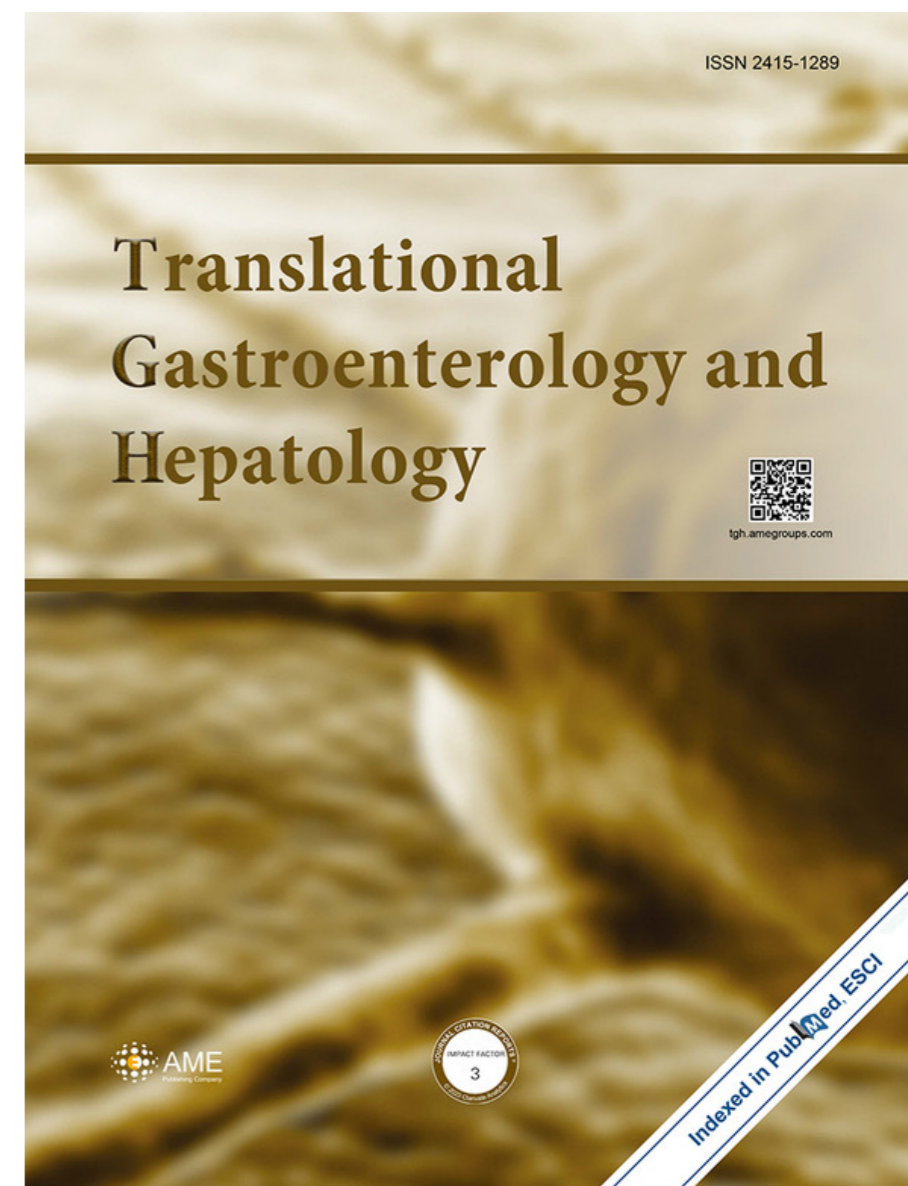

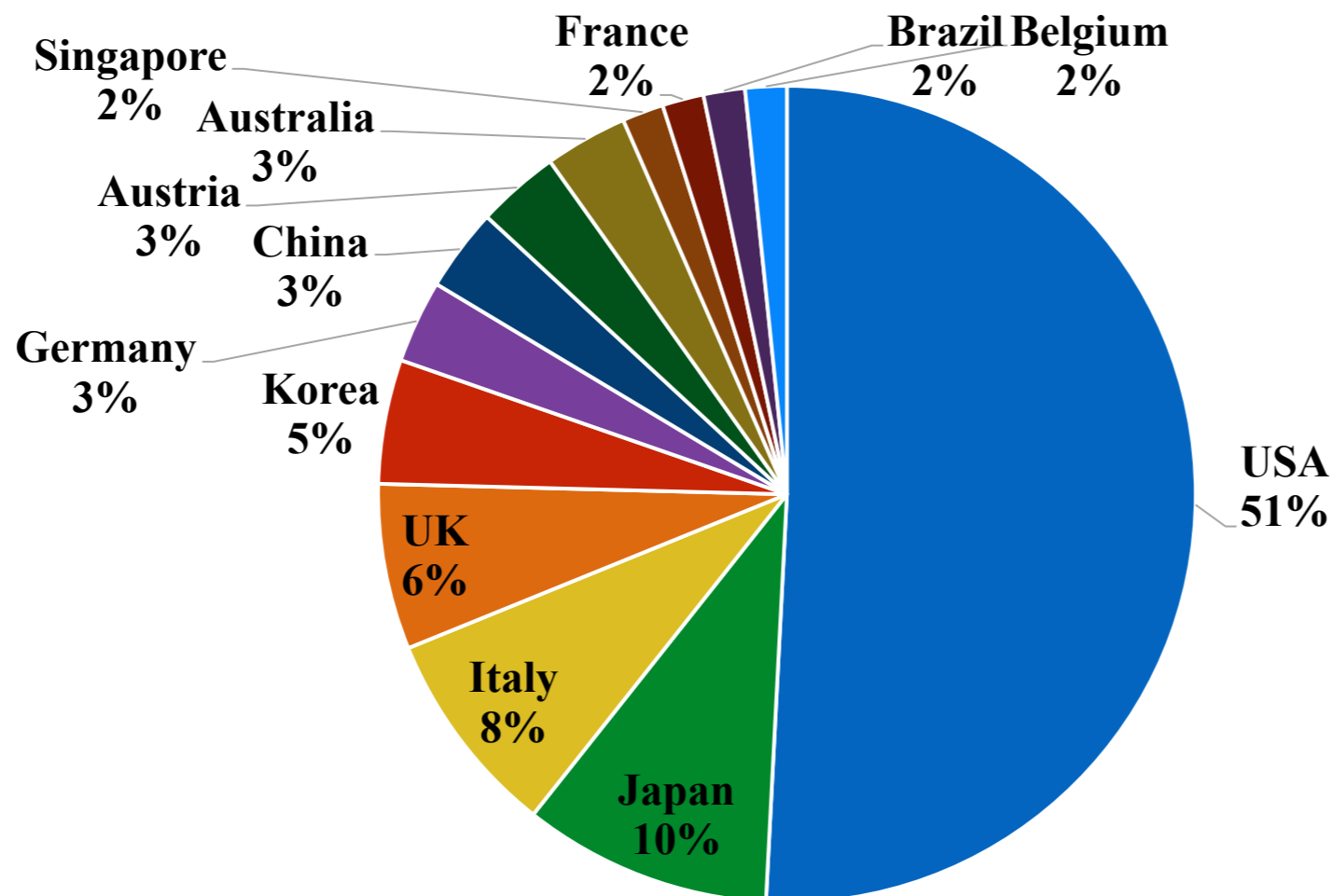

