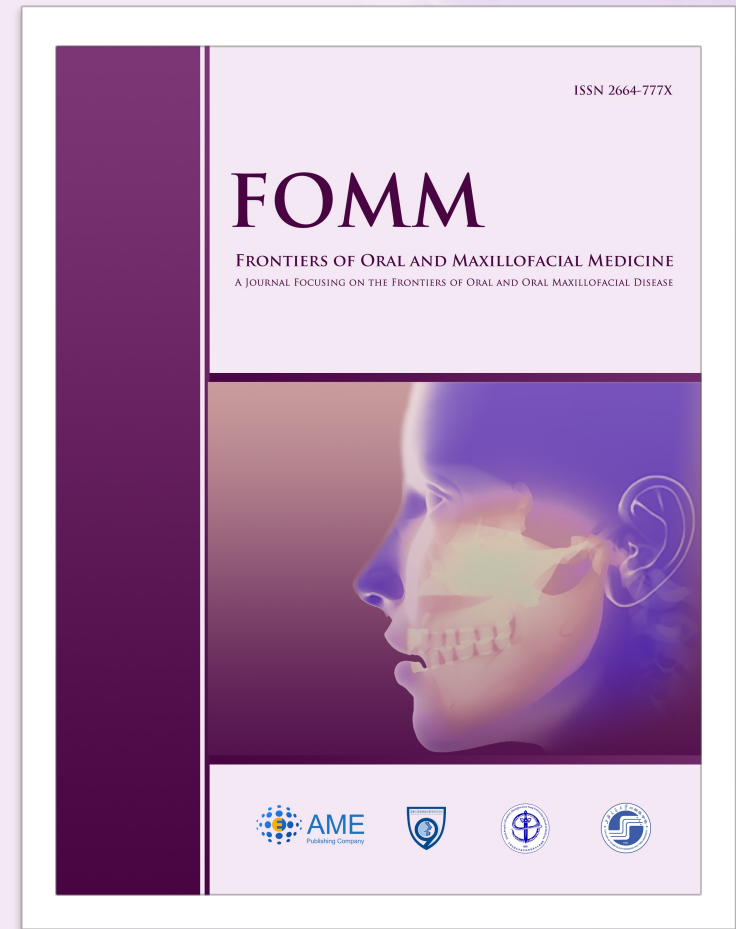

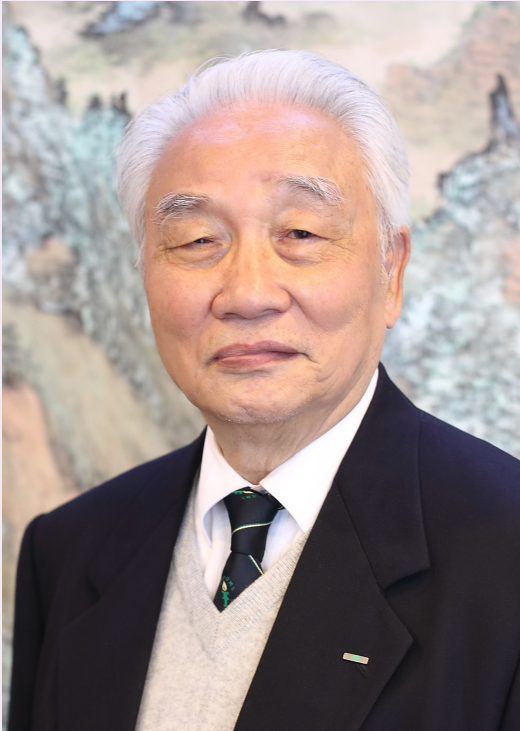

