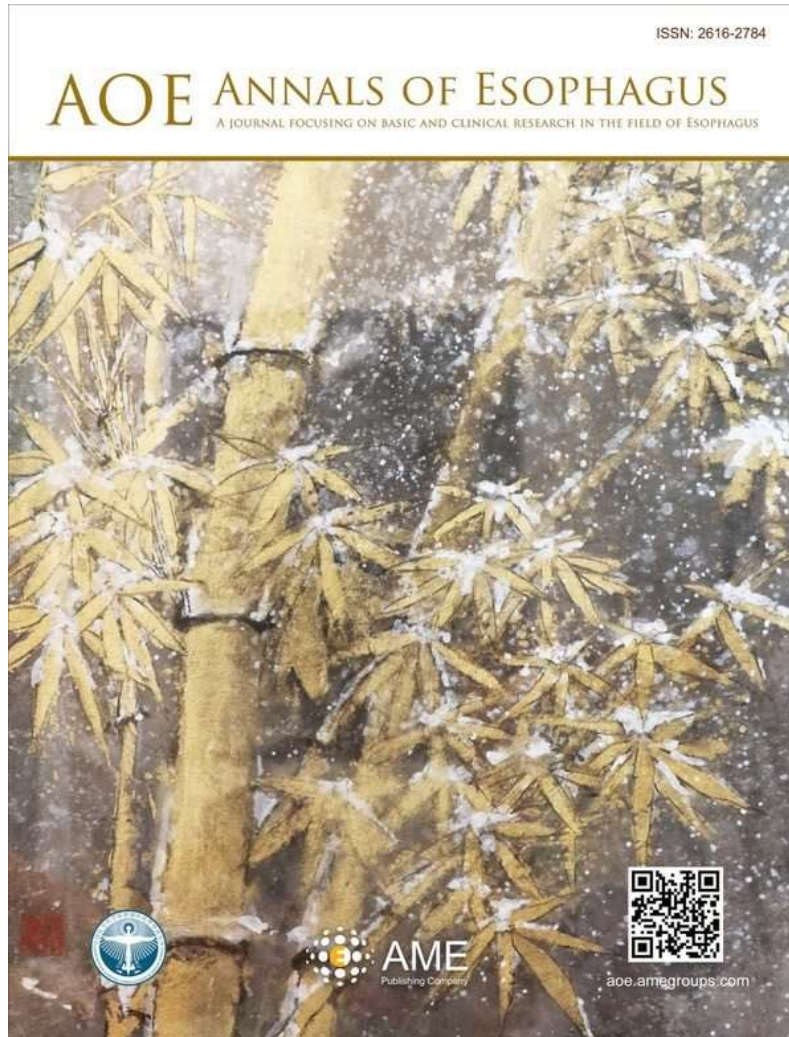

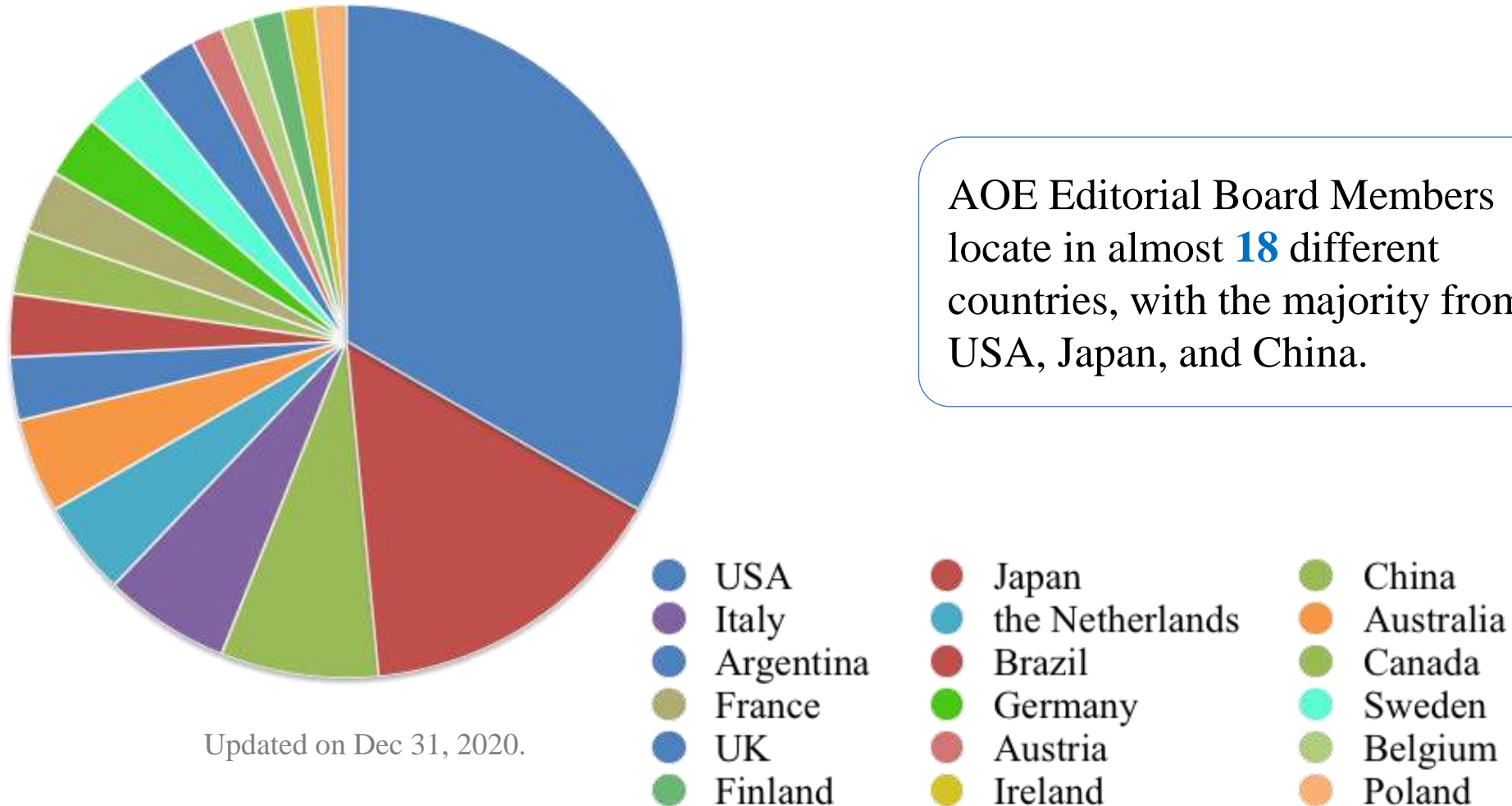

