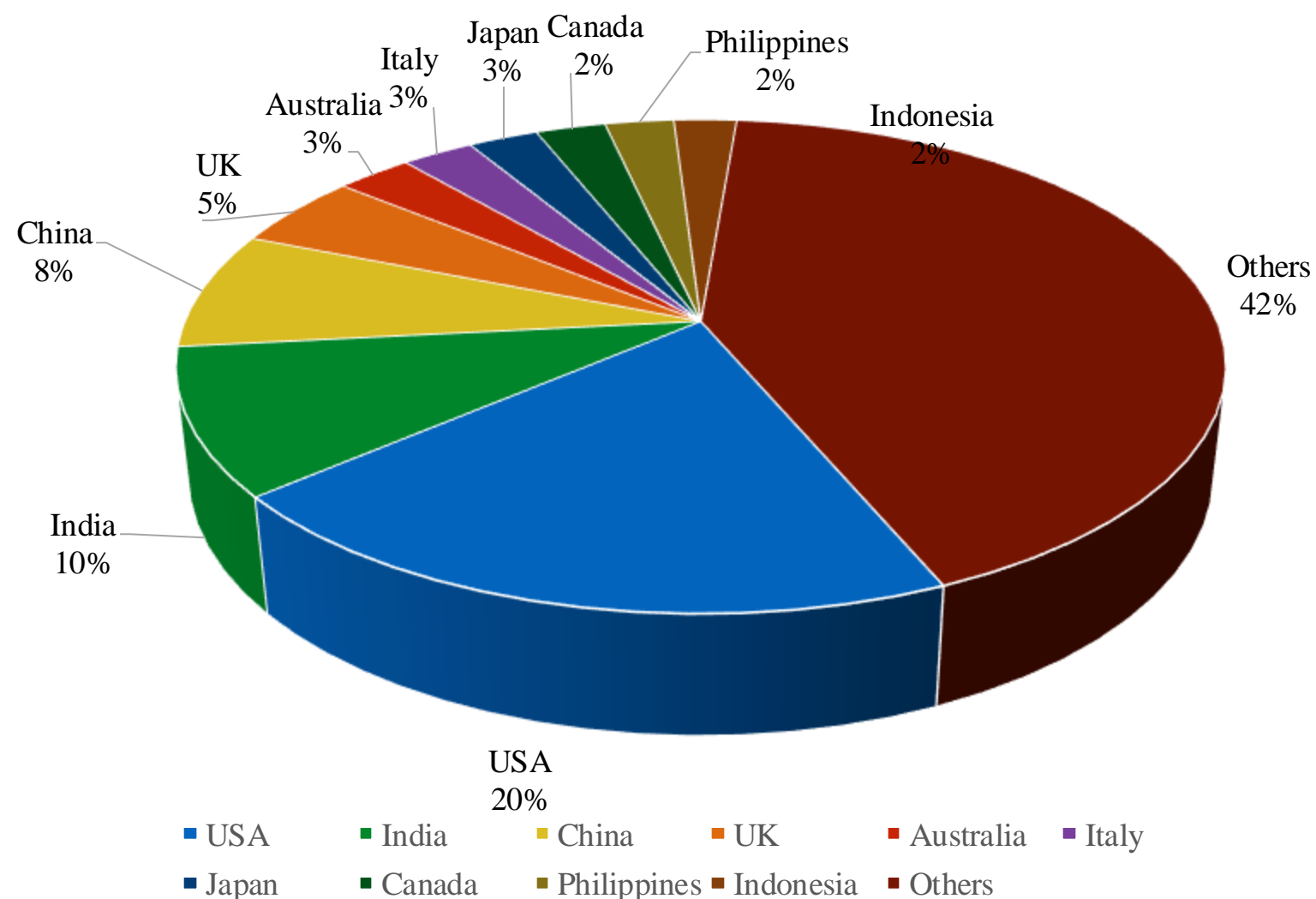


## 6. Website