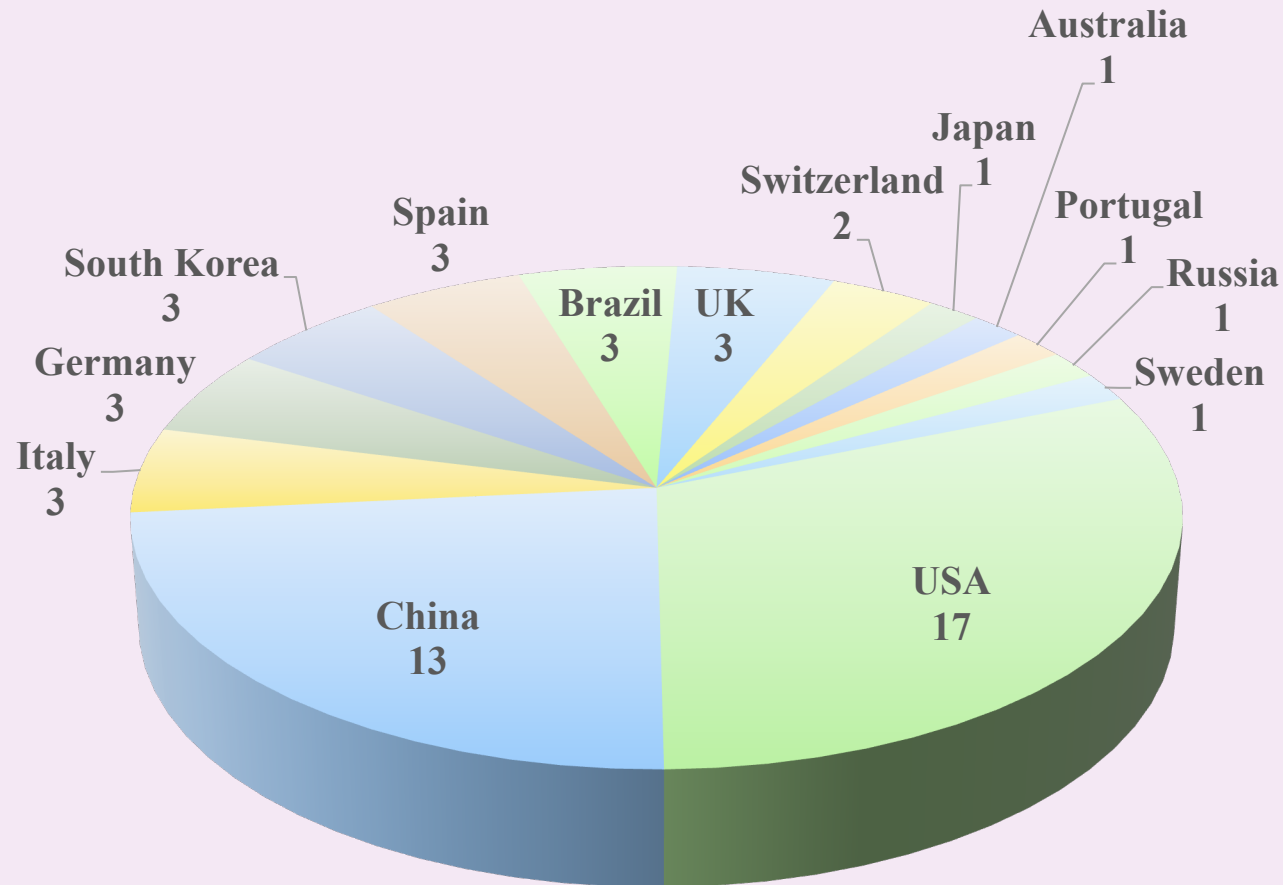

Geographic Distribution

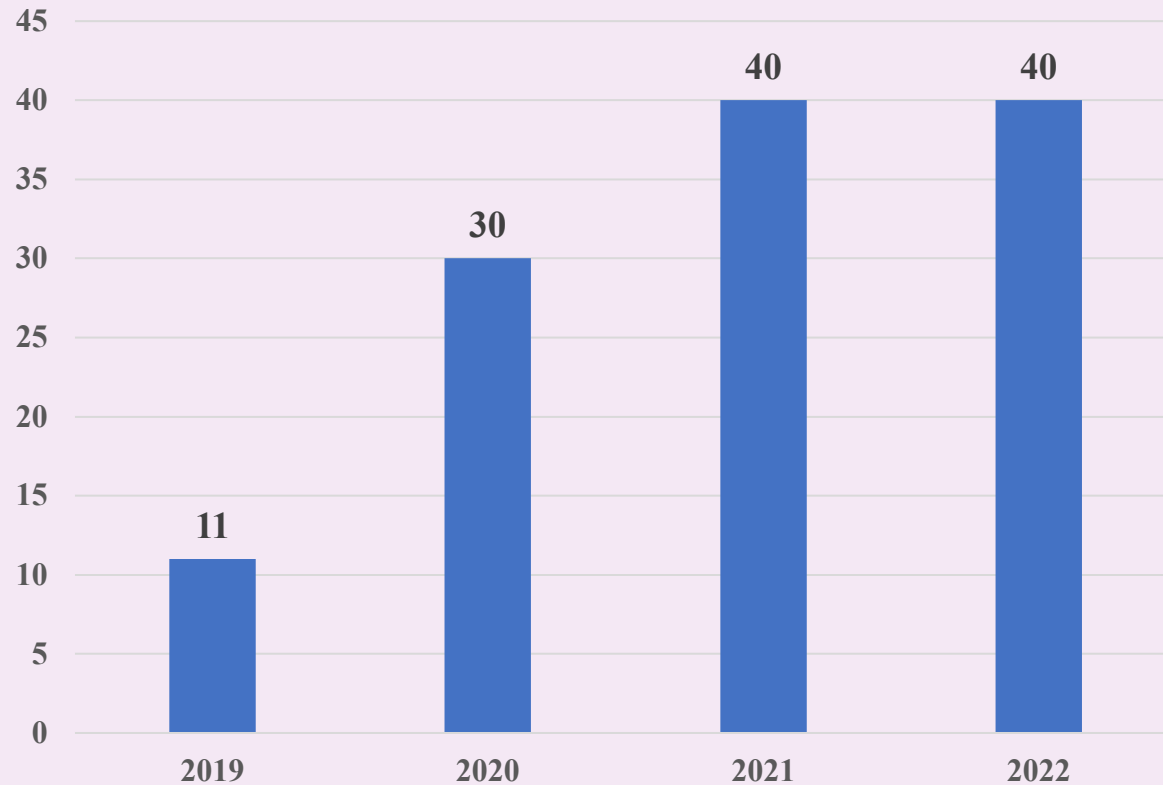

3. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

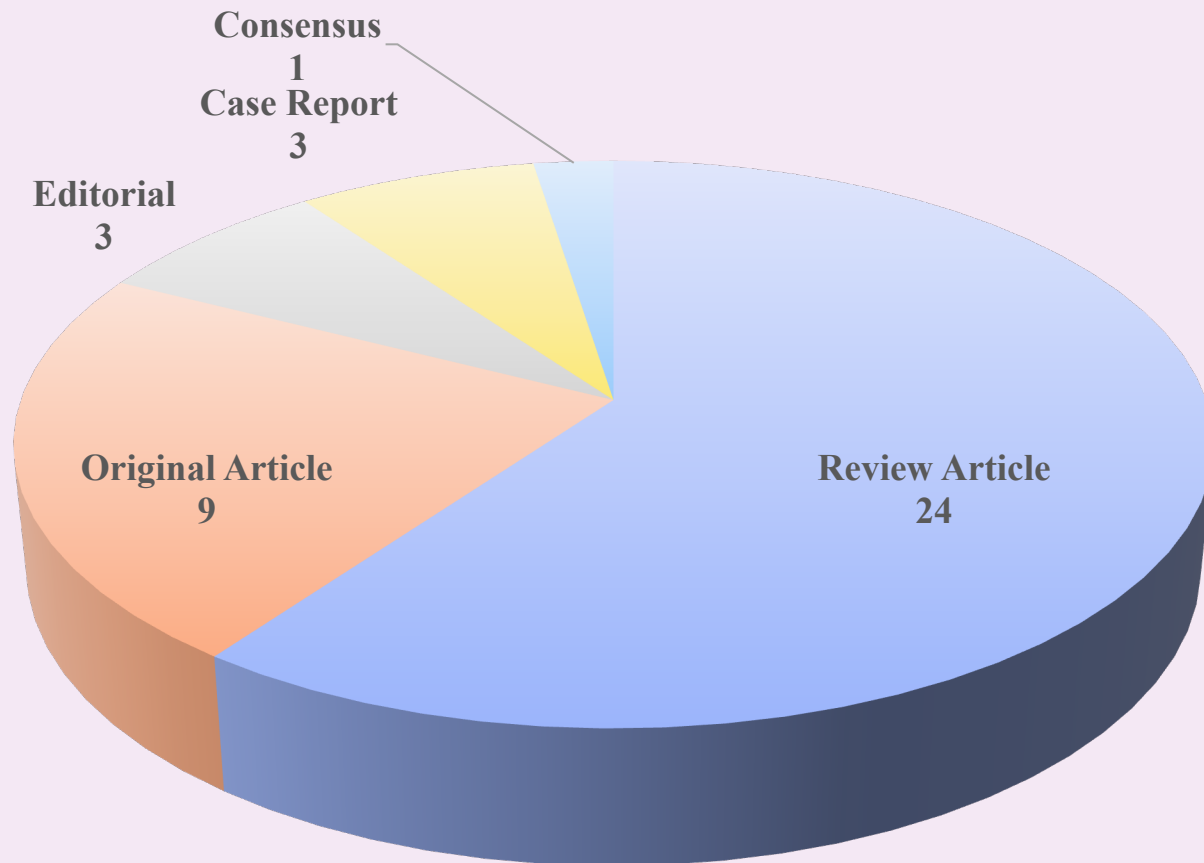

