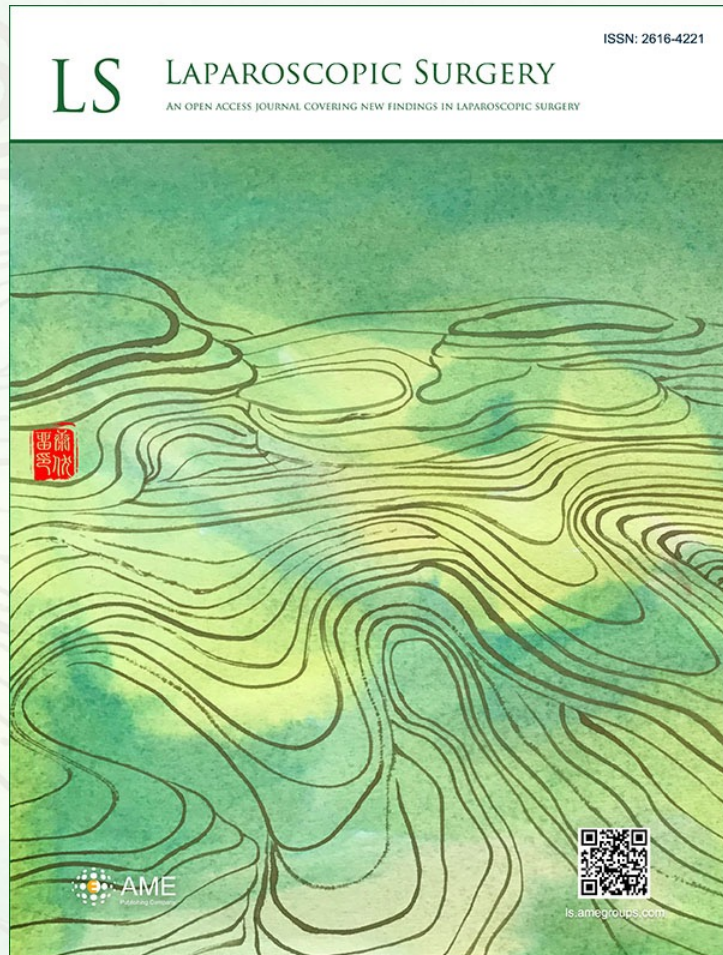

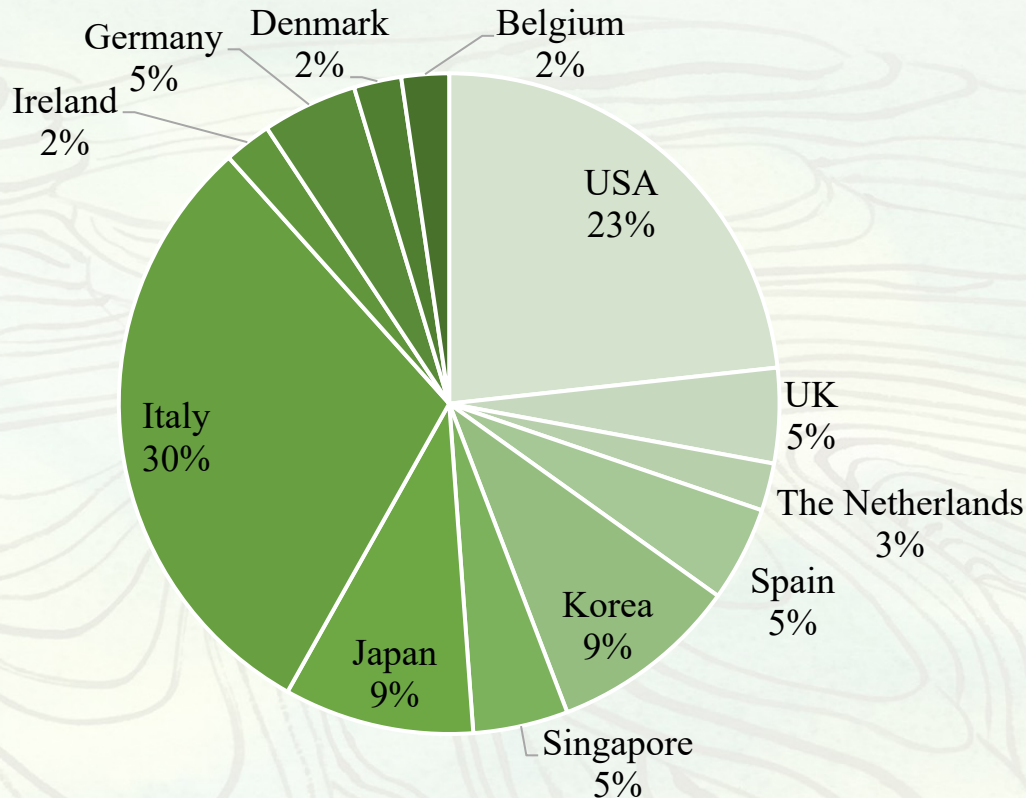
3. Message from the Editor-in-Chief

