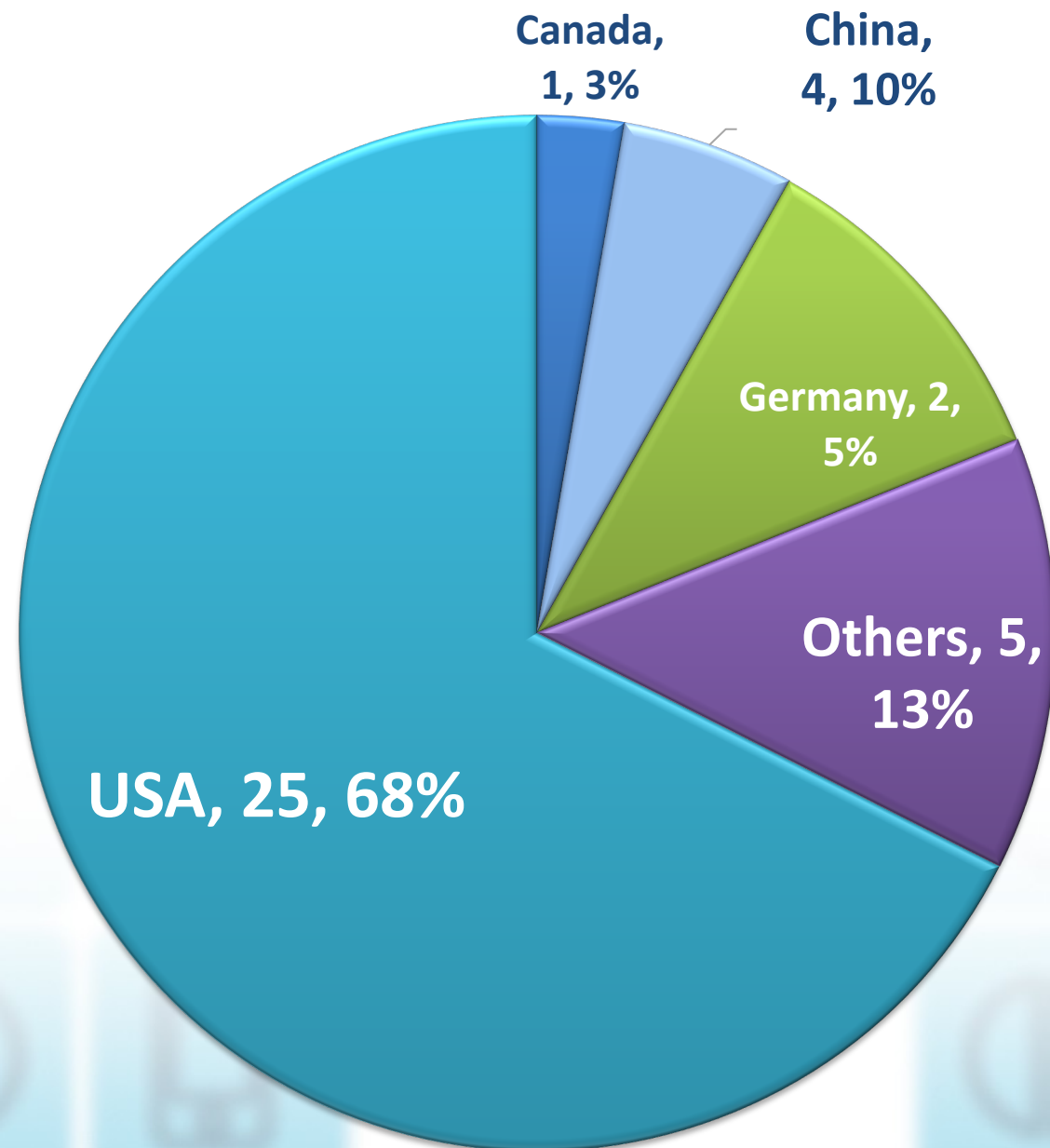

### 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

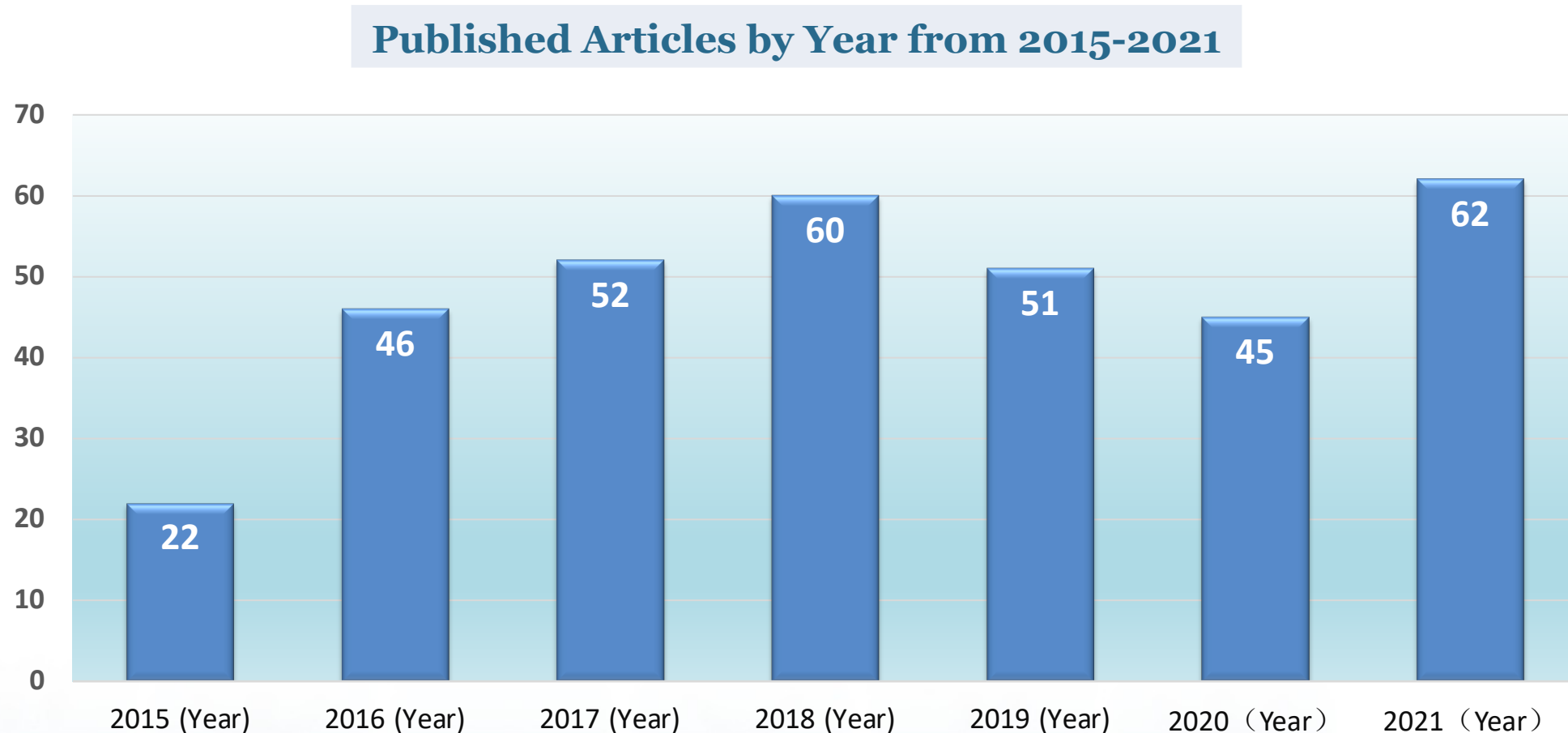