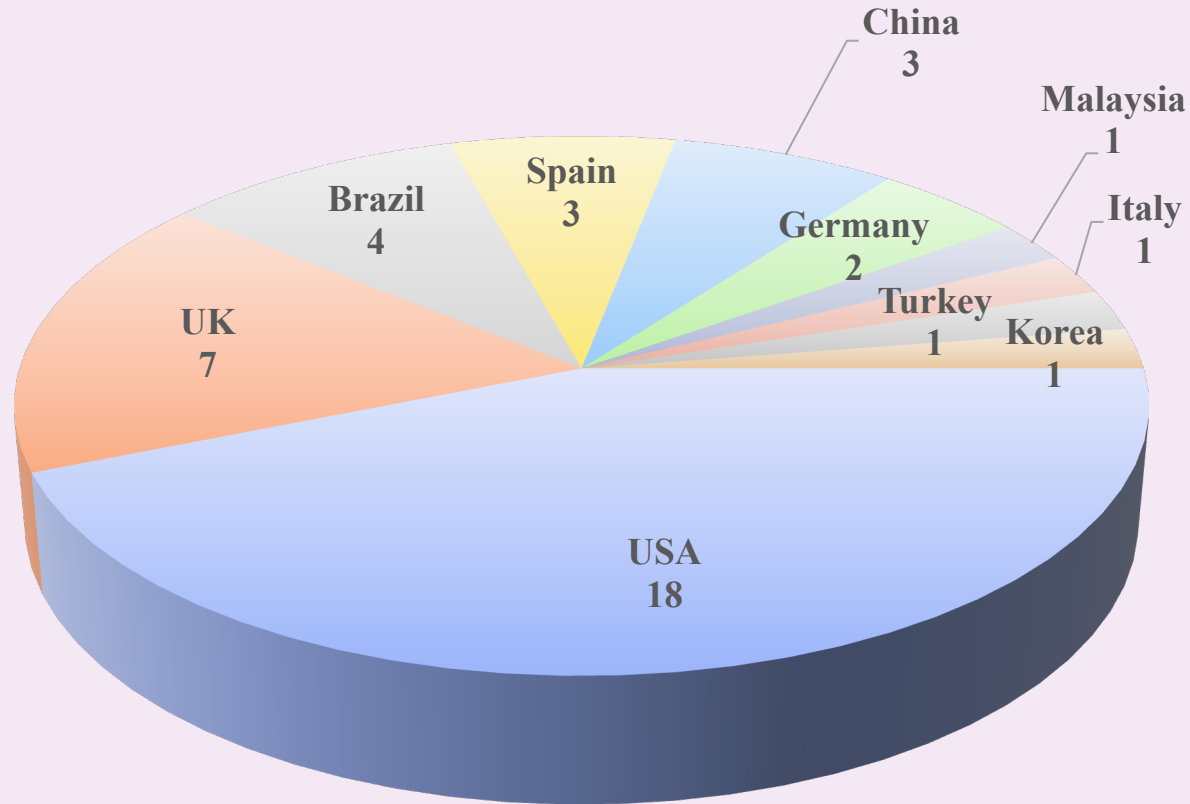
4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in 2022