4. Geographic Distribution of Editorial Board Members

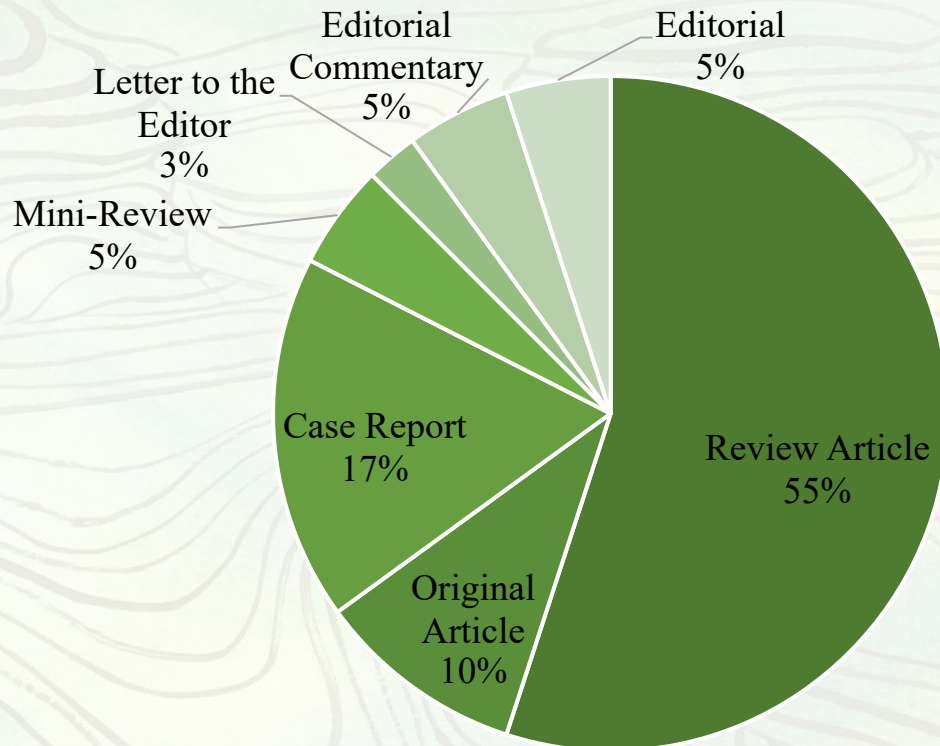


All together **43** members

USA.

