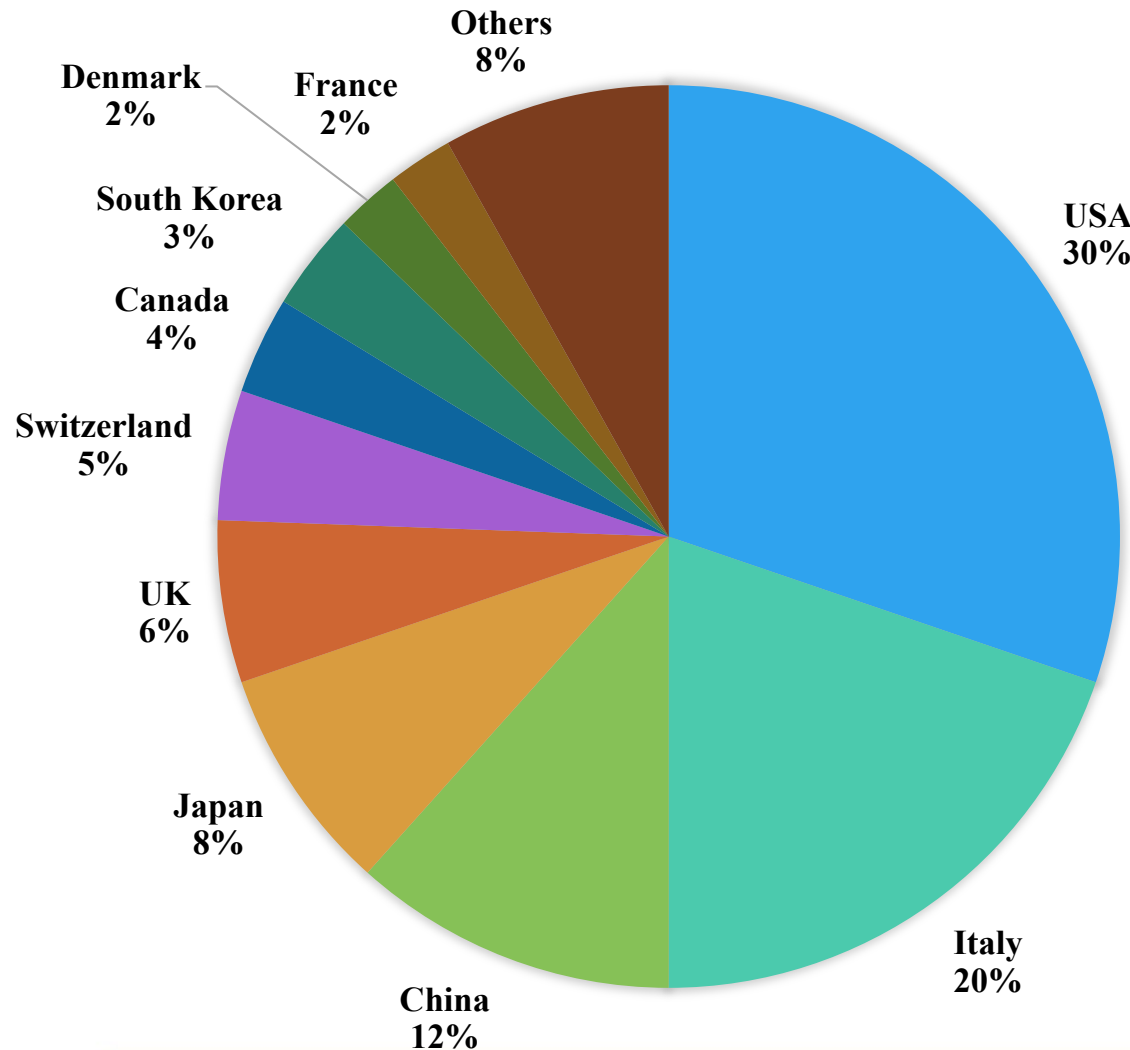

3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members

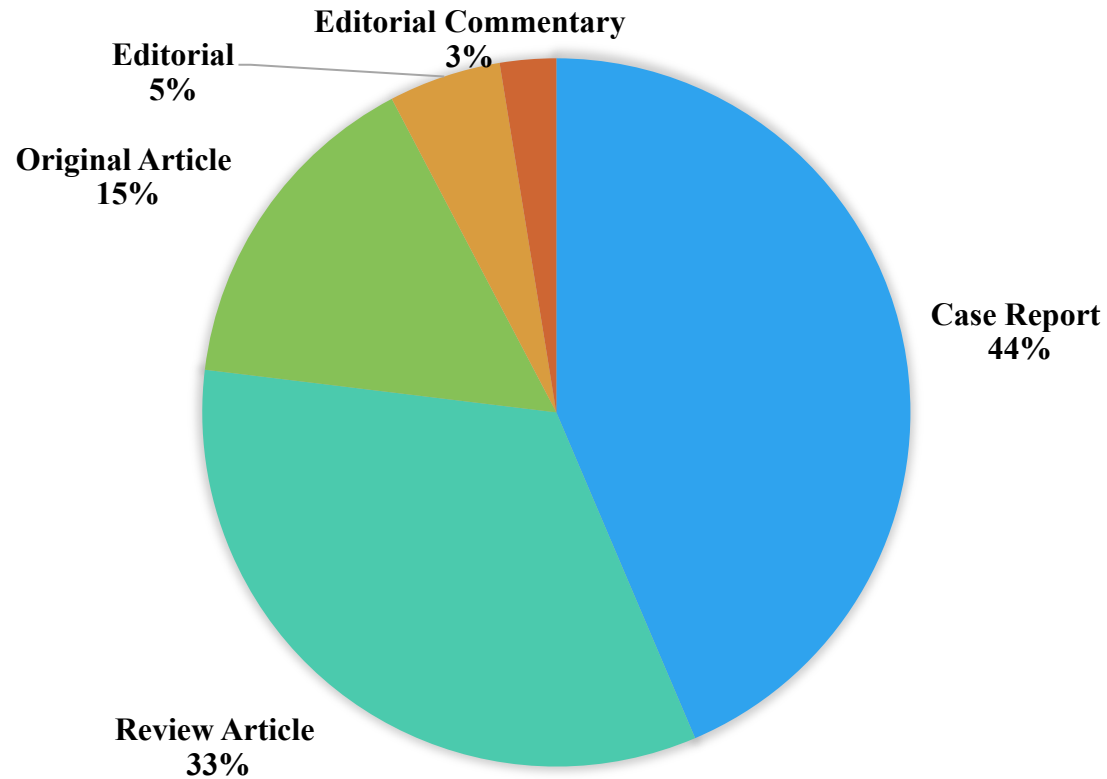

