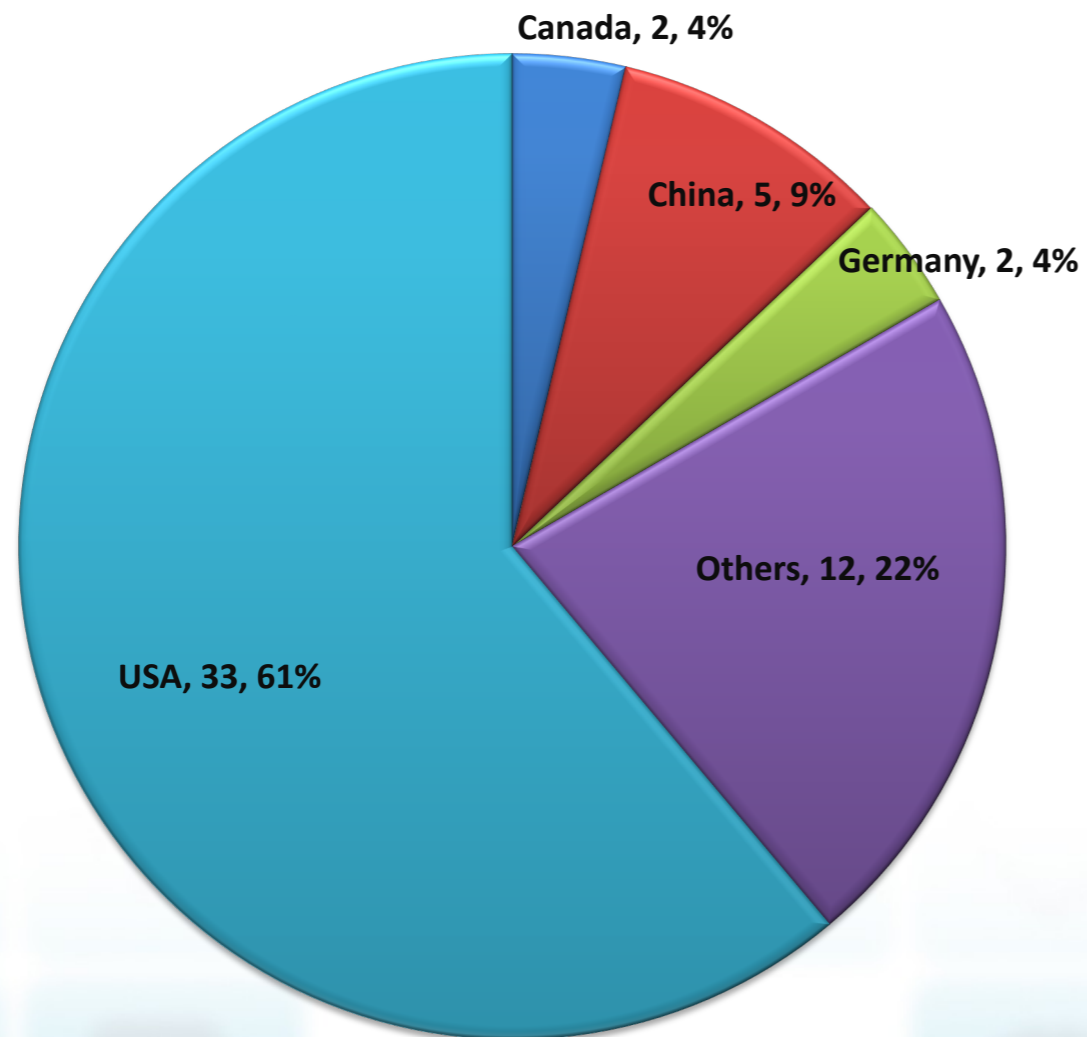

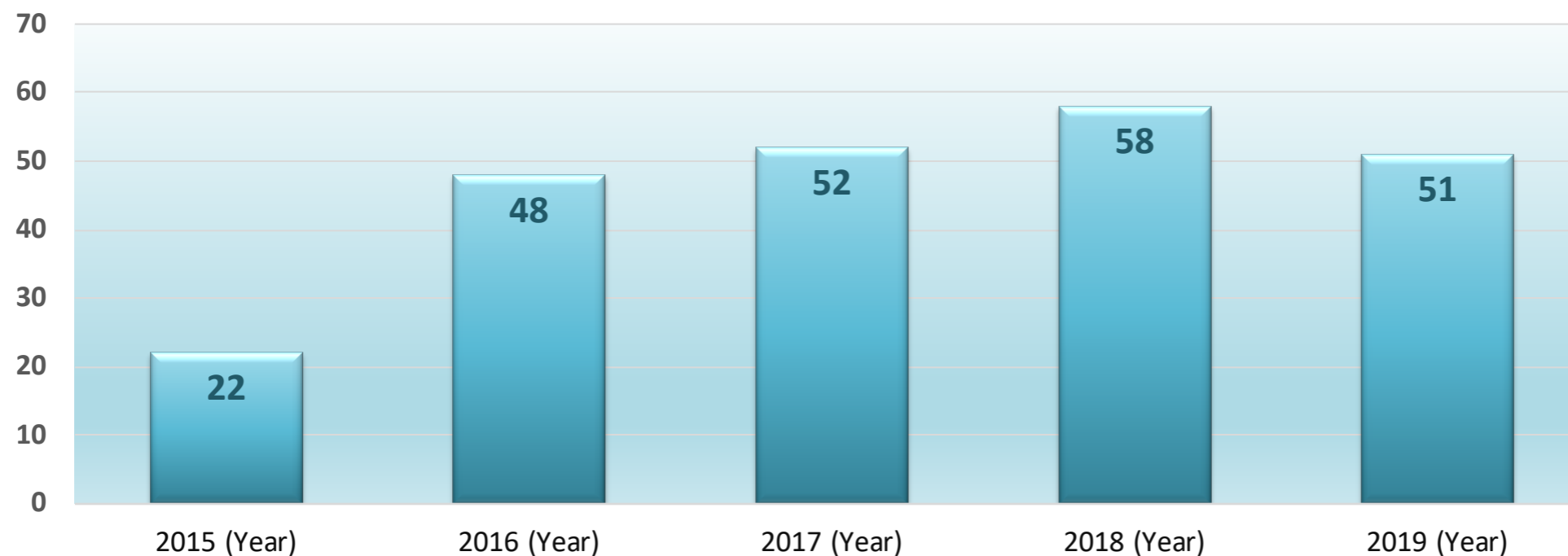

Published Articles by Year from 2015-2019



