

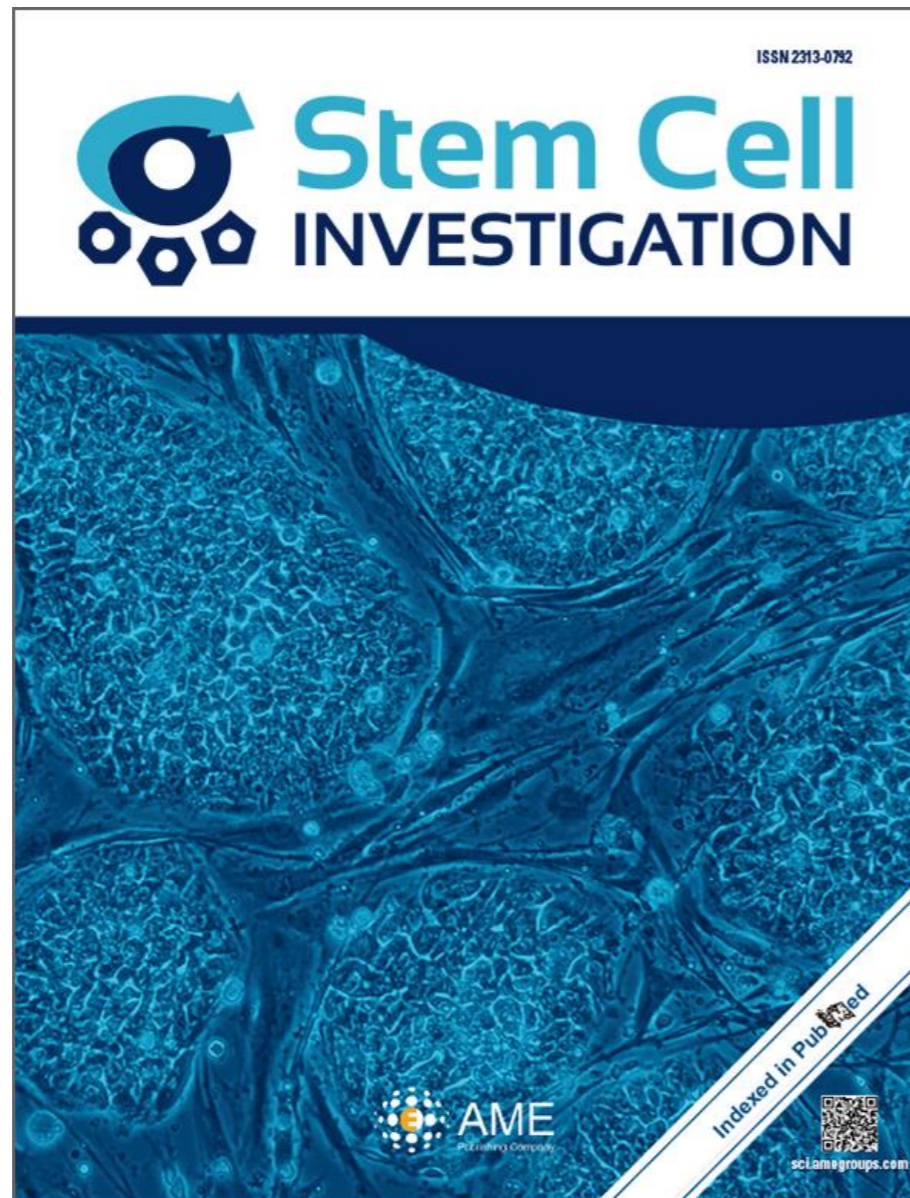

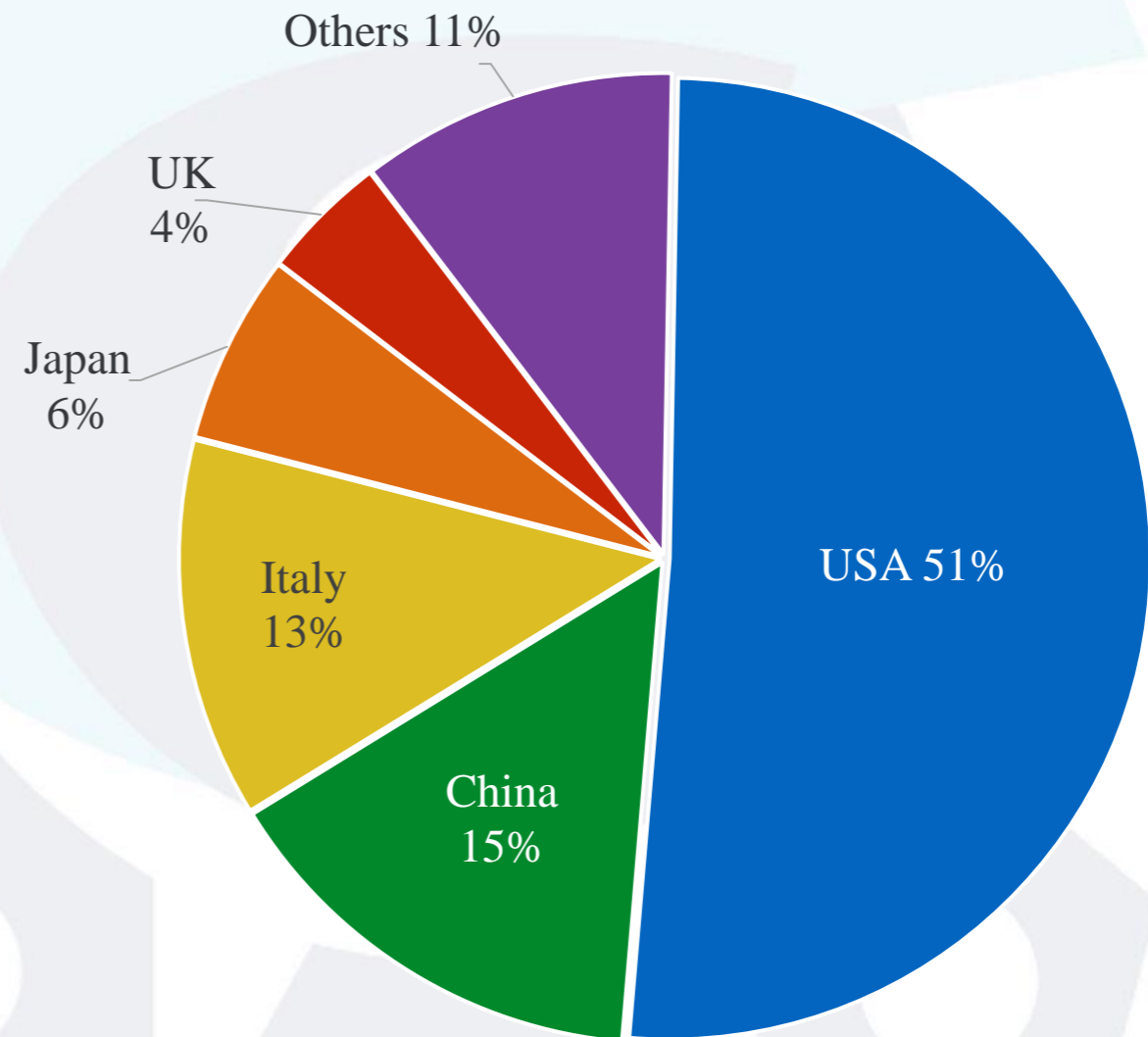

### 3. Distribution