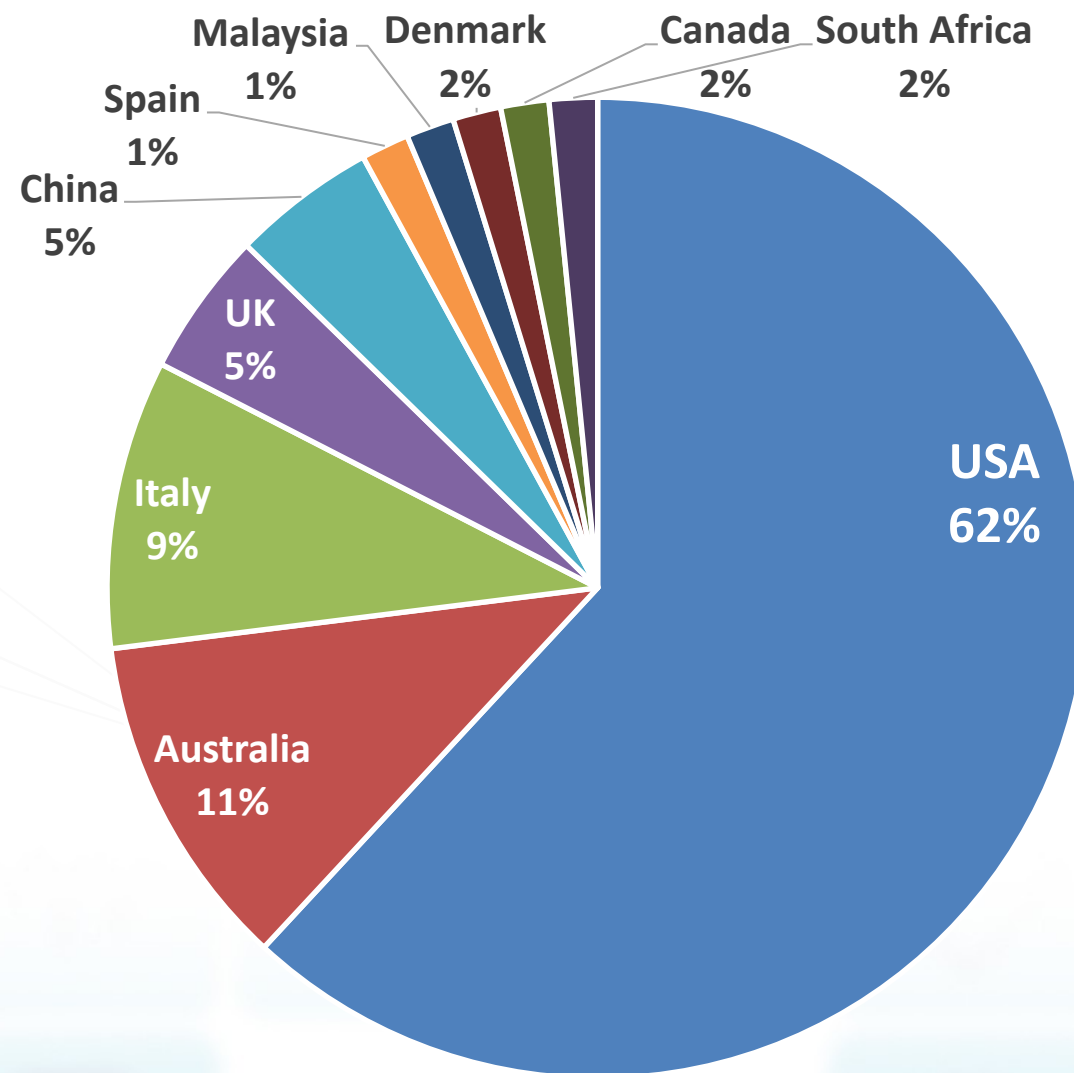

## 6. Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2020

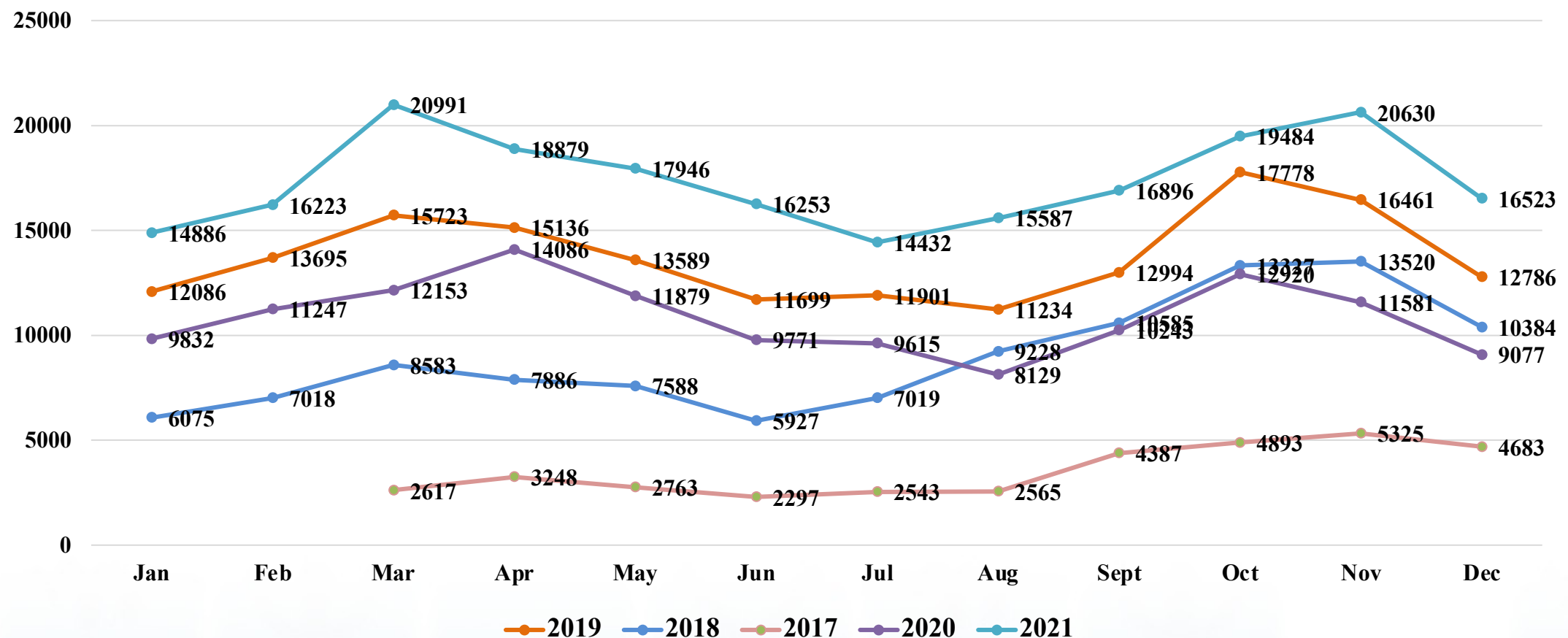


- **63** corresponding authors of articles published in 2021 come from 10 countries, which fully represents the international diversity in *mHealth*.
