



3. Editorial Board: Geographical Distribution




Most of the editorial board members are from USA. The others are from Italy, Japan, UK, China, and so on.

Till Dec 31, 2019, DMR has published 64 articles, including review article, editorial, original article, case report, surgical technique, brief report, and consensus, etc.


