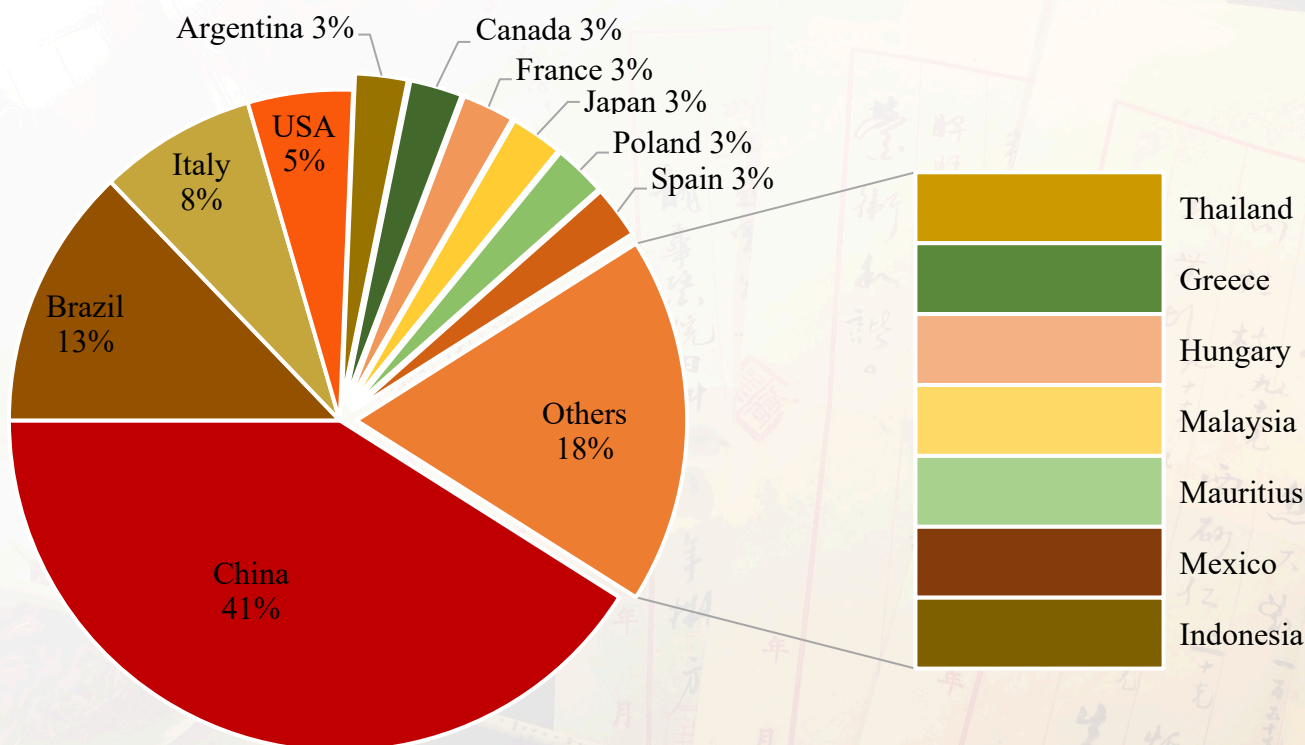
4. AMOUNT AND TYPES OF ARTICLES PUBLISHED IN 2021

LCM has published a total of **39 articles** in 2021, including **26** review articles and **5** original articles.

