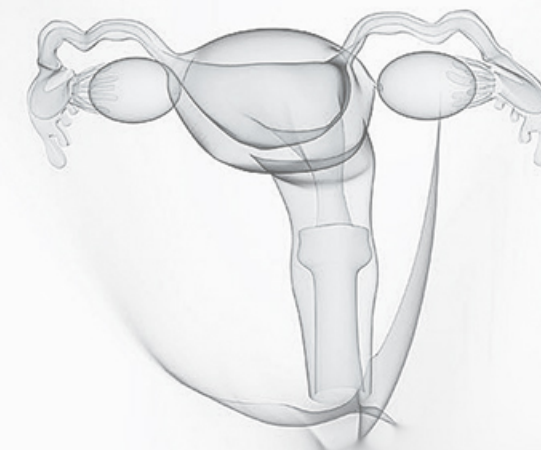


3. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members

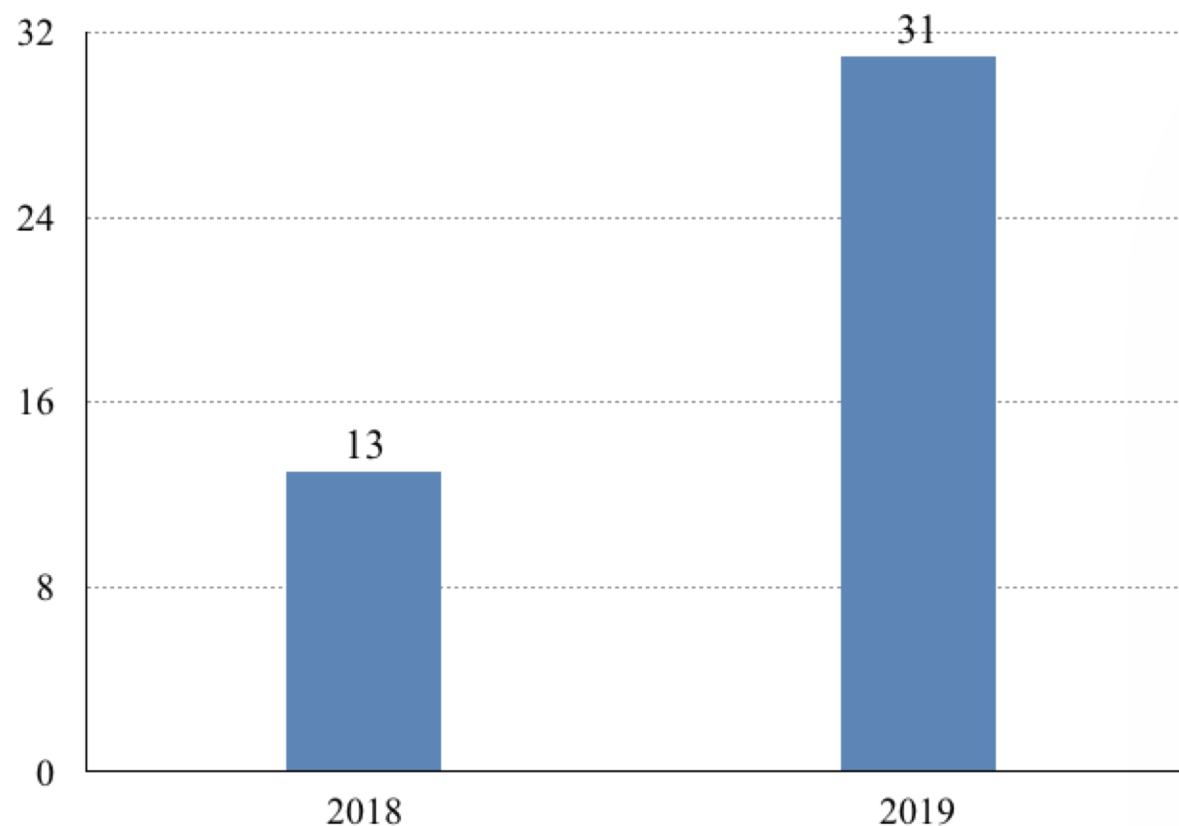

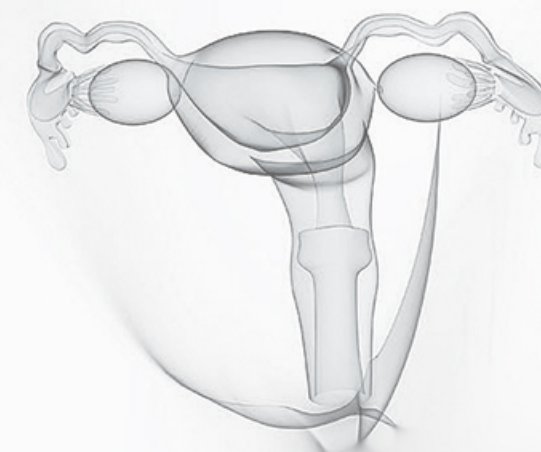
4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)