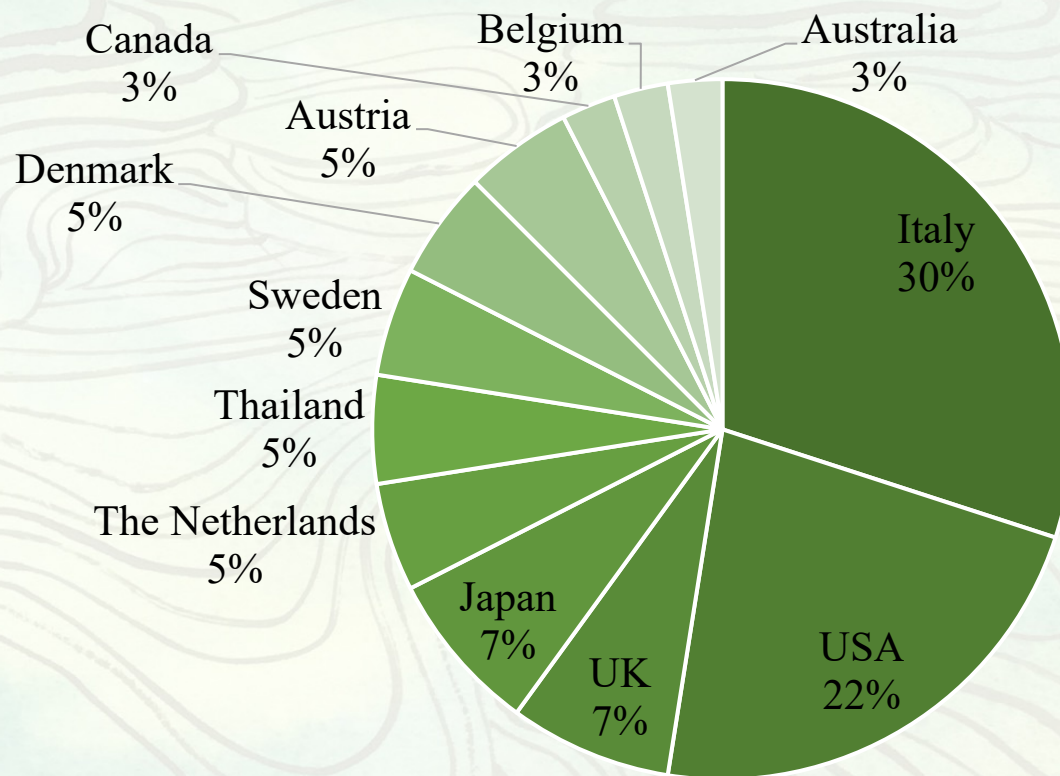

5. Types of Articles Published in 2022



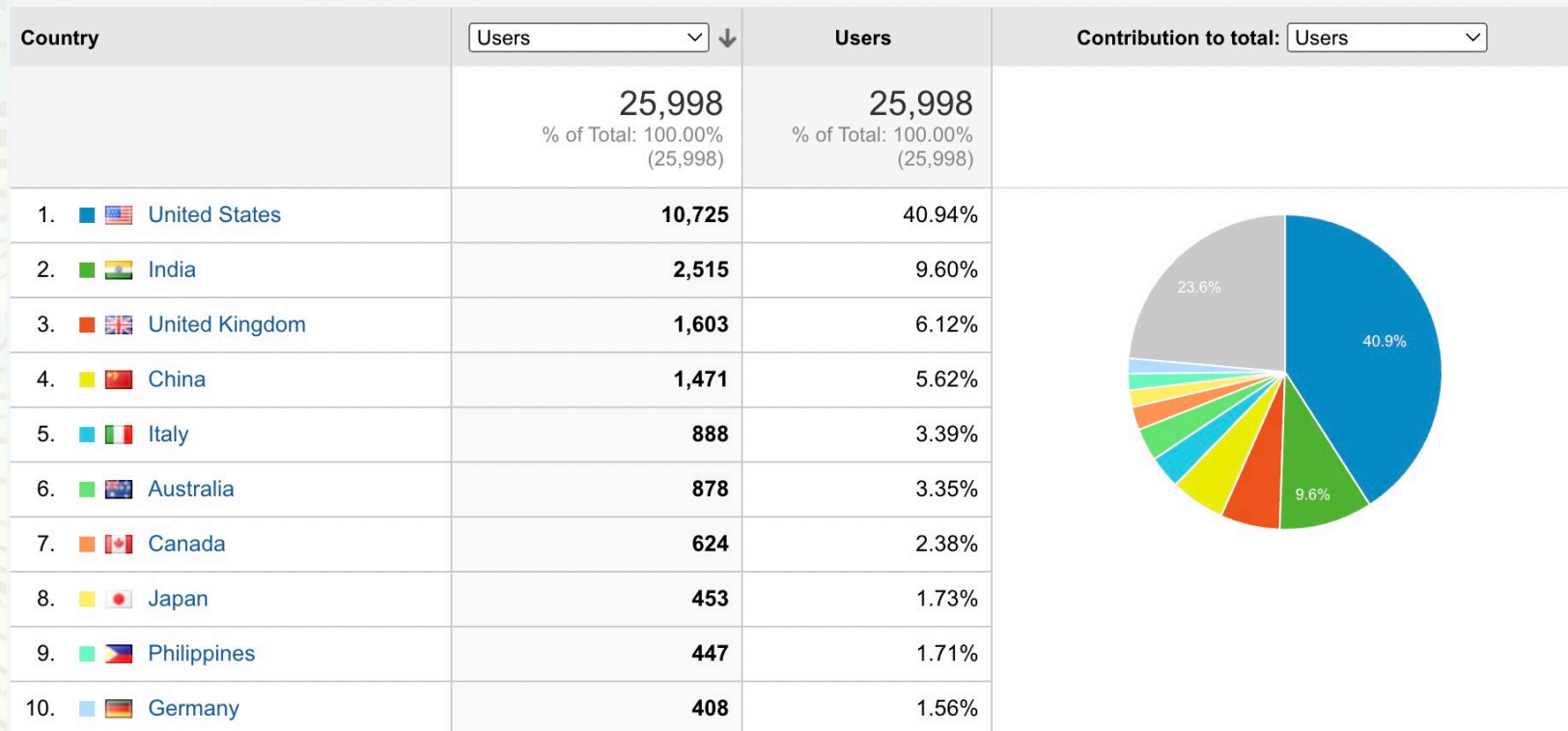
In 2022, LS published **40** **articles**, among which there are **35** Original Articles, Review Articles, and Case Reports.