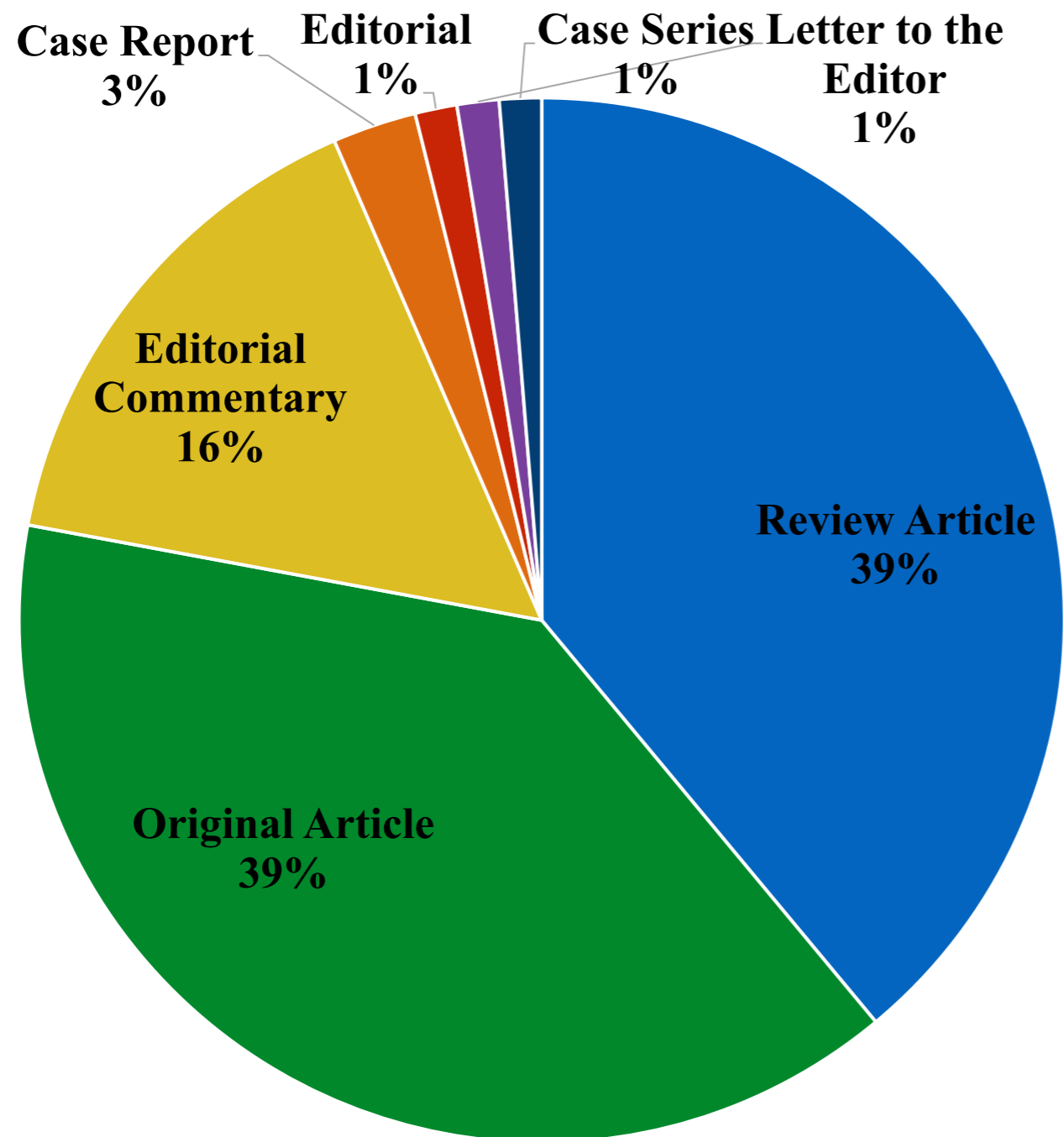
### 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

In 2024, TGH had **61** Editorial Board Members from **13 countries**, with the majority from USA (51%).