of Editorial Board Members

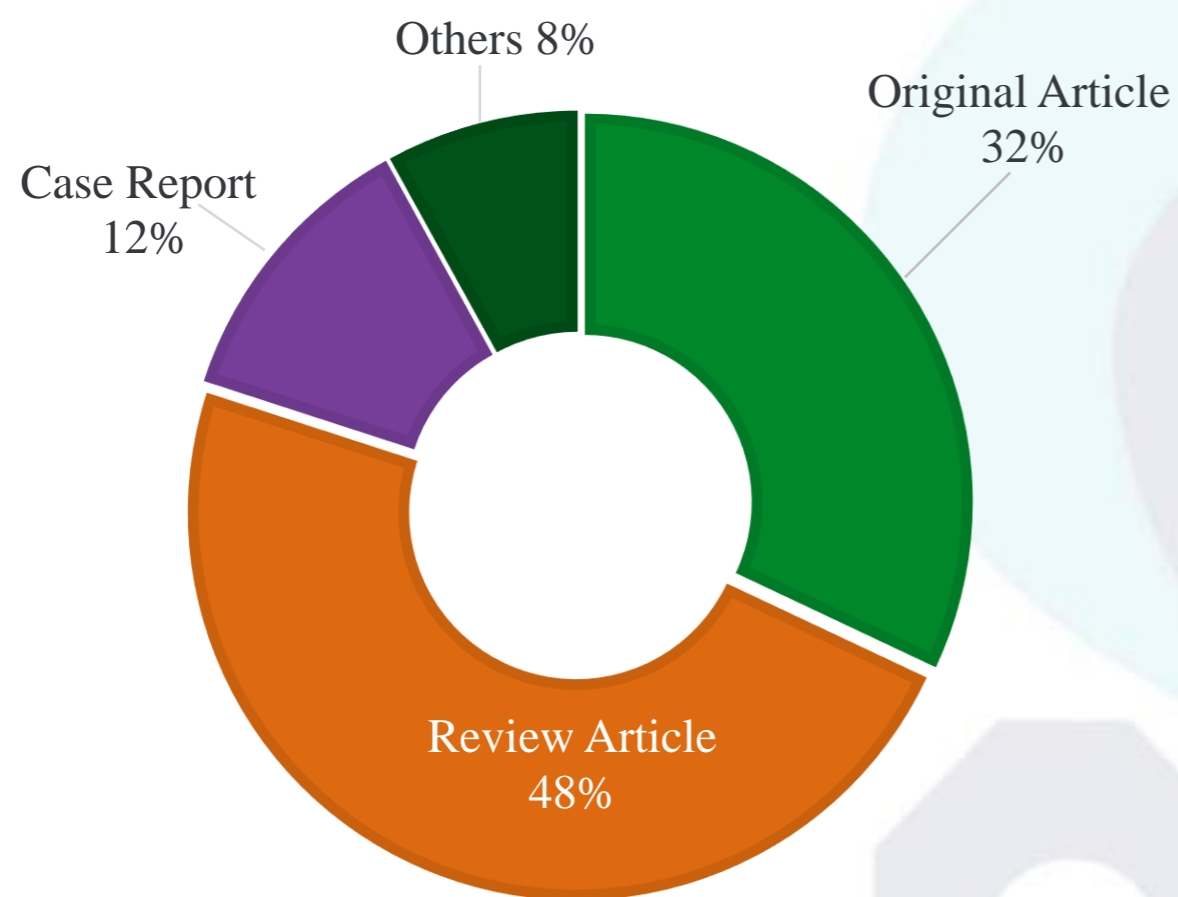
SCI has **47** Editorial Board Members from **10** countries. Among them, 51% from USA, 15% from China and 13% from Italy, etc.

