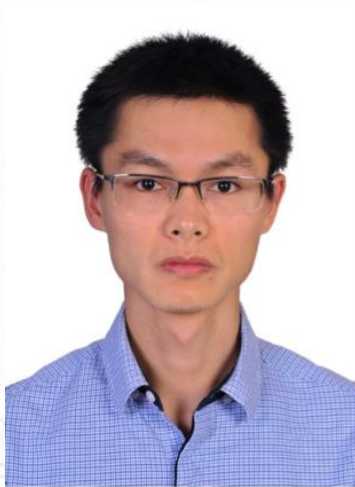

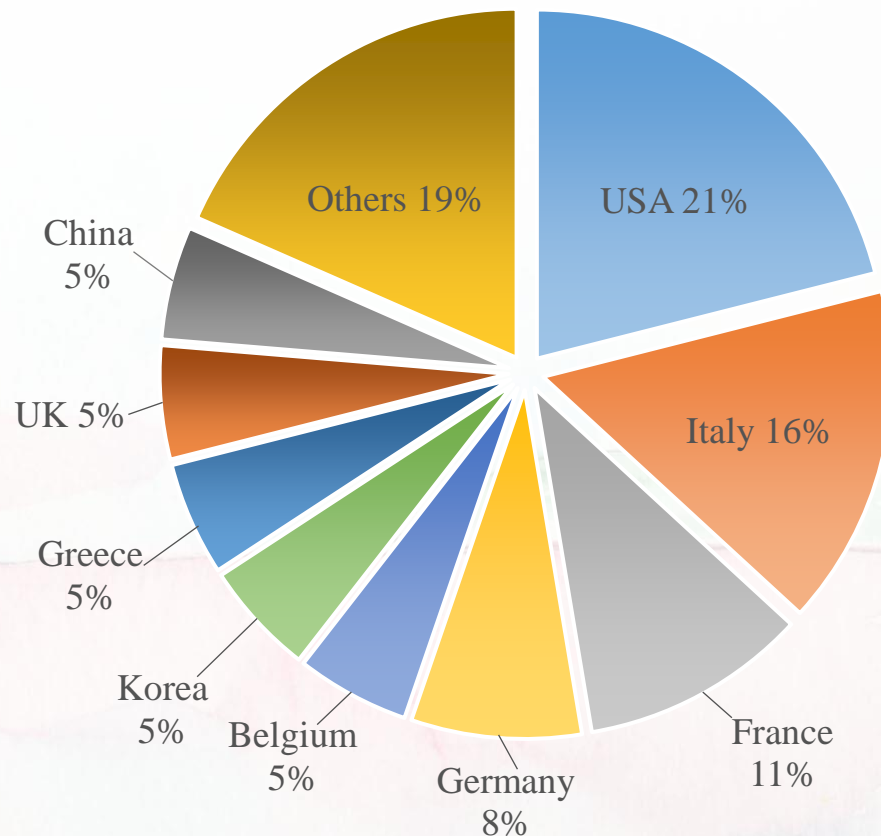

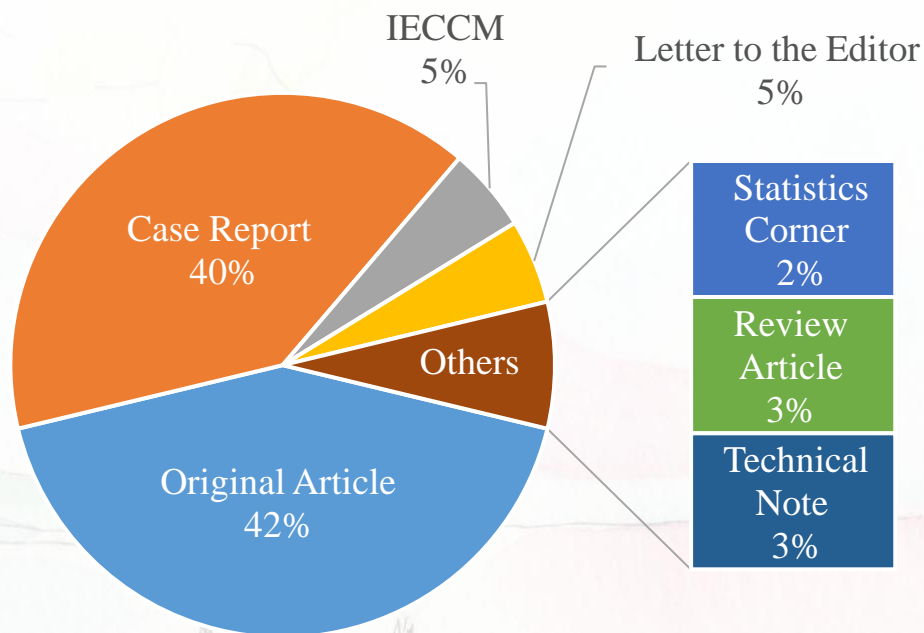
3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2021