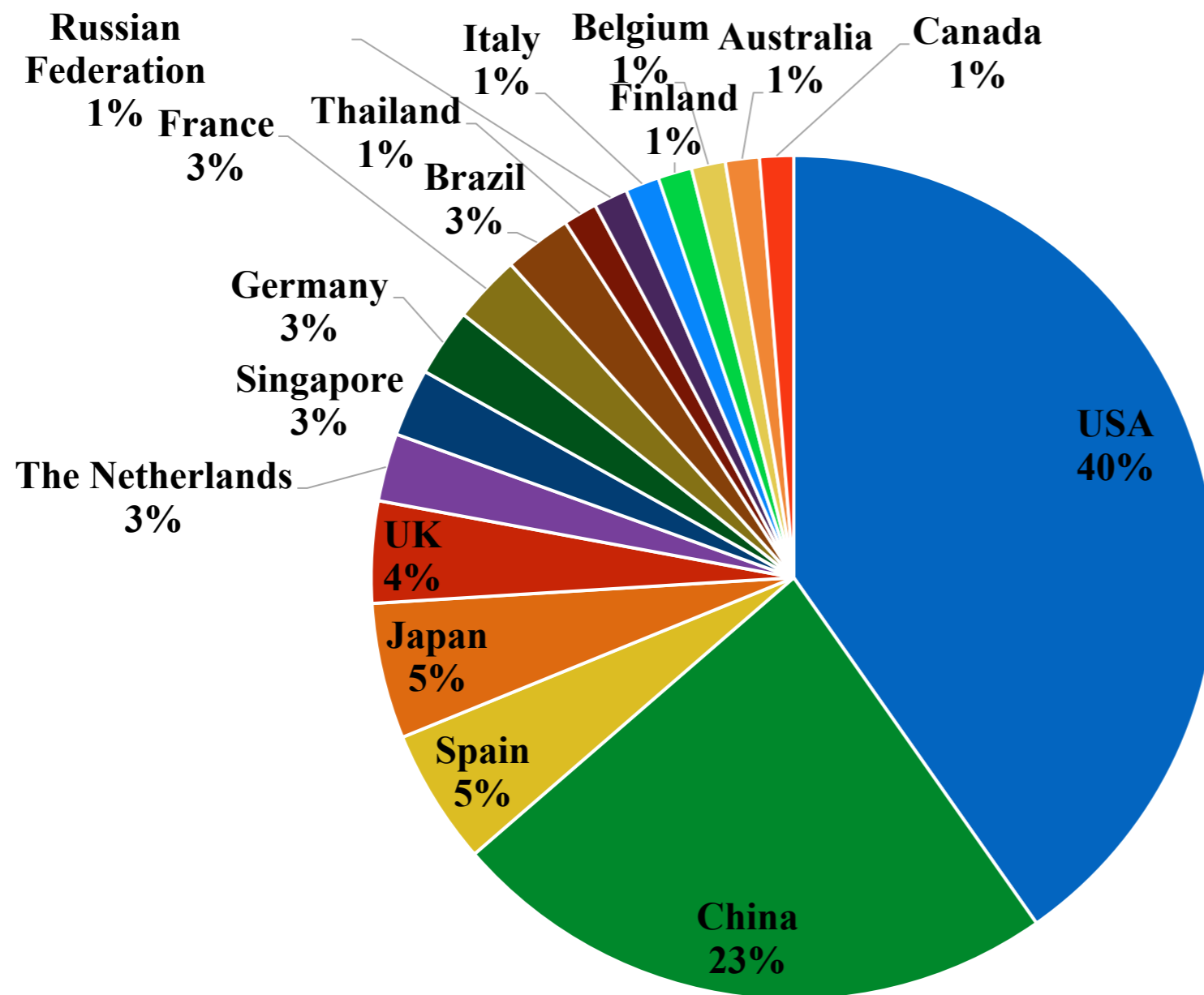
## 4. Diverse Type of