## 4. Diverse Types of Articles Published in SCI

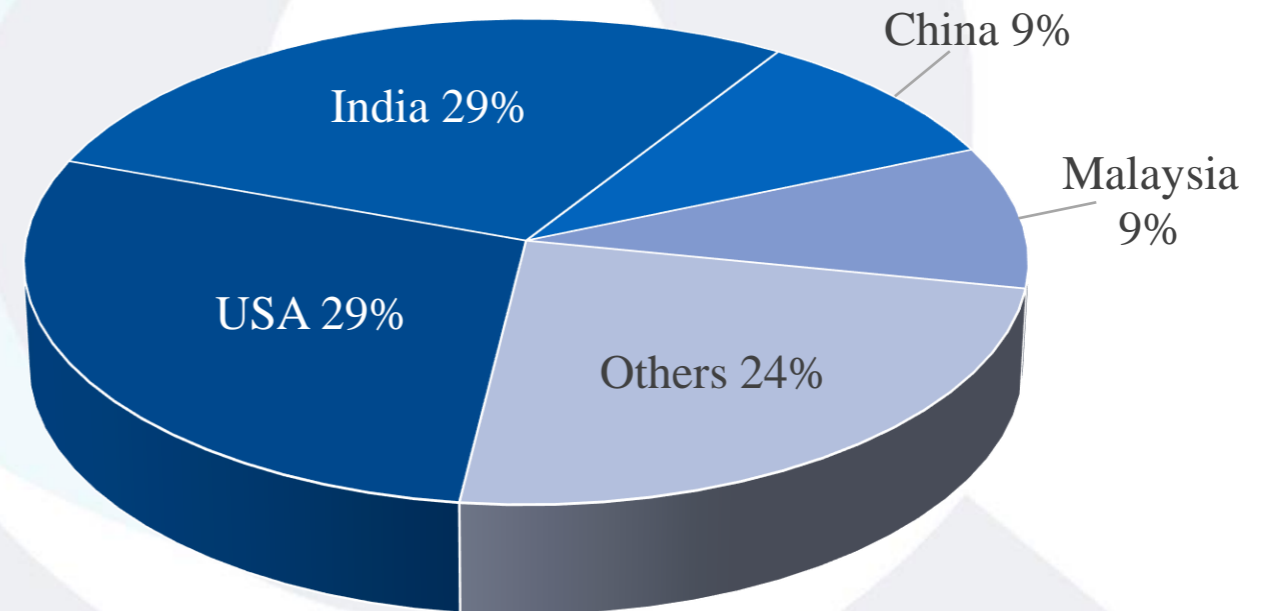


In 2021, SCI has published **25 articles**, among which, there are 12 Review Articles, 8 Original Articles, 3 Case Reports, etc.

## 5. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2021

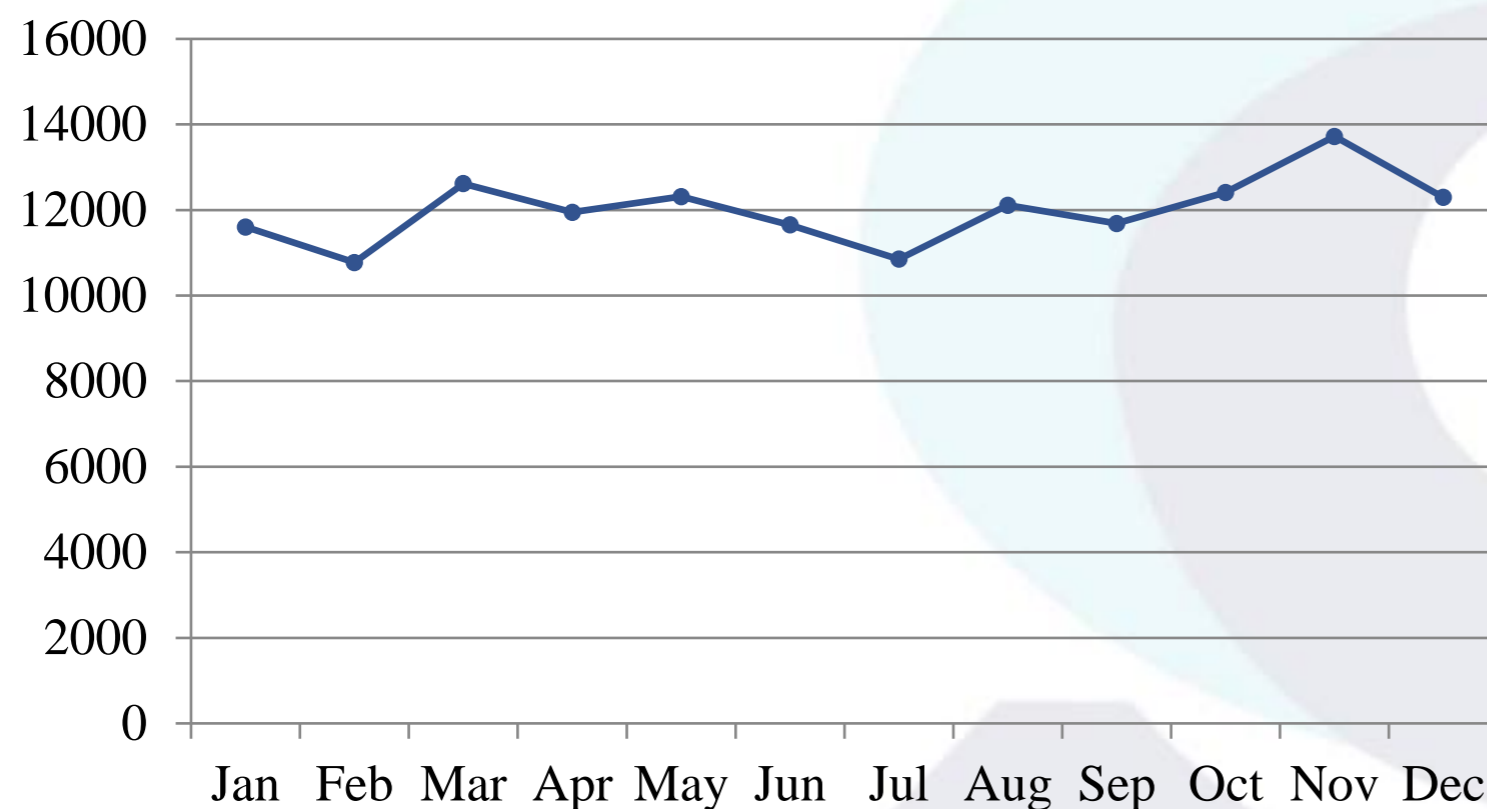
**21** corresponding authors come from **8** countries with majority of them from USA and India, followed by China and Malaysia.