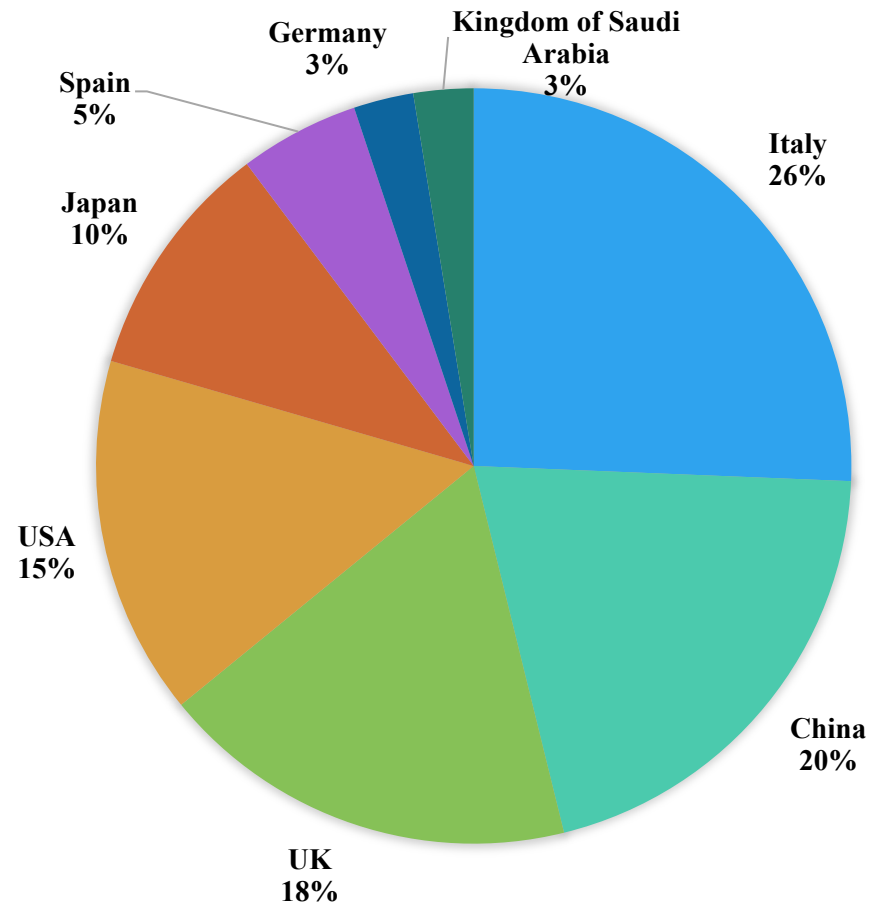

Since launched in May 2017, SHC has published a total of **364** articles. **39** were published