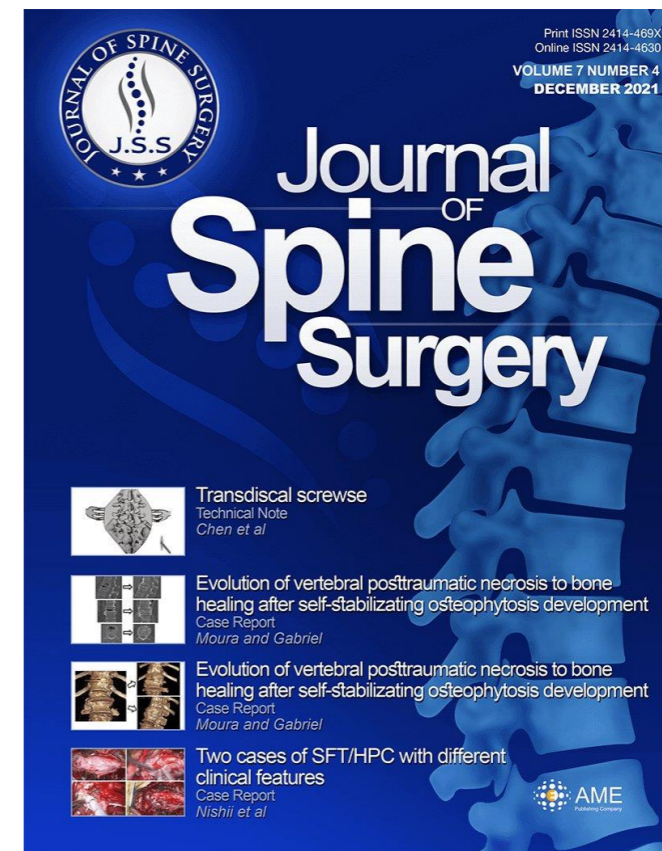

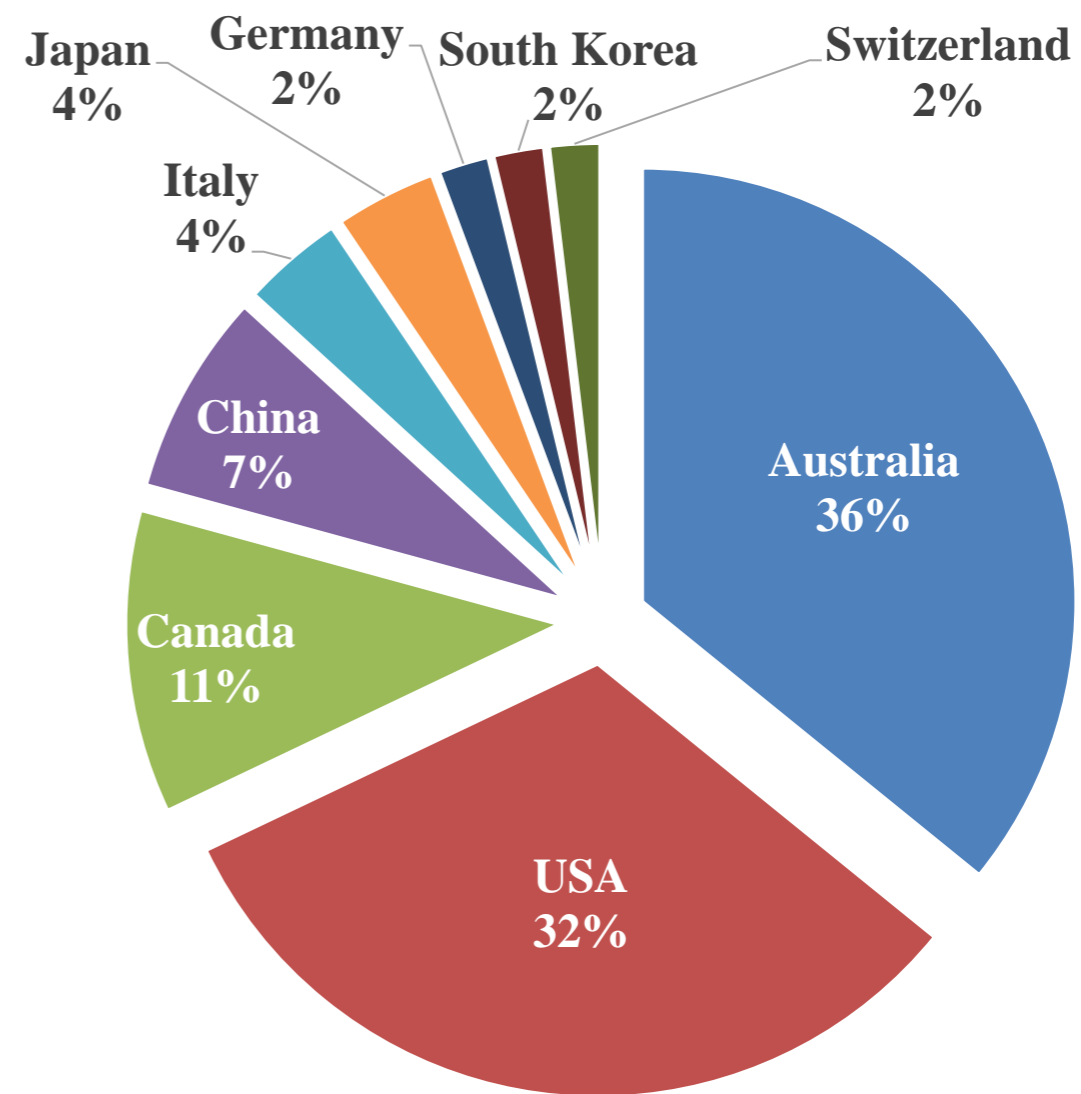