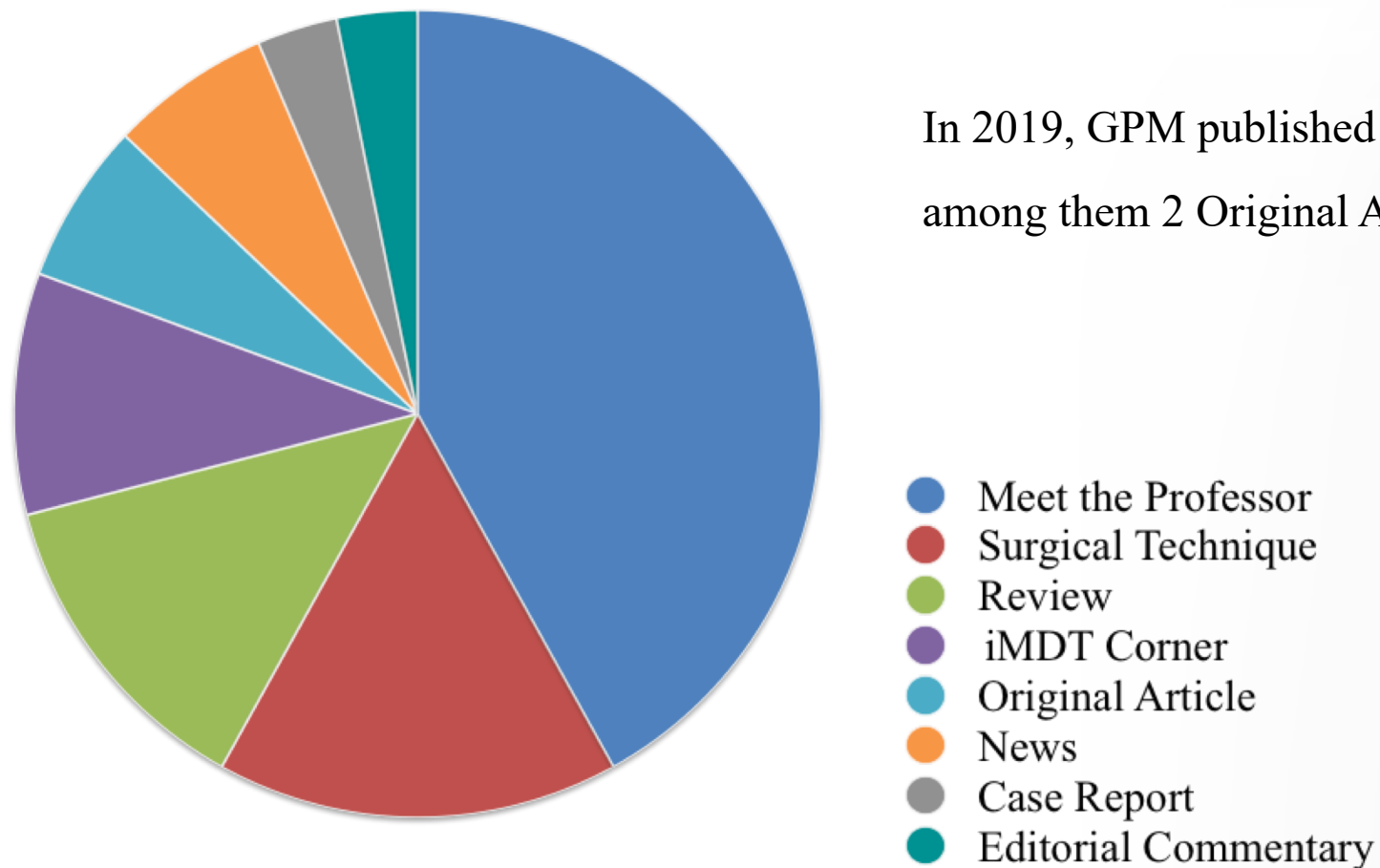

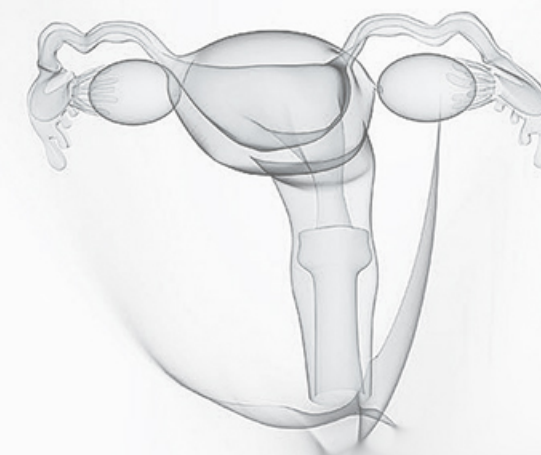
GPM has published till now **44 articles**.



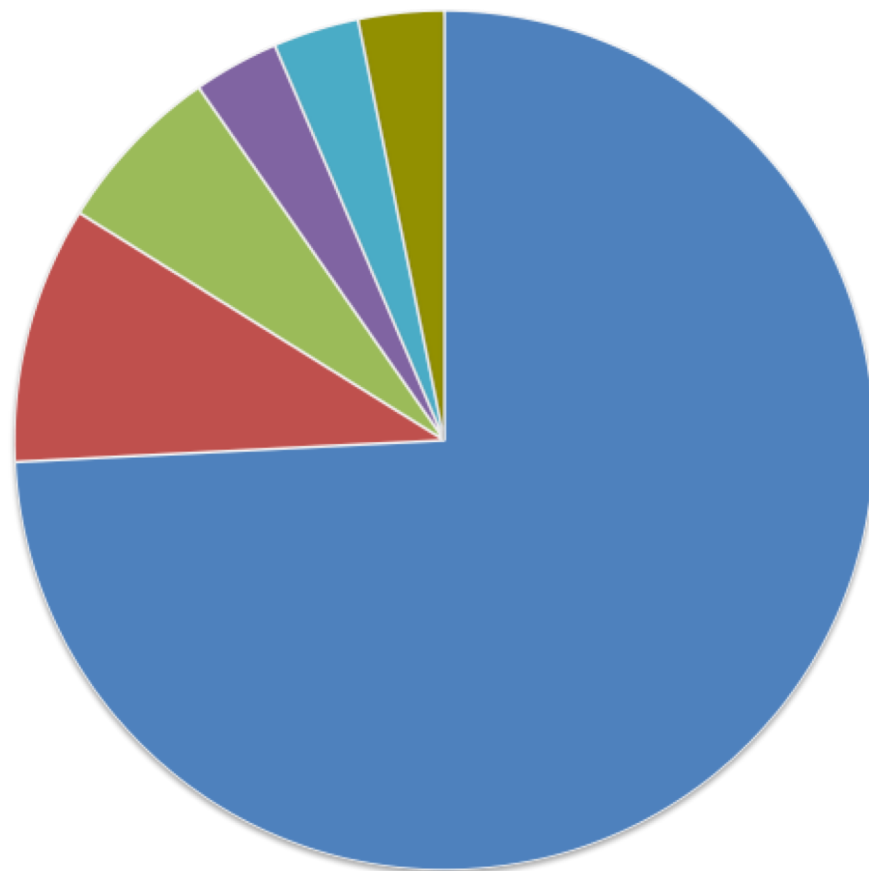
5. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2019



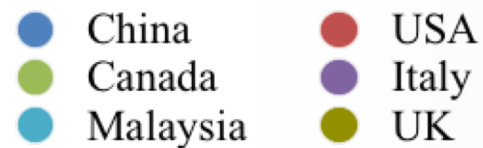
In 2019, GPM published **31 articles**, among them 2 Original Article, 4 Review, and 3 iMDT Articles.