in 2022 with diverse article types.

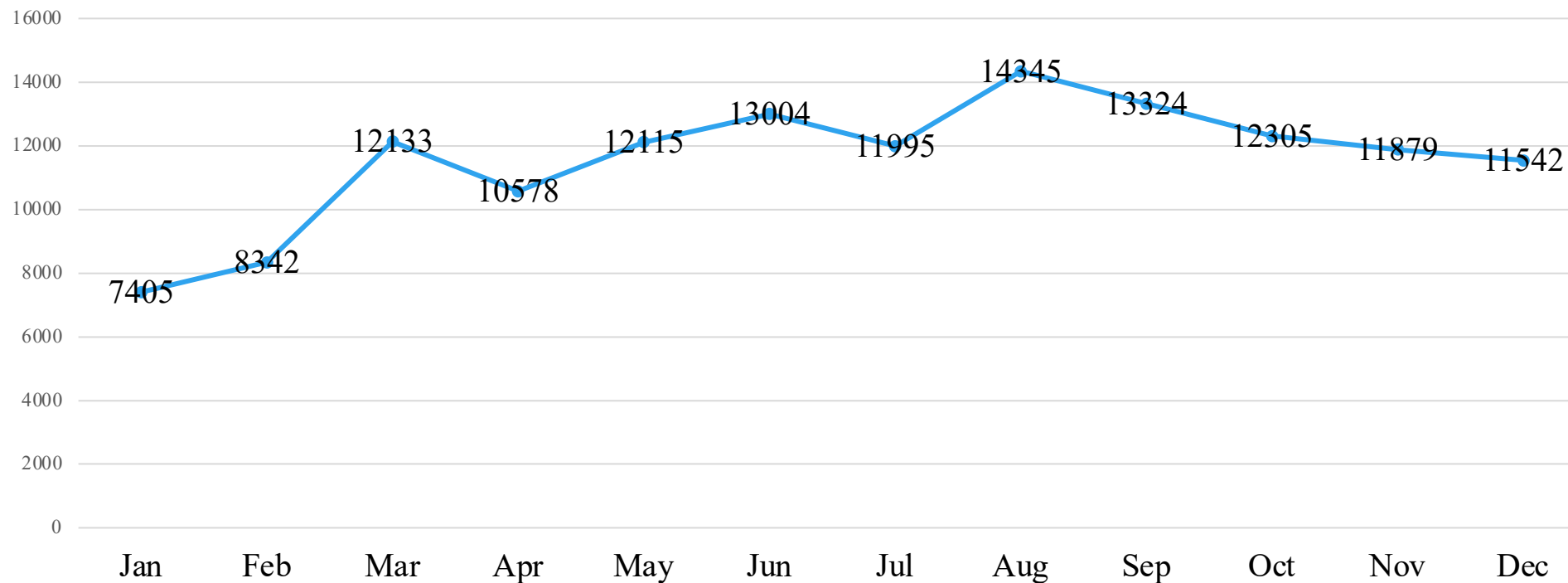
5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022



