





4. Distribution of Editorial Board Members




5. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



In 2020, 399 articles have been published in TAU.




6. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2020



Among the 399 articles published in 2020, there are 312 Review Articles and Original Articles




7. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2020

8. Citations of TAU Articles(results by years)




Citation of TAU Collection has increased rapidly.

9. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed




Retrieval of TAU in PubMed increased rapidly.