5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022

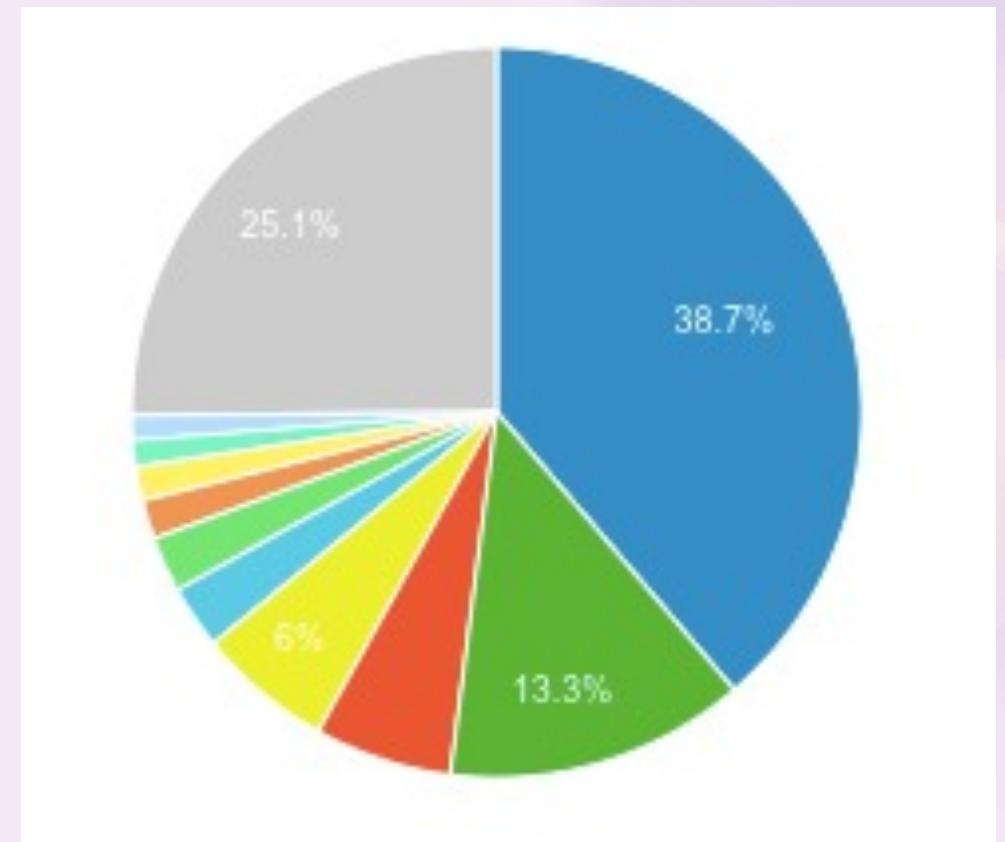


Corresponding authors of **40 articles** in 2022 came from **10 countries**, with a majority **from USA, UK and Brazil**.

