



#### 4. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members





# 5. Amount and Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2022




AMJ has published **40 articles** in total, among which **52%** are review articles, **17%** are original articles, and **15%** are case reports.





#### 6. Geographic Distribution of Corresponding Authors



AMJ authors come from many parts of the world, including USA, China, Italy, Japan, Germany, etc. The wide international spread of authors is one unique characteristic of the journal.

Among the **40** corresponding authors in 2022, **35% come from USA, 20% from China, 15% from Italy,** with the rest from 13 countries around the world.

#### 7. Pageviews of the Website in 2022