Visits until 2024 (results by year)

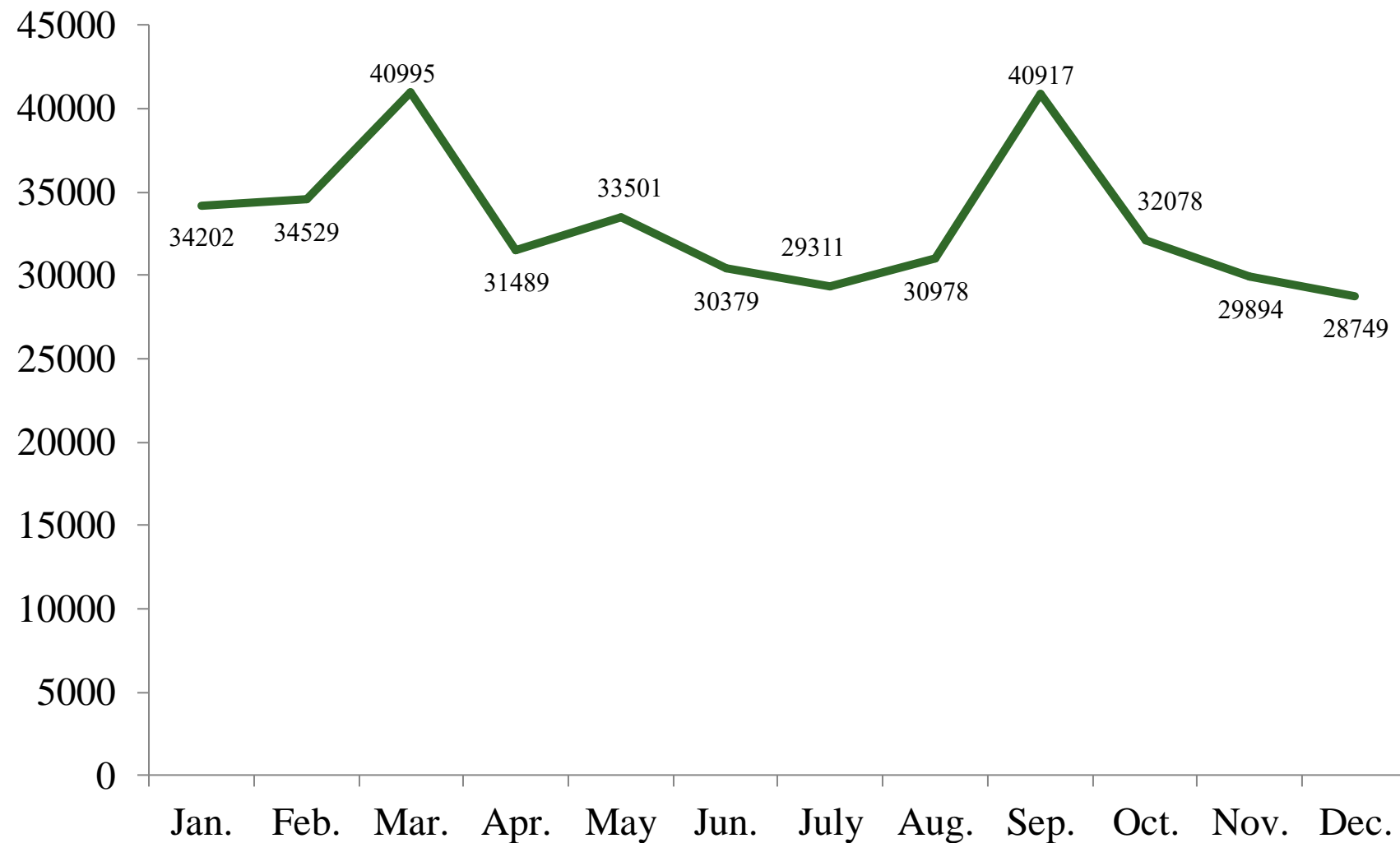