6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2022



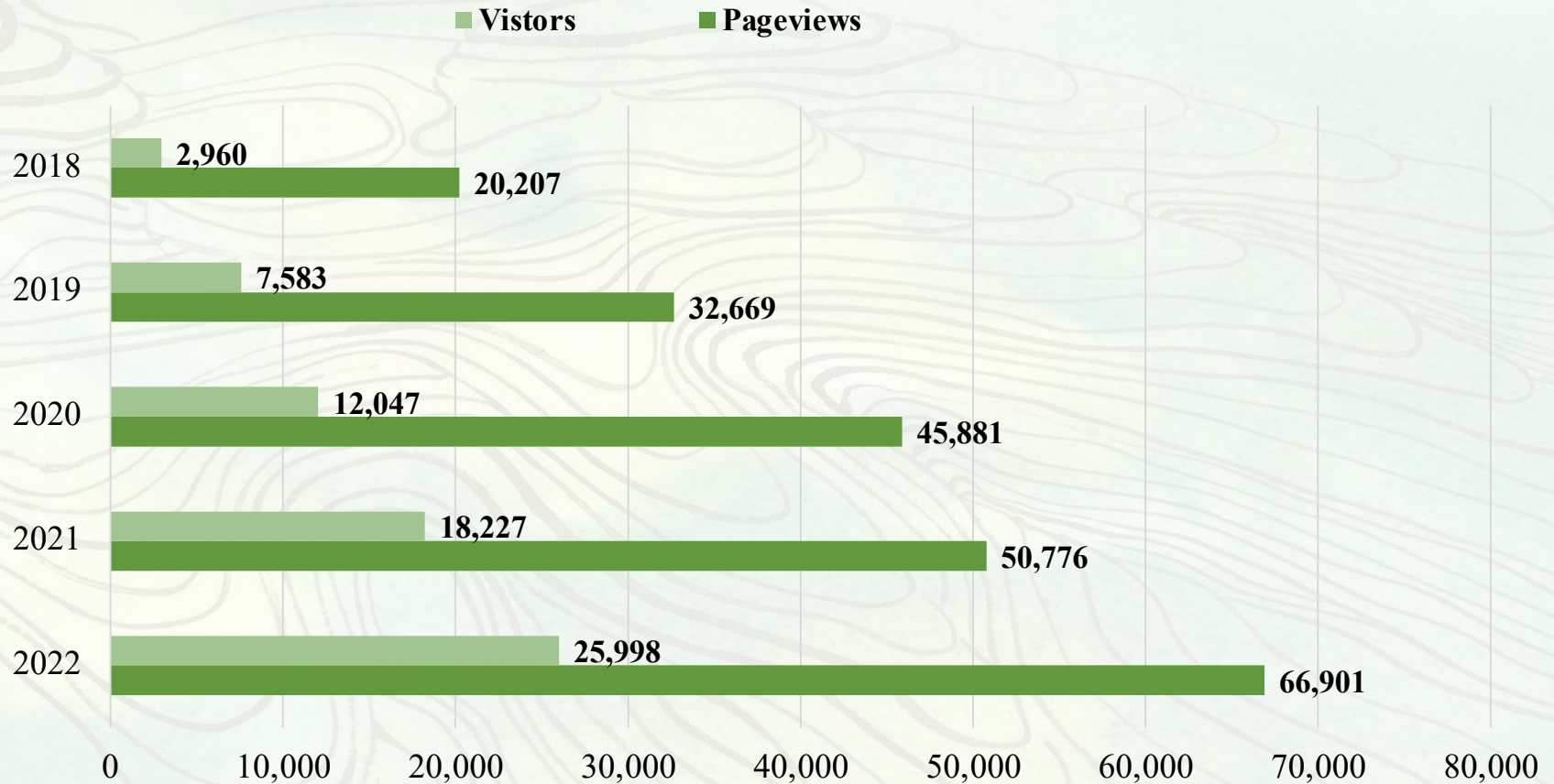
Corresponding authors of 40 articles published in 2022 came from **12** countries, with most from Italy (**30%**) and USA (**22%**)
