




1. General Information of the Journal

2. Message from the Editor-in-Chief



Mediastinum's editorial board comprises 47 members from 15 countries, with the largest proportion from the USA (34%), followed by Japan (21%).






4. Published Articles by Year

From 2017 to 2024, a total of 343 articles were published.




5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2024



In 2024, Mediastinum published a diverse range of 54 articles, with the majority of Review Articles (54%).




6. International Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2024