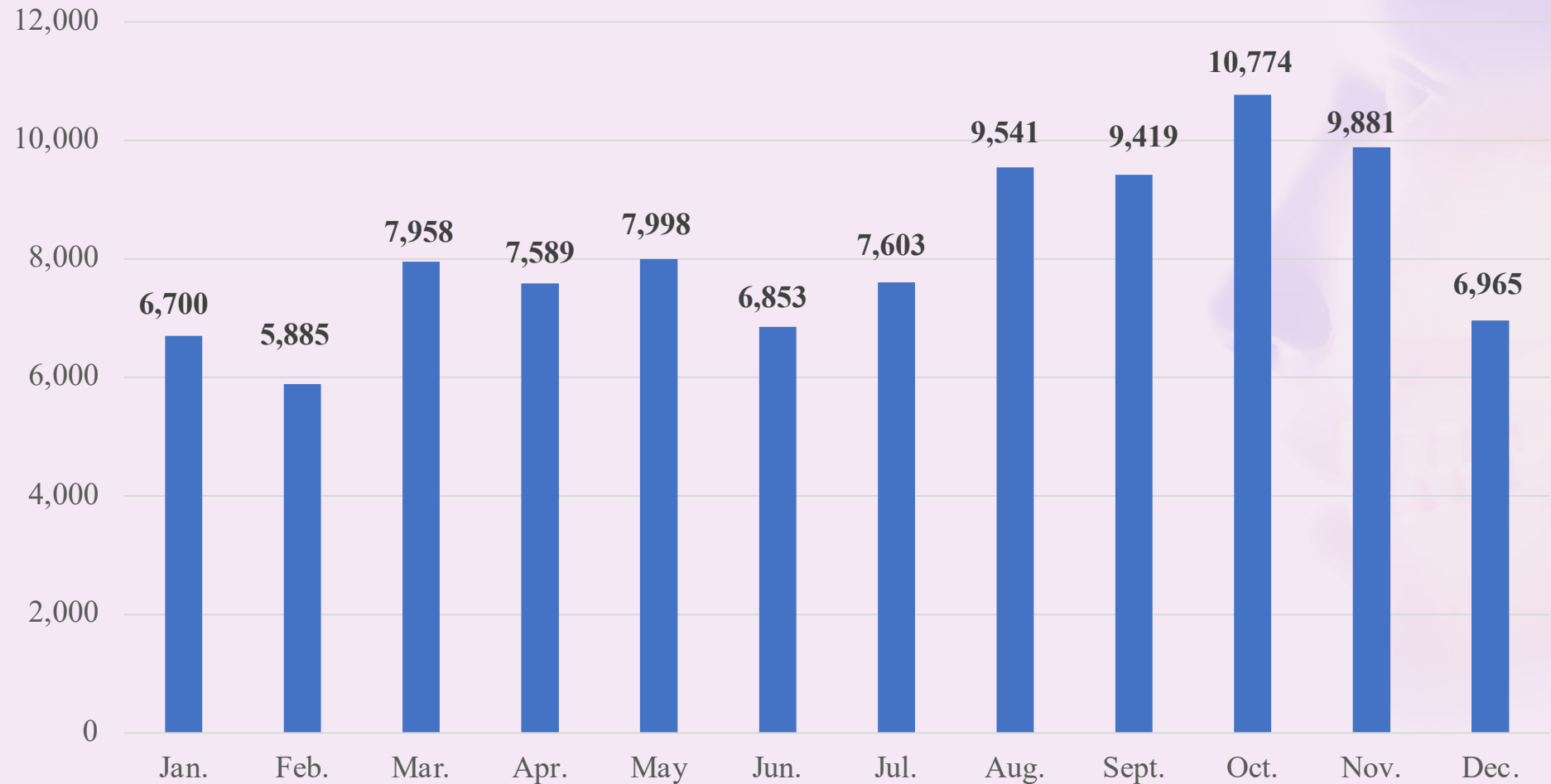

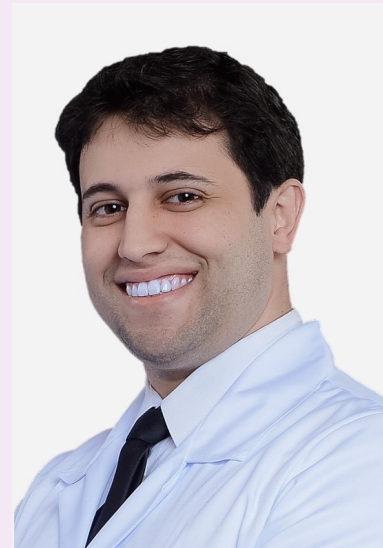