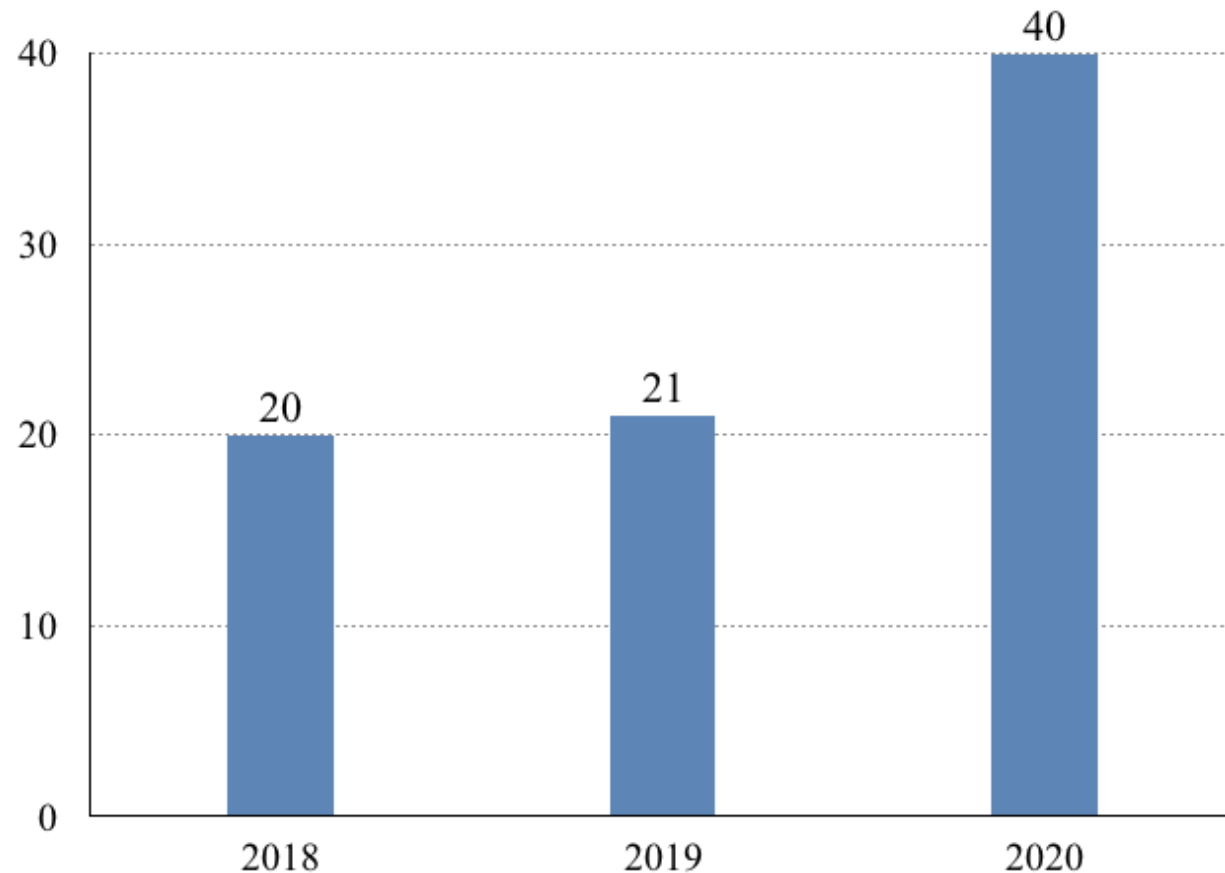

3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