





### 4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2023





Corresponding authors of 35 articles published in 2023 came from 11 countries, with mostly from USA.



摘要:胃肠道内镜切除术改变了多种癌前病变的疾病管理方式。最近,胃肠道内镜切除术适应证已经扩大至一些早期癌症。内镜切除术包含黏膜下注射及黏膜下层剥离两步,通常分为内镜下黏膜切除术(endoscopic mucosal resection,EMR)和内镜黏膜下层剥离术 endoscopic submucosal dissection,ESD)。EMR属于息肉切除术的自然延伸,通过黏膜下注射,切除病变后平整的创面。ESD技术难度较高,内镜钻探至黏膜下层后能够对早期恶性肿瘤实施治愈性整体切除。本综述将对现有胃肠道病理学证据、合理的术前评估、术前准备及术中操作技术等进行全面阐述。