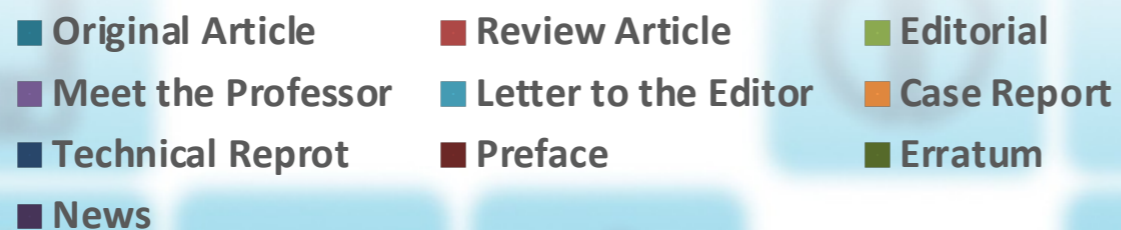
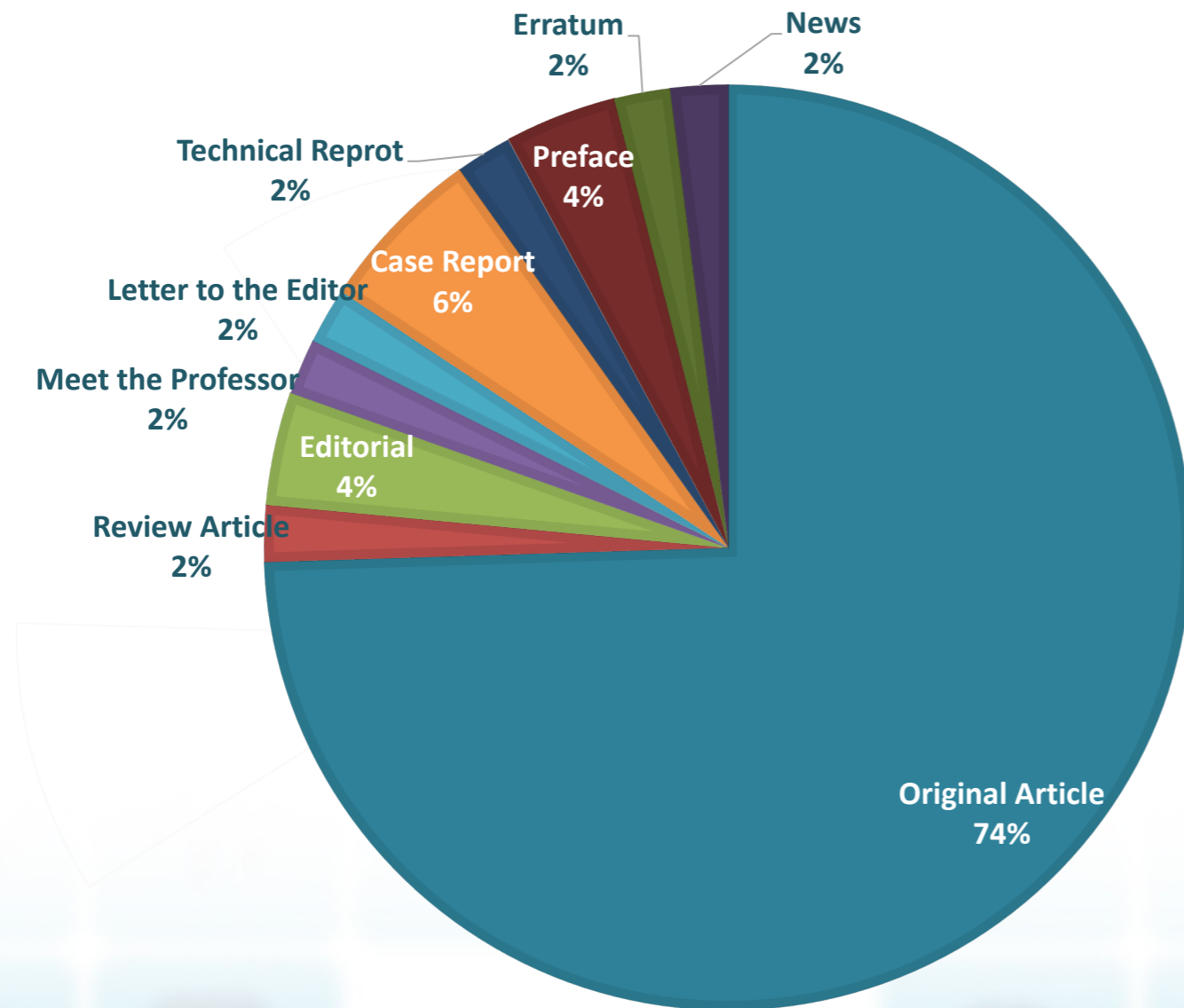
From March 10, 2015 to December 31, 2019, *mHealth* has