

3. Message from the Editor-in-Chief

Dear Colleague,

I am pleased to announce that impact factor of our journal is continuing its steady increase. The newly released 2021 Impact Factor is 2.89.

The number of manuscripts submitted increased so rapidly that we have doubled articles published from 141 in 2020 to 320 in the year of 2021. It reflected the rapid acceleration in research on GI oncology. Consequently, the quality of scientific investigations submitted to the JGO markedly improved. The original research articles have increased from 66% to 76% of all published last year in the JGO.


We are striving to improve all aspects of the JGO from submission and review process, while retaining our commitment to a fair and open access to publications in the JGO. I am grateful to our authors and reviewers for submitting and assuring the high quality of the research being published in our journal.




4. Distribution of 26 Editorial Board Members






5. Publication: Number(results by year)



Note: JGO is published quarterly from 2010 to 2013 and has been a bi-monthly journal since 2014.




5. Publication: Article Type

6. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed