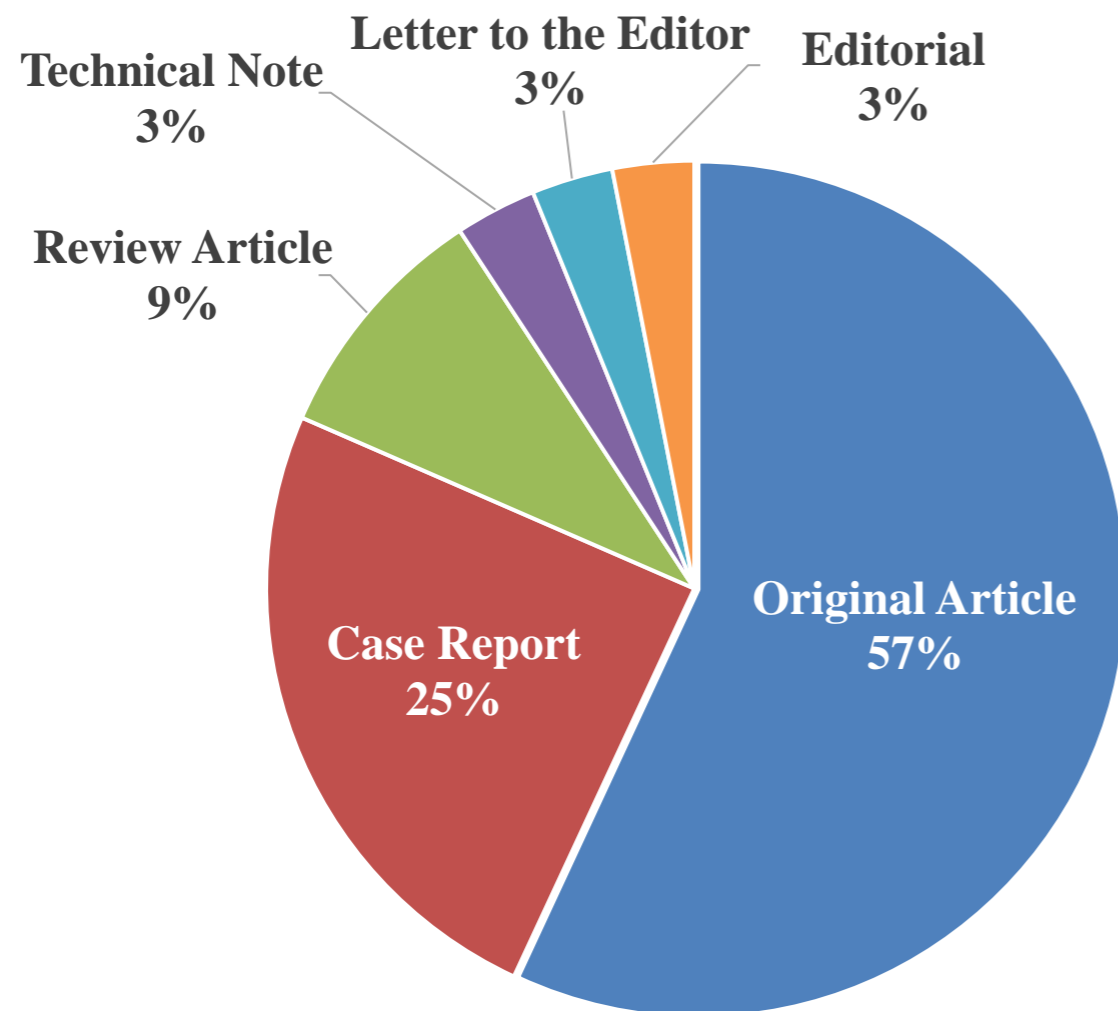
3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

- 48 Editorial Board Members

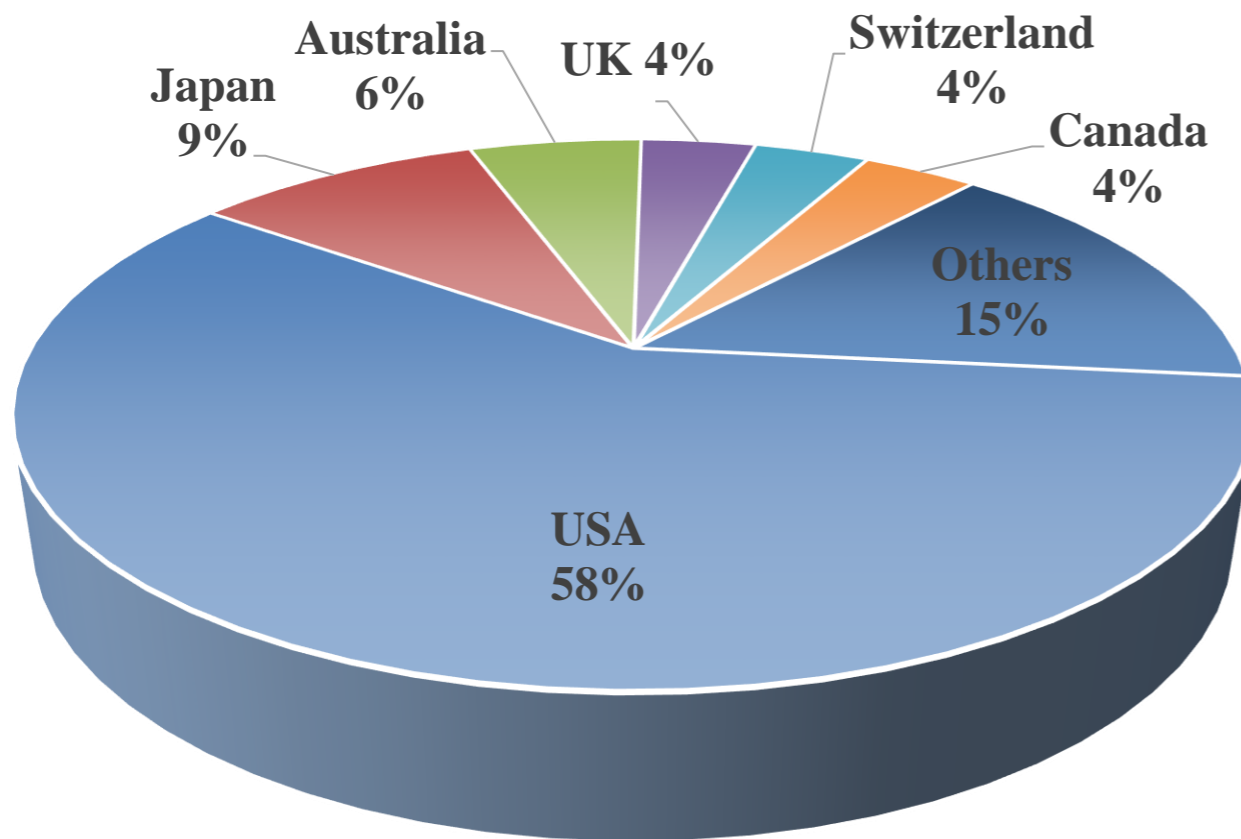


4. Types of Articles Published in 2021



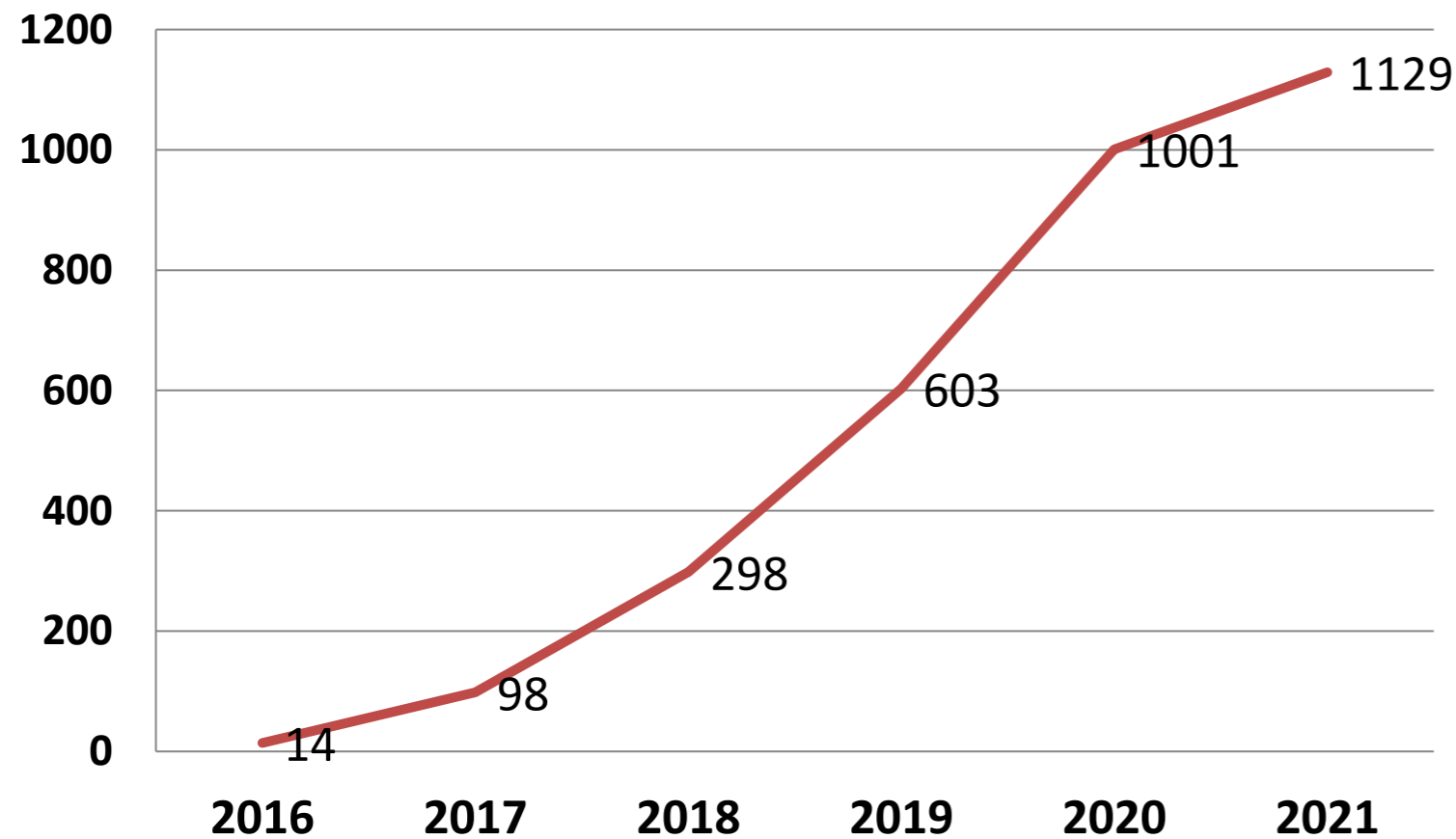

8. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed (PubMed Central)



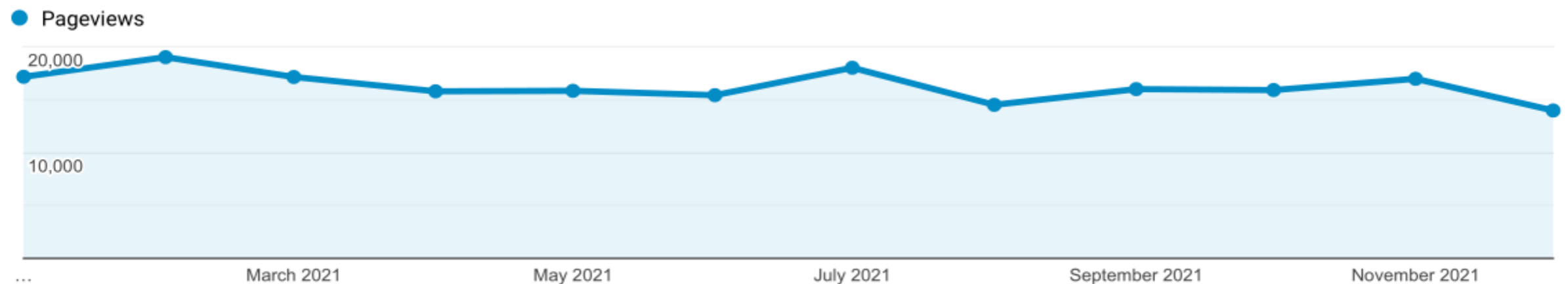
Retrievals of JSS from PubMed Central (PMC) in 2021 reached 325, 254 in total, with the peak reaching 29,907 in March 2021.
