

> Distribution of Editorial Board Members




74 JLPM editorial board members come from 21 countries, among who there are 22% from the Italy, followed by USA, UK, Spain and etc.





3. Diverse Types of Articles Published between Jan. 2021 and Dec. 2021




Since Jan. 2021, JLPM has published a total of 32 articles, among which there are 15 Review Articles and 7 Original Articles.





4. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors between Jan. 2020 and Dec. 2021




Corresponding authors of 32 articles published in 2021 come from 13 countries, among who there are 25% from UK, followed by China, Italy, Australia and etc.






6. Pageviews between Jan. 2021 and Dec. 2021