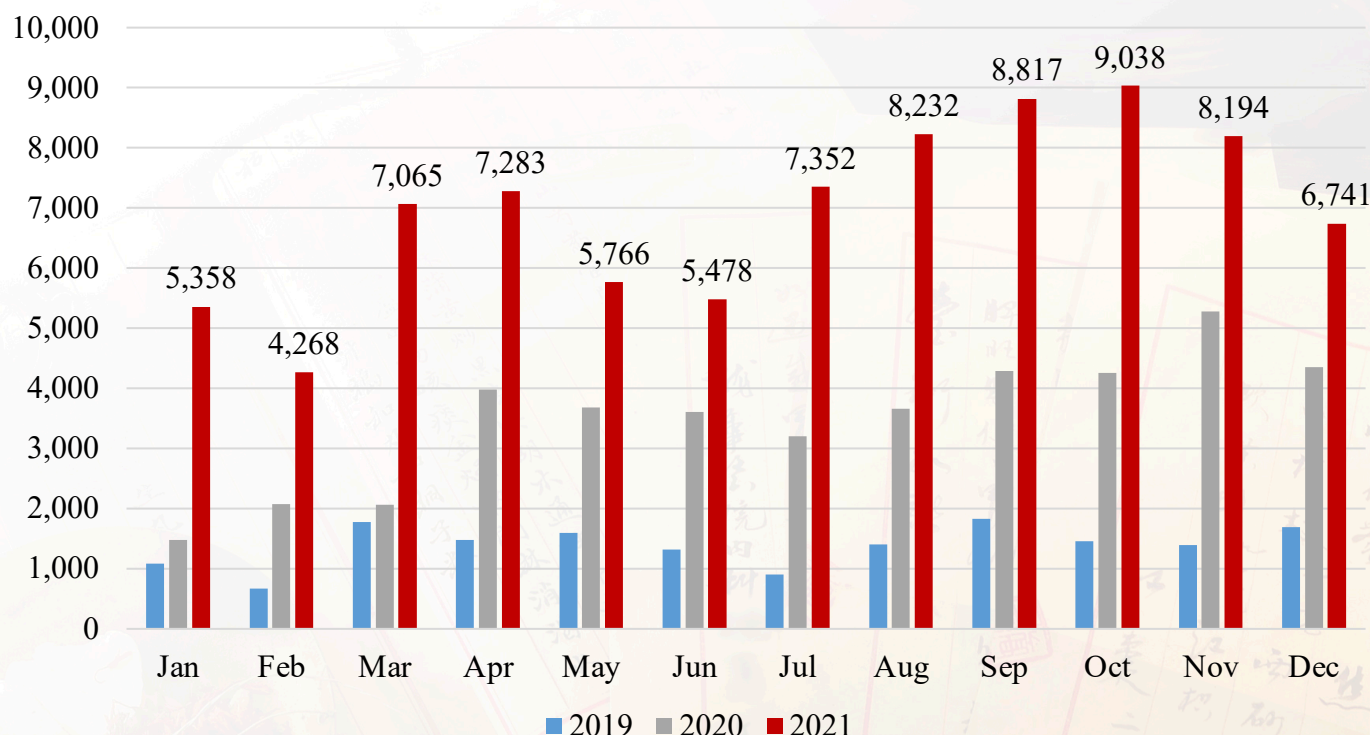


5. INTERNATIONAL DIVERSITY OF CORRESPONDING AUTHORS IN 2021

Corresponding authors of **39** articles published in 2021 come from **17** countries, among who there are **41%** from China, followed by Brazil, Italy, the USA and etc.