published **231** articles in total.

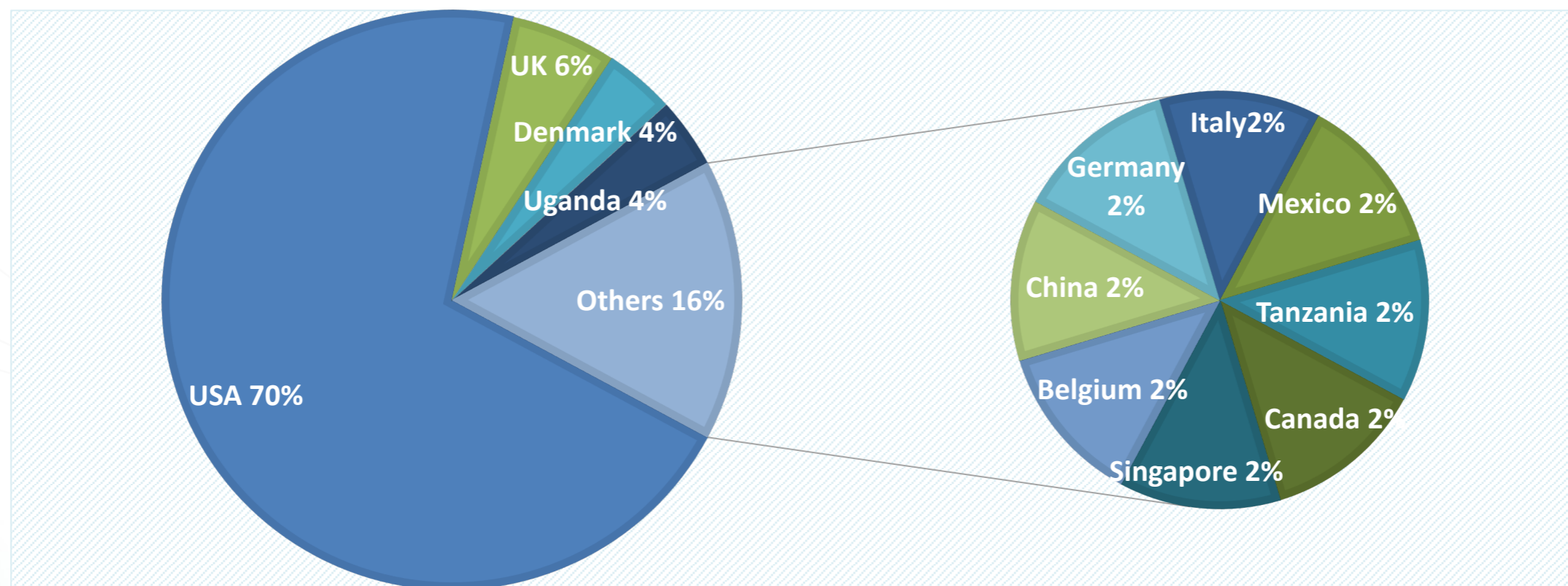

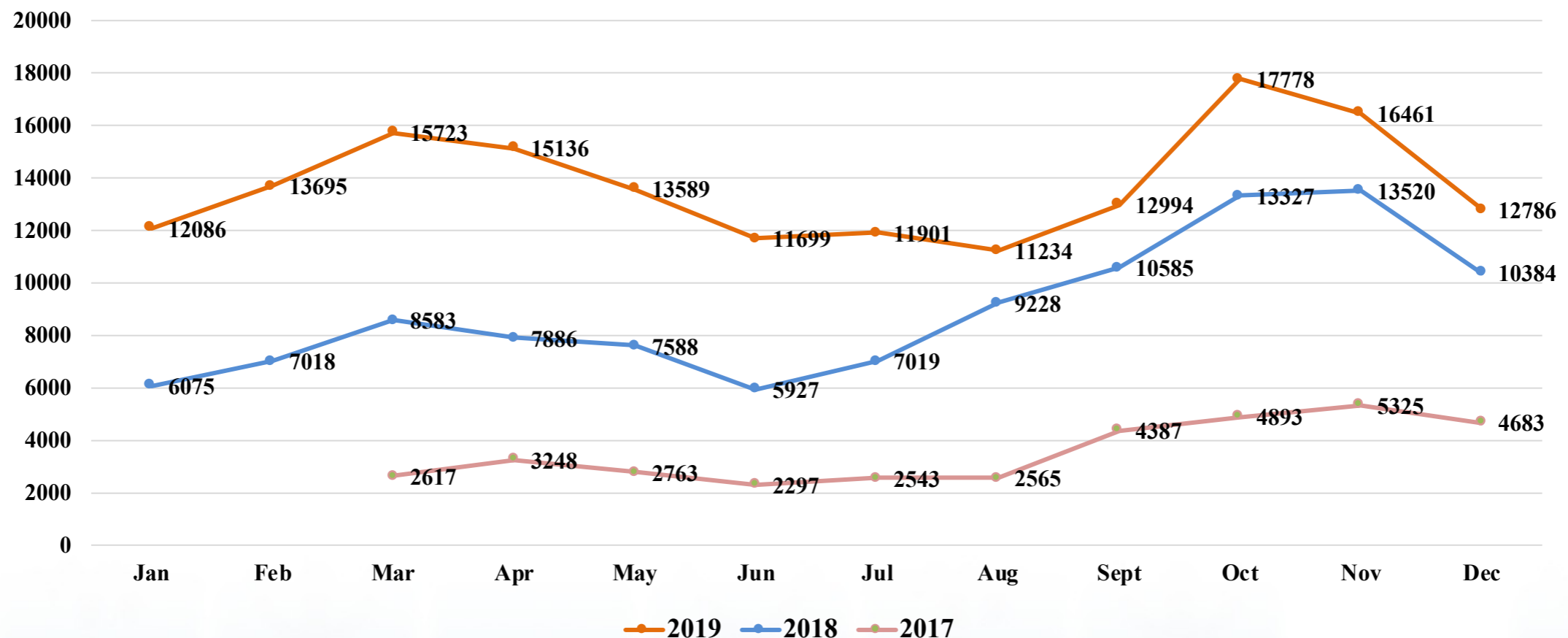
GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF CORRESPONDING AUTHORS IN 2019

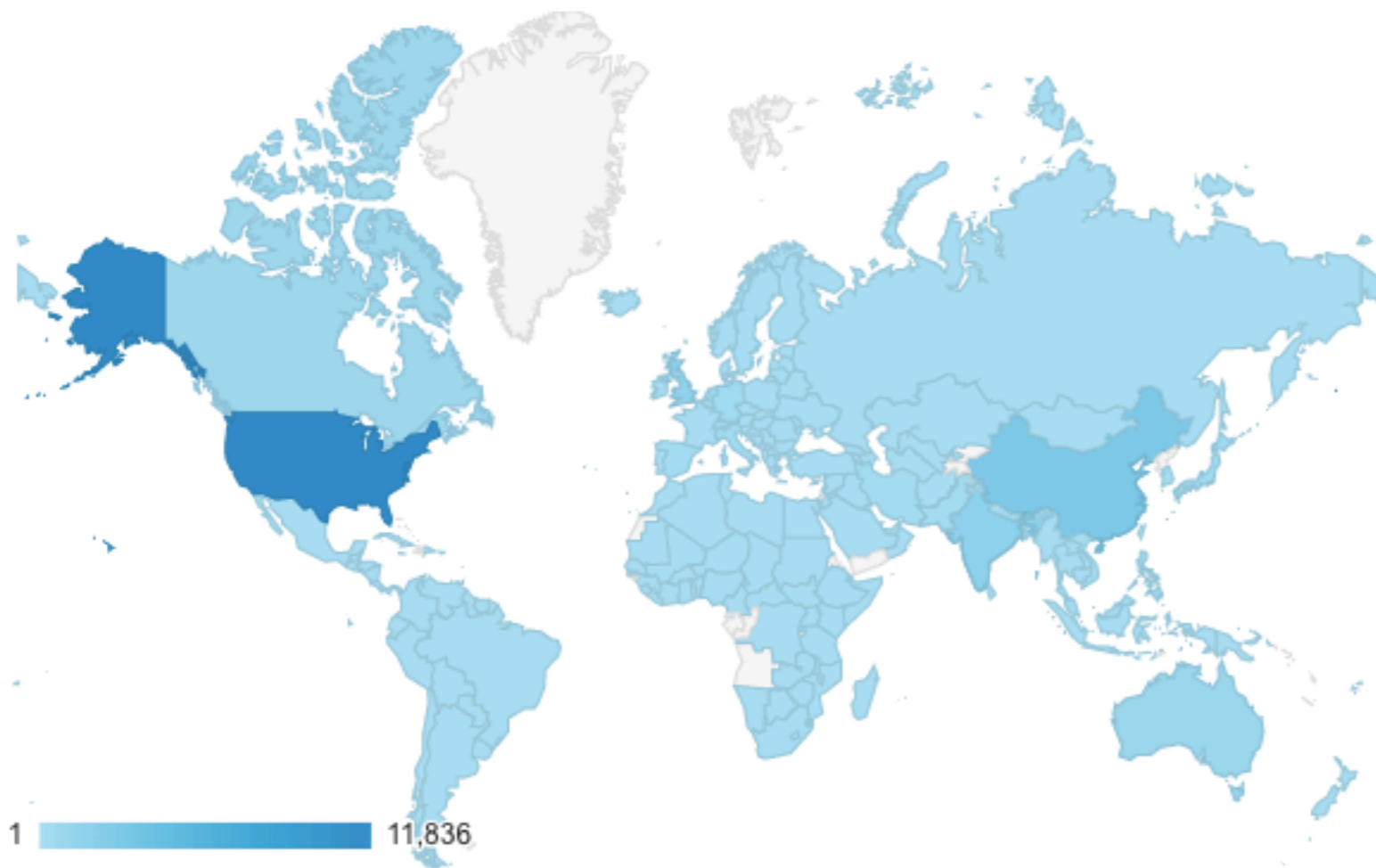
- **51** corresponding authors of articles published in 2019 come from **12** countries, which fully represents the international diversity in *mHealth*.