Articles Published in 2024

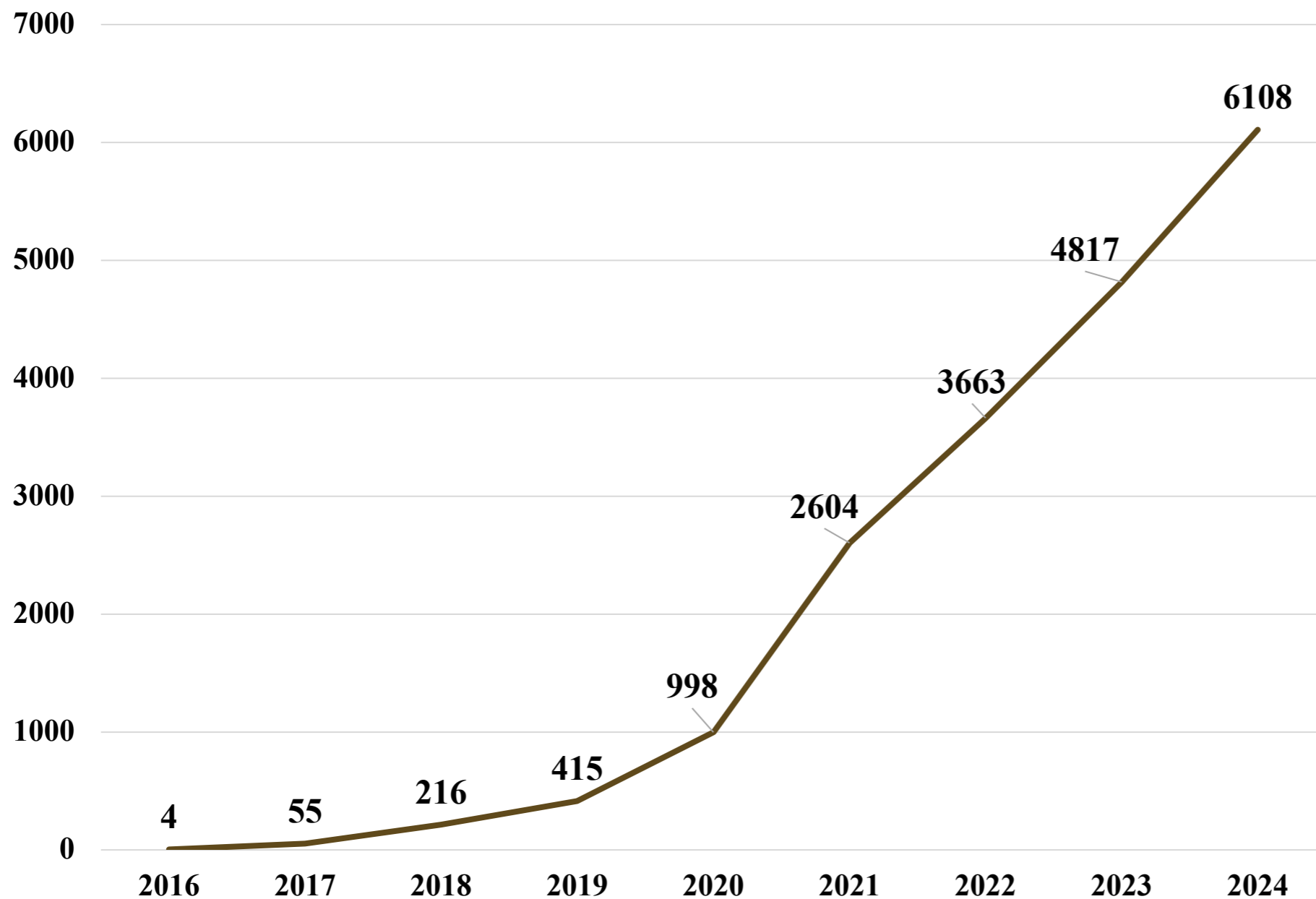