members



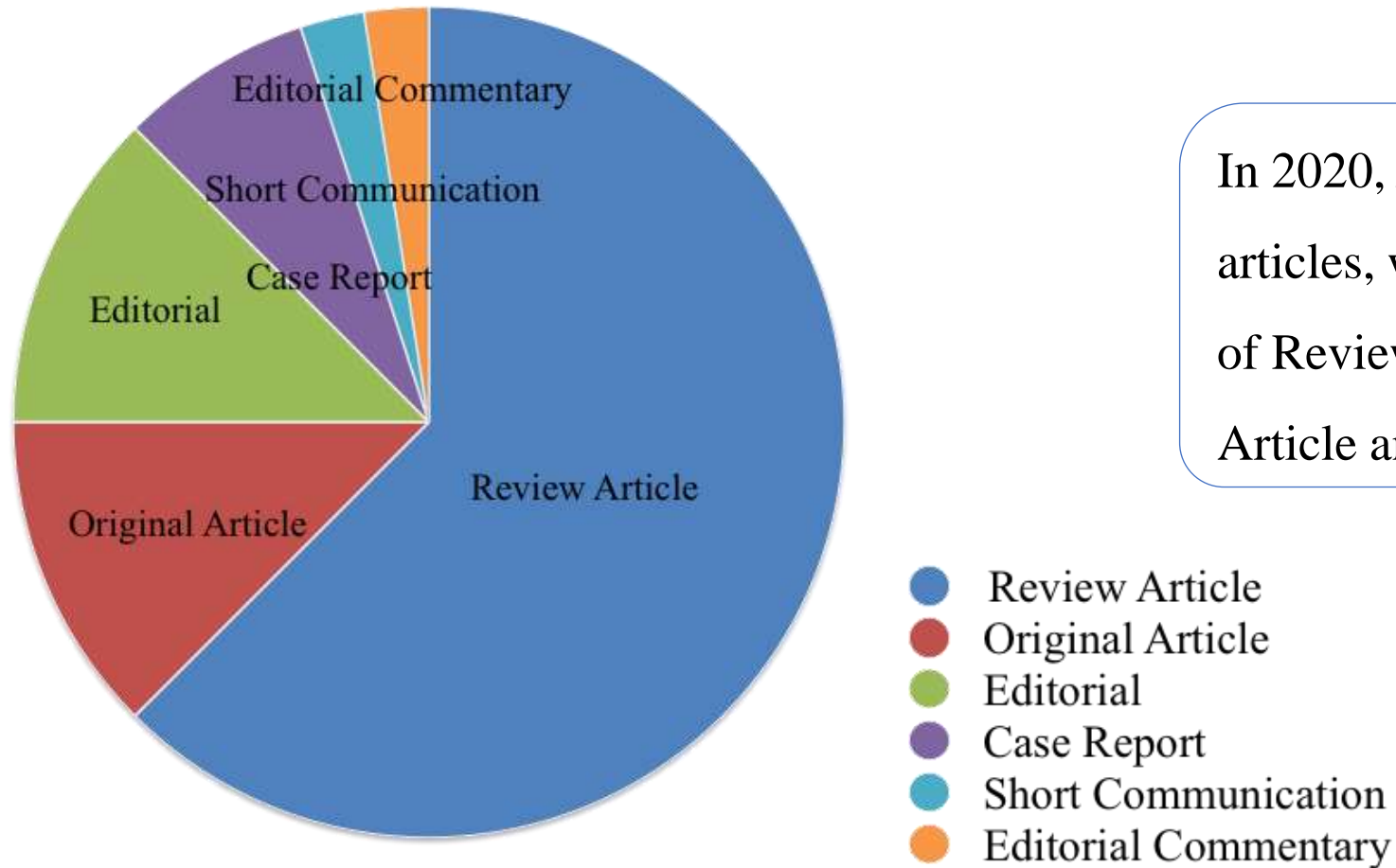

