



GPM's Editorial Board includes 79 members from 18 countries, with the majority from China, Italy, and the USA.



4. Number of Published Articles (Results by Year)




GPM has published a total of 197 articles since its launch in 2018.







5. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2023





6. International Distribution of Corresponding Authors in 2023




A total of 35 corresponding authors from 7 countries were identified in 2023, with the majority from the China (63%), followed by USA (17%).

The website pageviews of GPM have consistently increased from 2018 to 2022, but experienced a decline in 2023.