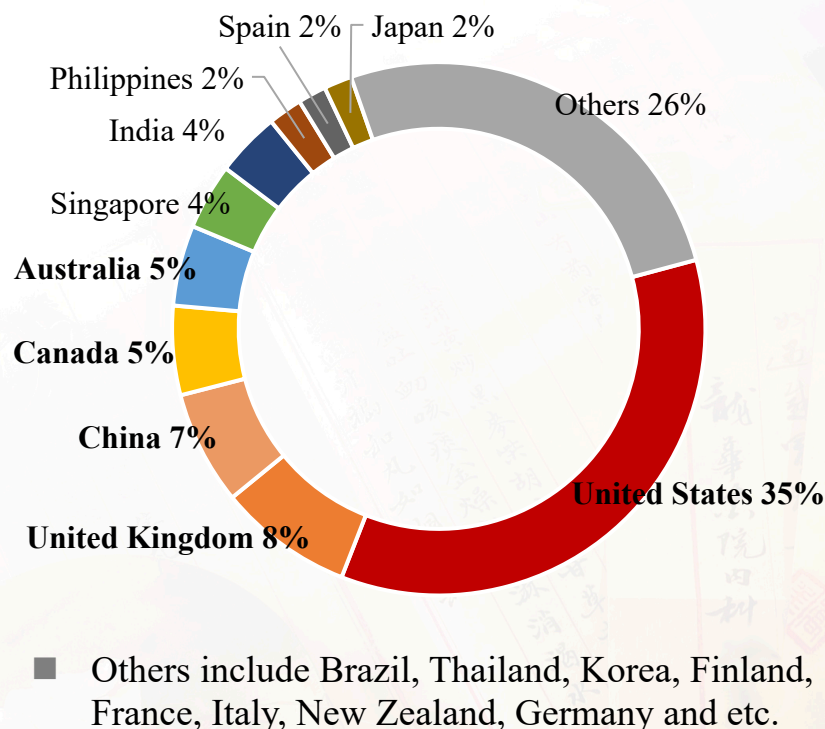
6. PAGEVIEWS IN 2021

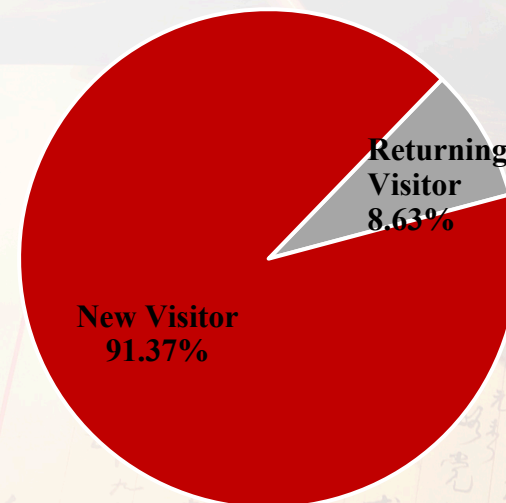
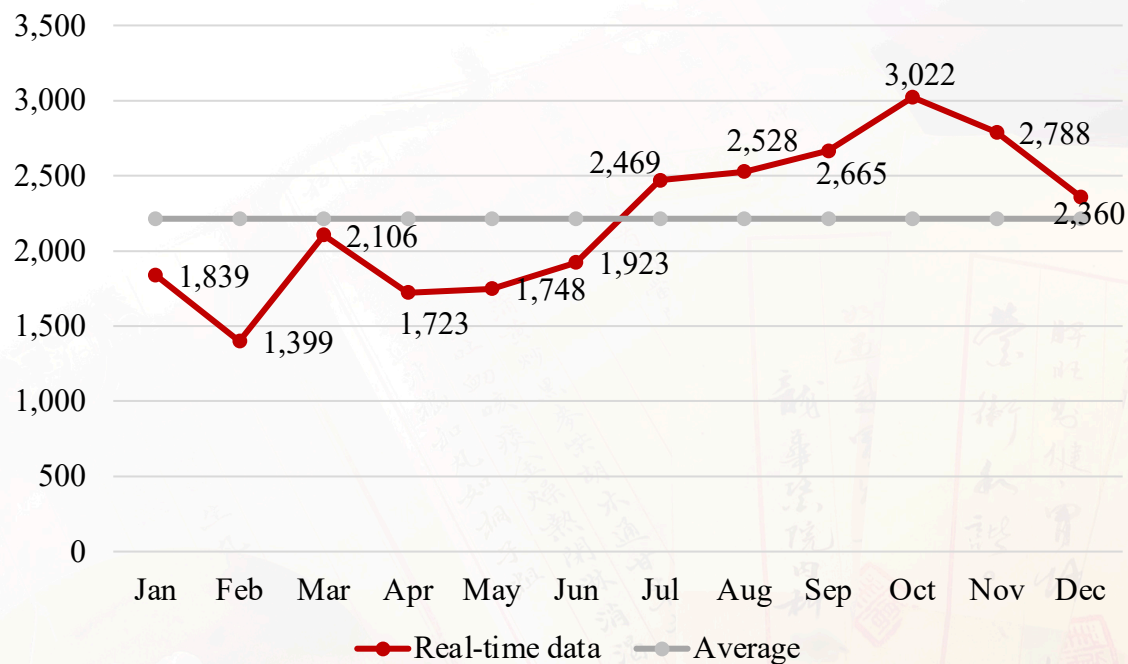