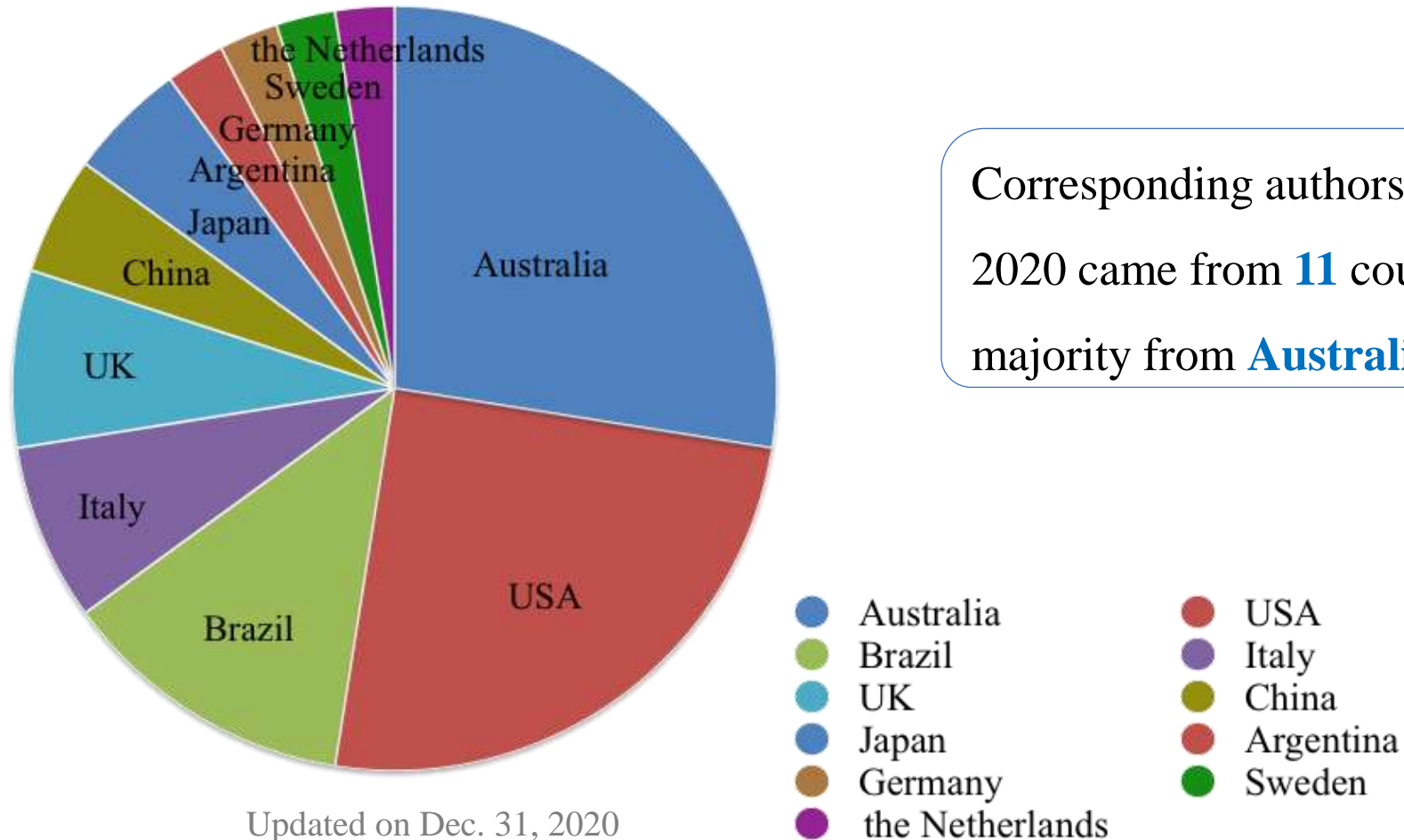

In 2020, AOE has published 40 articles, which