## 6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2021

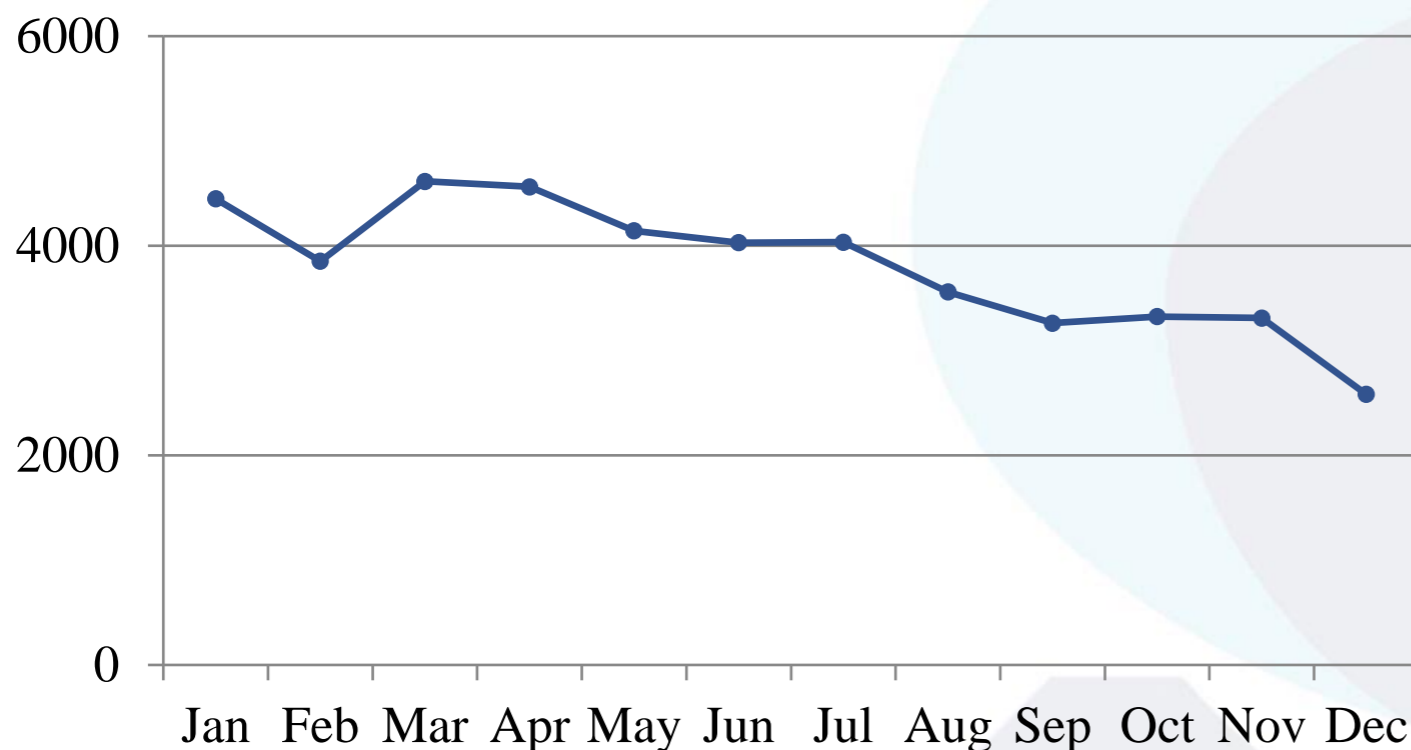


In 2021, the total retrievals of SCI in PubMed is **143,985 times.**
