



#### 3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members (2022)




All together 84 members from 18 countries, with a majority from China, Italy, and USA.

#### 4. Number of Published Articles (Results by Year)




GPM has published **162 articles** since its launch in 2018.



#### 6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022




Corresponding authors of 36 articles in 2022 came from 9 countries, with a majority from China and Italy.

Website pageviews of GPM have increased remarkably since its launch in 2018, reaching 120,264 in 2022.










#### 13. 2022 Masters of Gynecologic Surgery