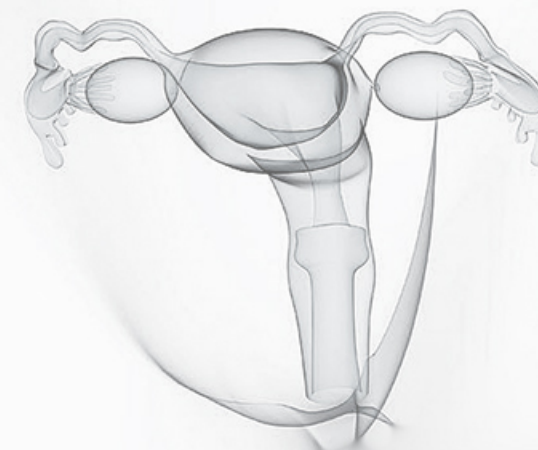
6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2019

came from **6 countries**.

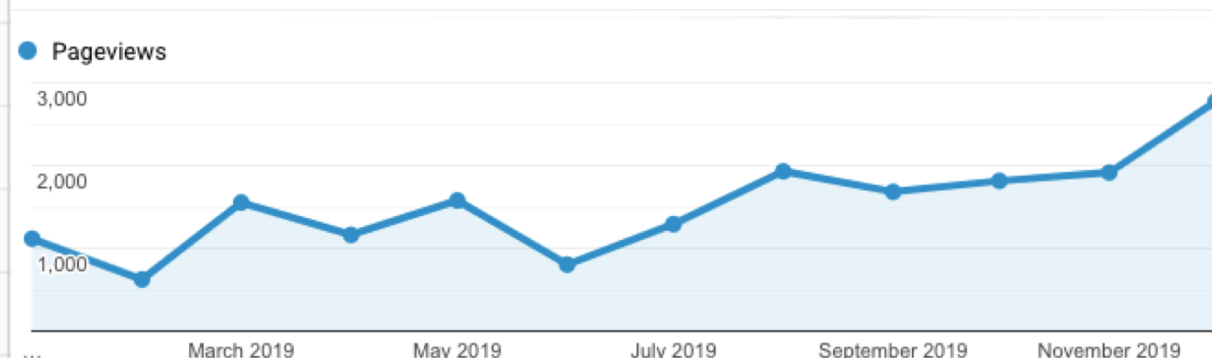
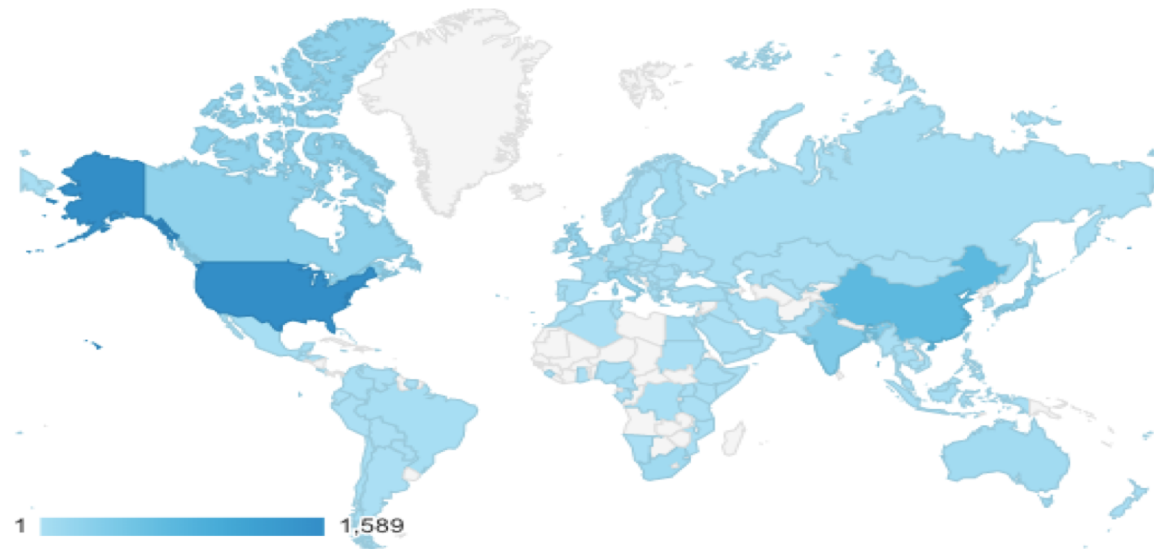
