




### 1. Basic Information



#### > Distribution of Editorial Board Members




89 JLPM editorial board members come from 26 countries, among who there are 18% from the USA, followed by Italy, Canada, Spain, Germany and etc.





# 3. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2020




In 2020, JLPM has published a total of 33 articles, among which there are 23 Review Articles and 7 Original Articles.

All together 75,732 visitors. Readers who visited JLPM website in 2020 were from diverse countries, with the majority from the USA, followed by India, UK, Canada and etc.