majorly consist of Review Article, Original Article and Editorial.

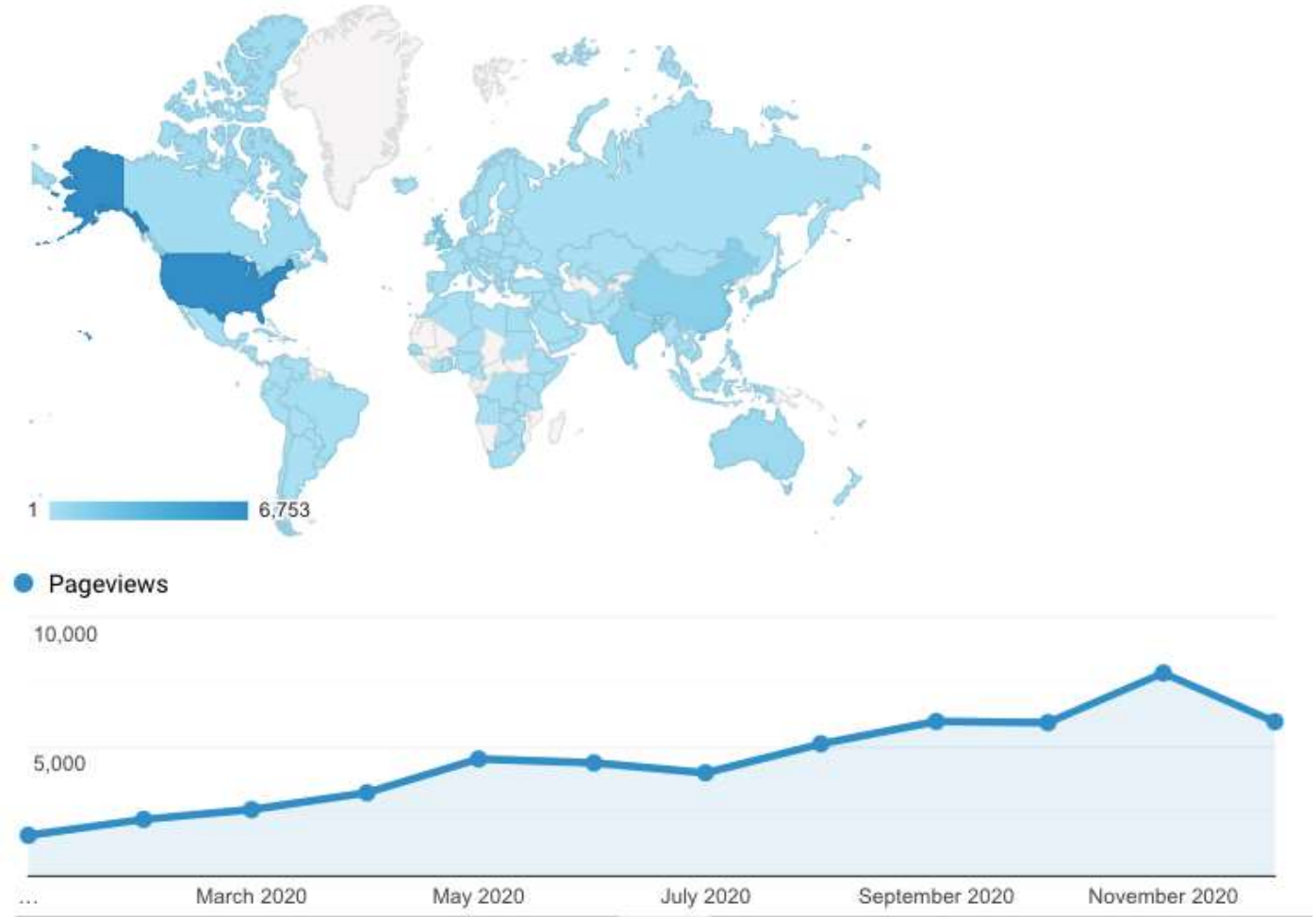

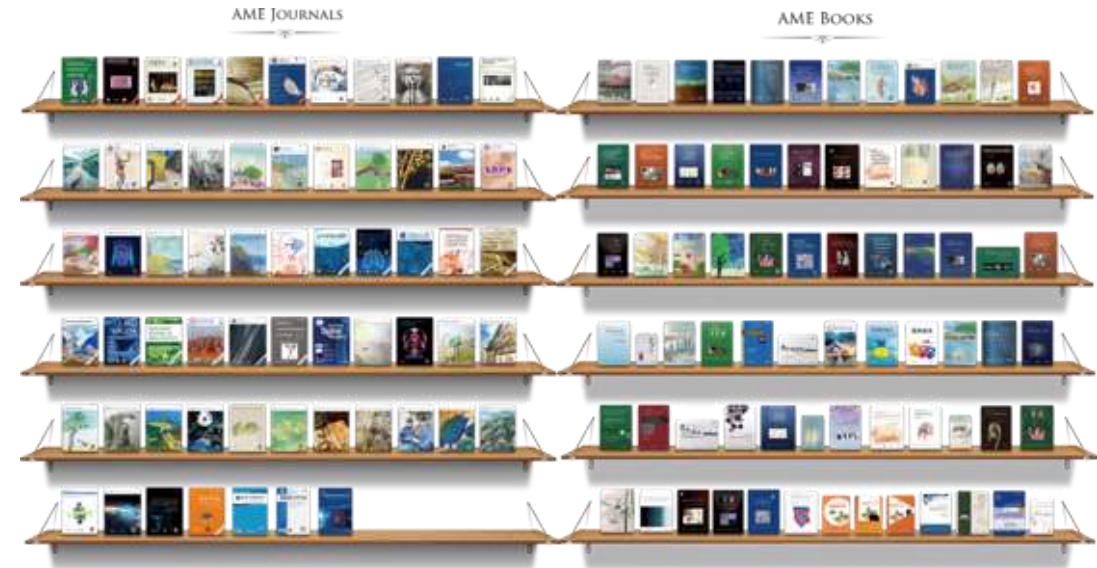