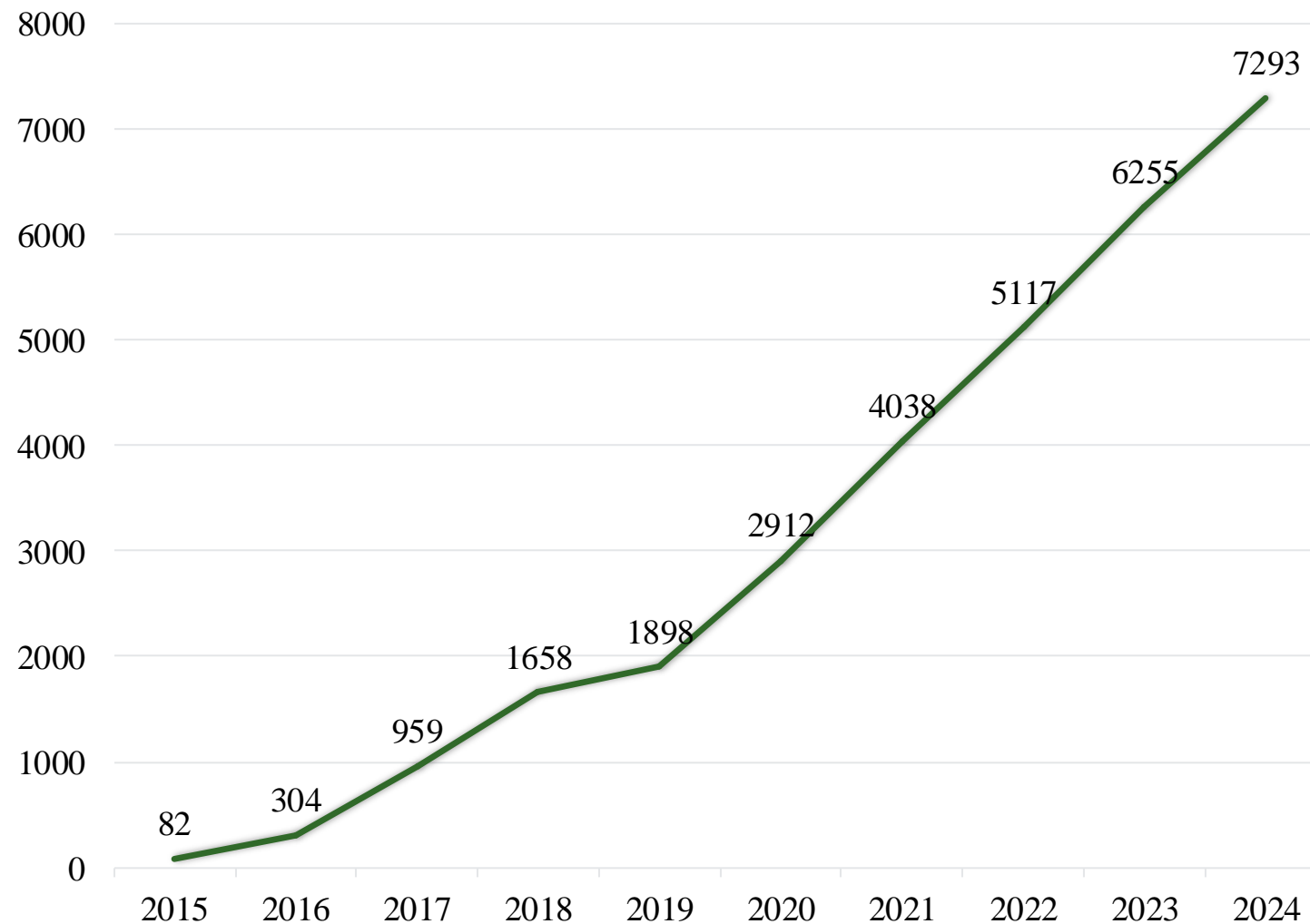