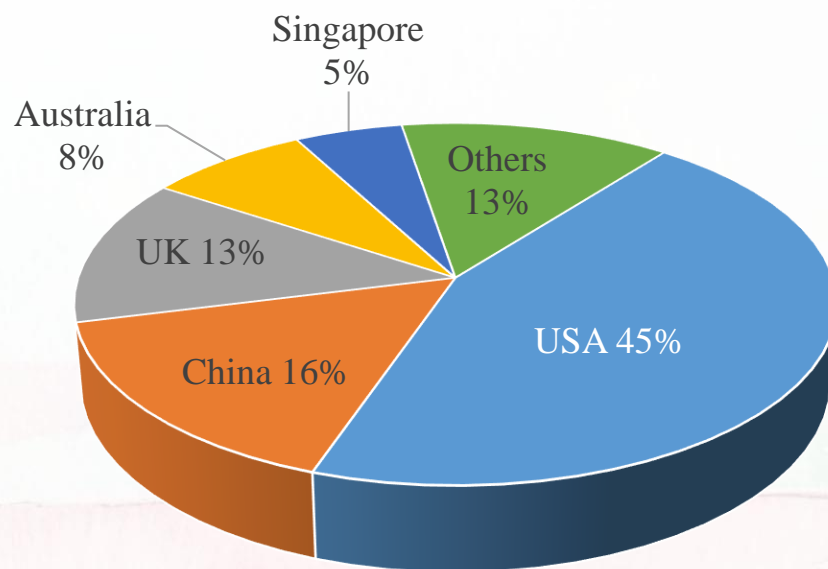

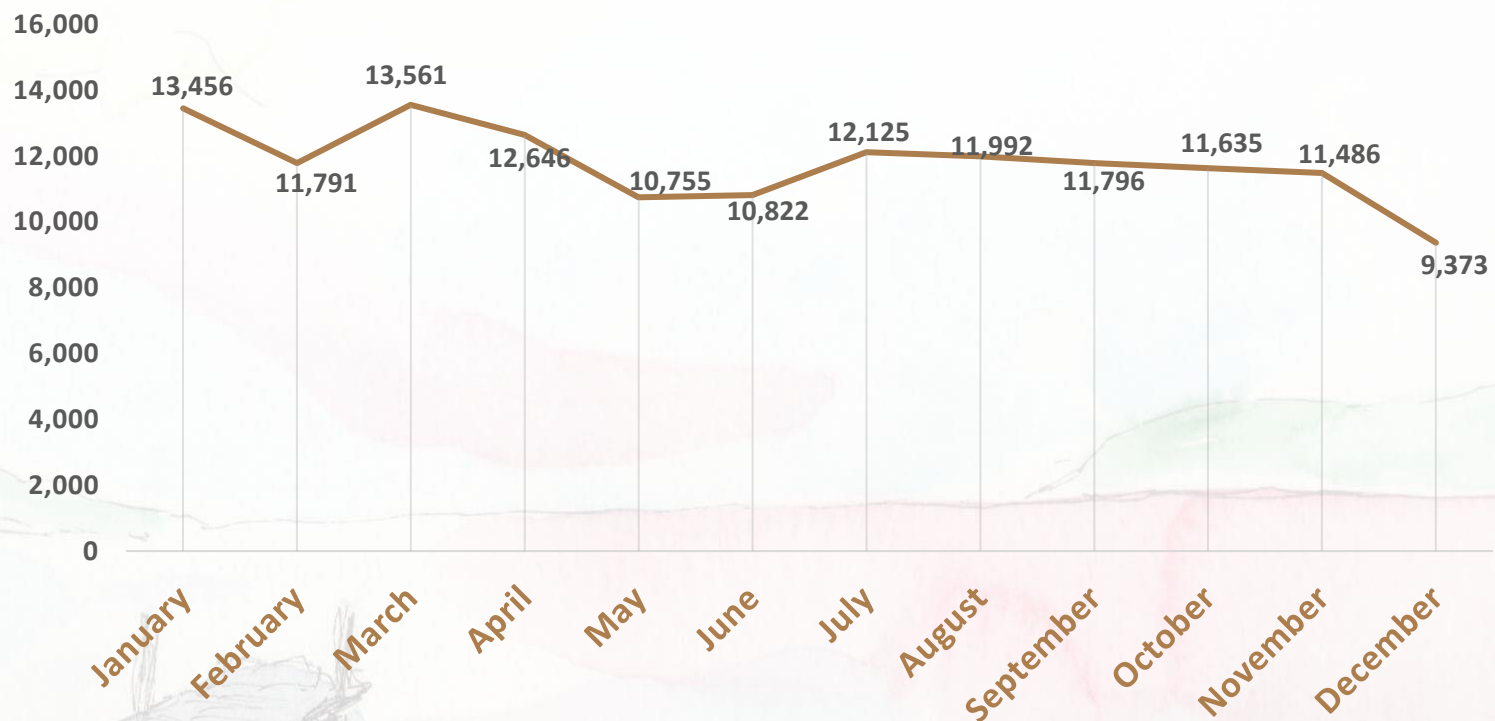
5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021