Corresponding authors of **39** articles in 2022 came from **8** countries with mostly from **Italy, China, UK, USA and Japan.**

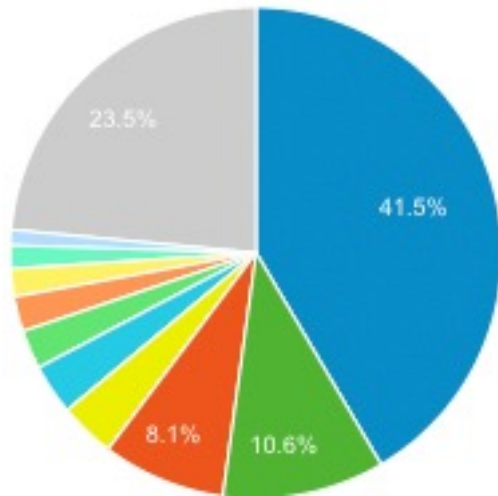

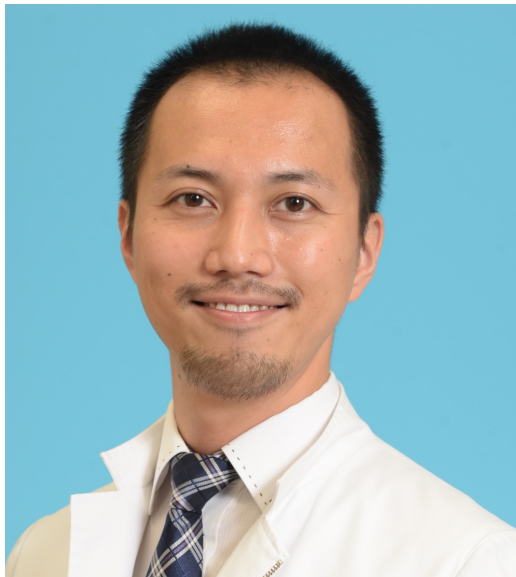

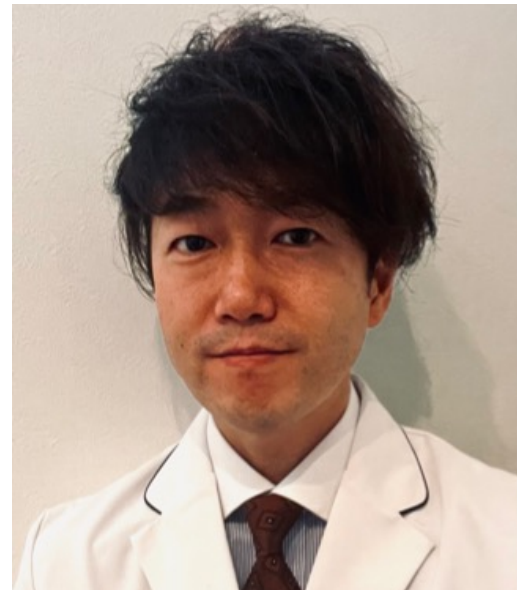
